

**Minutes of the 56th Meeting of State Level Task Force on Solid Waste Management
for discussion on several issues of solid waste management**

Director, State Urban Development Agency (SUDA) chaired the meeting.

At the outset, he welcomed all the members present and explained the discussion points of the meeting. After threadbare discussion the following decisions were arrived at:

1. The Committee noted that IIT Kharagpur has submitted their proposal for design parameters & preparation of DPR & technical assistance for setting up of FSTPs in 54 Non-Ganga Towns including 17 AMRUT cities without mentioning total consultancy fees. They have mentioned only payment modalities. It was learnt that two FSTP at Siliguri and Kharagpur have been approved under State Fund (to be charged out of Ring fenced account). DPRs of these two had been prepared by the IIT Kharagpur and the projects will be implemented by the MED with technical assistance of IIT Kharagpur. Bid documents have also been prepared by MED with the assistance of IIT Kharagpur and tenders have already been floated.

Now the committee recommended to take following actions:

- ✓ At first, MED may be requested to submit a report regarding the progress of FSTP set up at Siliguri MC and Kharagpur Municipality.
 - ✓ On the basis of the report and subject to operationalization of SMC and Kharagpur FSTP models, a decision will be taken for their present proposal for 54 towns.
 - ✓ As 17 AMRUT Towns is there in the proposal, so in the next meeting State Mission Director, AMRUT may be invited for his opinion.
2. The Committee noted that Kolkata MC has completed the drone survey for remaining quantity of legacy waste and recommended that
 - ✓ Kolkata MC shall immediately tender the work of biomining and bioremediation of legacy waste of their sites.
 - ✓ As progress of presently working agency M/s D.H. Patel is very slow, so to complete their work within 2024, KMC shall should fix the target of daily processing of legacy waste to the agencies as a tender condition.



3. The Committee was appraised that a pre-bid meeting was held for engagement of agency for biomining and bioremediation of balance quantity of legacy waste of Promodhnagar & Kamarhati dumping sites and a discussion was held between the committee members regarding several clauses of the tender document and submittal made by the bidders post the pre-bid meeting. All the communication received from the prospective bidders are also made a part of the minutes of the meeting.

The Committee accepted and recommended the following clauses based on the pre-bid queries as submitted by the intended bidders :

5. The Committee recommended that maximum 3 (three) JV partners may be allowed in the tender of balance legacy waste processing.
6. The Committee noted that M/s Emdee as JV with M/s Rohini Fire Safety Ltd. has been awarded for integrated legacy and fresh waste processing of Cluster-3 project of Ashoknagar Kalyangarh, Habra and Gobordanga Municipalities. M/s Emdee has submitted application to WBPCB for Consent to Establish for setting up fresh waste processing plant and after getting the permission from WBPCB they will apply for Factory Licence. As for legacy waste processing these kind of permission and licence is not required, hence the Committee recommended that part payment for legacy waste processing may be released to them subject to maintaining all the formalities as per rules on submission of bills after commencement of processing of legacy waste by M/s Emdee Digitronics Pvt. Ltd.
7. The Committee noted that all the ULBs have a demand of setting up Animal Caracas Crematorium. It is understood that the Department has suggested to utilize the existing Animal Crematorium at Promodhnagar for the ULBs adjacent to it and Animal Crematorium for the remaining ULBs may be considered on a cluster mode later on.

With no other issue for discussion the meeting ended with vote of tanks to and from the chair.

2. We would like to request you to either include the **Net Worth** of Directors of the Lead Member while considering the eligibility criteria under financial capacity to satisfy the required Net Worth of 39 Crores.
Or, alternatively, requesting to consider the required Net worth for Eligibility as 40% of asked Average turnover of Rs. 52 Crores as given in the criteria section. (Ref: Page No.- 8, Section 2- Instruction to Bidders, Clause 5.5.9)
3. We request you to make EMD as 1% of total estimated amount offered including GST which is to be paid One-Time during bid submission instead of 2% as balance after deducting Rs.10 Lacs as initial EMD.

4. Lastly, we would like to request you to reduce Performance Bank Guarantee to **3% of total amount offered including GST** instead of 5% after Letter Of Acceptance (LOA) to be valid till the expiry of 6 months after the project completion. (Ref: Page 3, SI. No. 3, PBG)

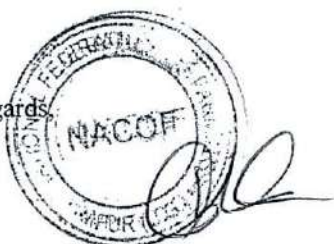
