

**Minutes of the 40th Meeting of State Level Task Force on Solid waste management
for discussion on tender issues and others**

In the Chair : Director, SUDA

Meeting Date : 12th April, 2022

Director, State Urban Development Agency (SUDA) chaired the meeting.

At the outset, he welcomed all the members present and explained the discussion points of the meeting. A threadbare discussion was held regarding the agenda points and following decisions were taken:

1. The Committee noted that the tender for engagement of agency for fresh waste processing at Contai has not been matured in 4th call. For establishment of fresh waste processing plant land is available with Contai and Mandarmoni at their own area. The Committee recommended that for attracting sufficient bidders, considerable quantity of fresh waste will be available if a cluster project can be launched covering Contai, Digba, Mandarmoni and Tajpur. The Committee further recommended to view whether the land available at Contai & Mandarmoni fall under CRZ or not. Therefore, it was decided that Director, SUDA will request Executive Officer, DSDA and Chairman, Contai Municipality to provide the Latitude and Longitude of the lands available at their respective location and subsequently Director, SUDA will request for CRZ Clearance from Director of Environmental Institute and Wet Land Studies.
2. The Committee noted that District Magistrate, Malda has provided a land to Englishbazar and Old Maldah Municipalities for establishment of fresh waste processing plant through Inter Departmental Transfer. Border Security Force has given the verbal consent to use the land for this purpose. As the land is located near the Bangladesh Border area and there is a high chance of encroachment of land, DM, Malda has requested to construct the boundary wall in the land immediately. The Committee further noted that in the 2nd call of the tender for engagement of agency for fresh waste processing has already matured for Englishbazar and Old Maldah Municipalities, where the construction of boundary wall is within the scope of the bidder. As approval of AA&FS and placing of work order will take time, boundary wall cannot be constructed immediately. Hence, the Committee recommended to cancel the present tender and go for a fresh tender with the construction of boundary wall by the bidder to be excluded



from the scope of work. The Committee further recommended to take action for construction of boundary wall immediately.

3. The Committee noted that School of Environmental Studies, Jadavpur University and Jalpaiguri Engineering College in support of West Bengal Pollution Control Board submitted a proposal for conducting survey works regarding Plastic Product Manufacturer, Recycler, Users and Collectors in all Districts of North Bengal, incorporating the suggestions given in the 39th SLTF meeting. After a threadbare discussion the Committee recommended the following:

✓ Points to be incorporated in the questionnaire:

- Item wise use pattern of different plastics covering all stakeholders
- In rural sector 0.01% population sample should be enumerated whereas for urban sectors (ULBs) 5% population sample should be enumerated.
- In the sample all category of stakeholders viz. students, women, slum dwellers etc should be enumerated
- Circular Economy Roadmap should be done wherein different category of stakeholders to be included.
- Public demand on alternative to SUP should be studied and a viable alternative of SUP must be suggested.
- Post study, a comprehensive presentation on findings to be made before the Committee

✓ SUP study should be completed alongwith report submission within the first 2 months i.e. within 30th June, 2022.

✓ Total study should be completed within 7 months including compilation of data and final report submission

✓ The Committee recommended that the total budget estimate of Rs. 13.99 lakhs for completion of the study proposed by the Principal Investigator, Prof. (Dr) Soupayan Mitra of Jalpaiguri Engineering College may be accepted.

4. The Committee noted that M/s SIMOCO Telecommunications Pvt. Ltd. has proposed to install 10 MT Capacity weigh bridge in each of 27 sites where they were awarded the work for establishment of fresh waste processing plant and its O&M for 10 years. After threadbare discussion, the Committee recommended to install weigh bride of 30 MT capacity with least count of 10 Kg. in each site.

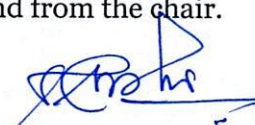
5. The Committee noted that KMDA has floated tender of 8 clusters for 15 ULBs having 18 dumpsites for engagement of agency for biomining and bioremediation of legacy waste (details annexed). out of that tenders for 6 clusters have been matured. The recommendation of the Committee is placed below:

✓ Cluster of Arambag and Tarakeswar: M/s Aayushi Hygiene and Care Pvt. Ltd. / M/s Great India Construction became the L-1 bidder quoting the rate of Rs. 628/-. Committee recommended acceptance of the rate.



- ✓ Cluster of Dhulian, Kandi and Englishbazar: M/s Chowdhury Enterprise/M/s Rohini Fire Safety Pvt. Ltd. became the L-1 bidder quoting the rate of Rs. 580/-. Committee recommended acceptance of the rate.
 - ✓ Nalhati: M/s Rajan Construction/M/s Rohini Fire Safety Pvt. Ltd. became the L-1 bidder quoting the rate of Rs. 448/-. Committee recommended acceptance of the rate.
 - ✓ Basirhat: M/s Rajan Construction/M/s Rohini Fire Safety Pvt. Ltd. became the L-1 bidder quoting the rate of Rs. 484/-. Committee recommended acceptance of the rate.
 - ✓ Jhalda: M/s Krishna Multistructure Engineering Pvt. Ltd. became the L-1 bidder quoting the rate of Rs. 680/-. Committee requested KMDA to further negotiate the rate.
 - ✓ Cluster of Coopers Camp and Bansberia: M/s Aayushi Hygiene and Care Pvt. Ltd. / M/s Great India Construction became the L-1 bidder quoting the rate of Rs. 640/-. Committee recommended acceptance of the rate.
 - ✓ Jhargram: Tender cancelled due to non participation of bidder in 2nd call. The Committee recommended to invite 3rd call.
 - ✓ Cluster of Darjeeling, Kalimpong, Mirik and Kurseong: Tender not opened due to participation of insufficient number of bidders. Committee recommended to invite second call.
6. The Committee requested KMDA to organize joint meeting with KMDA and SUDA Engineers for providing sitewise actual quantity of legacy waste and action plan with timeline for clearing of land for installation of infrastructure for fresh waste processing.
 7. KMDA has surfaced the problems of processing of legacy waste at some of the sites having small quantity of legacy waste and also having constraint of space. They have suggested to transport the waste totally from that site to nearby processing site run by same agency and thereby process the same following prevailing norms and regulations. It has also been assured from their end that proper weighment of the incoming legacy waste should be done at the time of exit from the native site and also during entry at the new processing site to avoid the miss match that may occur during transit. Similarly the weighment should be done for the fractions coming out after processing. A fresh SoP for transportation of the legacy waste from one site to another shall be issued before commencement of the transportation. In this regard the Committee expressed their views which is affirmative.

With no other issue for discussion the meeting ended with vote of tanks to and from the chair.

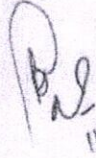

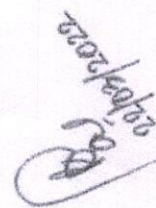

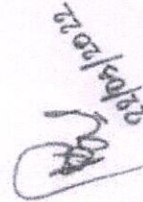
