**Minutes of the 26th Meeting of State Level Task Force on Solid Waste Management for discussion
on tender issues of fresh waste and legacy waste management**

Date : 14.06.2021

Time : 12.30 PM

Venue: Conference Hall of SUDA

List of participants annexed.

Director, State Urban Development Agency (SUDA) chaired the meeting.

At the outset, he welcomed all the members and explained the discussion points of the meeting. After that, financial bid of fresh waste e-tenders of Beldanga, Birnagar, Dalkhola, Dubrajpur, Egra, Gangarampur, Gushkara, Mathabhanga, Taki, Alipurduar and Islampur opened. Then following decisions have been taken in the meeting.

- i. For Alipurduar Municipality, tipping fee quoted by M/s Parasmoni Organic and Agri Products Pvt. Ltd. is Rs.415/- per MT and Simoco Telecommunication (South Asia) Ltd. is Rs.3808/- per MT. Hence, Committee accepted the L-1 rate and recommended the L-1 bidder i.e. M/s Parasmoni Organic and Agri Products Pvt. Ltd. for the work of Alipurduar Municipality to be considered by the Department.
- ii. For Islampur Municipality, tipping fee quoted by M/s Parasmoni Organic and Agri Products Pvt. Ltd. is Rs.415/- per MT and Simoco Telecommunication (South Asia) Ltd. is Rs.3808/- per MT. Hence, Committee accepted the L-1 rate and recommended the L-1 bidder i.e. M/s Parasmoni Organic and Agri Products Pvt. Ltd. for the work of Islampur Municipality to be considered by the Department.
- iii. For each of the 9 ULBs - Beldanga, Birnagar, Dalkhola, Dubrajpur, Egra, Gangarampur, Gushkara, Mathabhanga and Taki, Simoco Telecommunication (South Asia) Ltd. as single bidder quoted the tipping fee of Rs.3808/-. As the rate quoted is too high, the Committee recommended to cancel the 9 bids.

The Financial bid of 27 ULBs - Bankura, Jalpaiguri, Hooghly-Chinsurah, Suri, Coochbehar, Jhargram, Balurghat, Arambagh, Berhampore, Panskura, Rampurhat, Kalyani, Halisahar, Garulai, Chakdah, Budge budge, Bongaon, Basirhat, Barrackpore, Naihati, Titagarh, Ranaghat, Murshidabad, Khardah, Gayeshpur, Domkal and Dhulian opened. The rates for tipping fee quoted by M/s Simoco Telecommunication (South Asia) Ltd. are Rs.367/- for Bankura, Rs.394/- for Jalpaiguri, Rs.367/- for Hooghly-Chinsurah, Rs.421/- for Suri, Rs.421/- for Coochbehar, Rs.421/- for Jhargram, Rs.367/- for Balurghat, Rs.421/- for Arambagh, Rs.367/- for Berhampore, Rs.421/- for Panskura, Rs.421/- for Rampurhat, Rs.394/- for Kalyani, Rs.421/- for Halisahar, Rs.421/- for Garulai, Rs.421/- for Chakdah,

Rs.421/- for Budge budge, Rs.421/- for Bongaon, Rs.394/- for Basirhat, Rs.367/- for Barrackpore, Rs.367/- for Naihati, Rs.421/- for Titagarh, Rs.421/- for Ranaghat, Rs.421/- for Murshidabad, Rs.421/- for Khardah, Rs.421/- for Gayeshpur, Rs.394/- for Domkal and Rs.421/- for Dhulian. The Committee accepted all the rates and recommended that initially 10 tenders will be awarded to M/s Simoco Telecommunication (South Asia) Ltd. with the condition that they should start the work immediately (within one month) and commissioning within 6 months installing all the machineries within 6 months and in the agreement there should be the clause that non-performance of these 10 projects in time, these assignments will be cancelled alongwith the remaining 17 tenders, and if they perform well in time then the other 17 projects will be awarded subject to the condition that they should execute the work on same terms & condition and no price escalation will be claimed from their end. In consultation with KMDA, 10 ULBs among the abovementioned 27 ULBs have been selected where the work of bio mining of legacy waste already initiated and a considerable portion of land from legacy waste dumpsites have been reclaimed. The name of these 10 ULBs are Halisahar, Hooghly-Chinsura, Jalpaiguri, Kalyani, Khardah, Murshidabad, Titagarh, Barrackpore, Berhampore and Budge Budge.

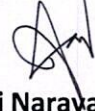
Though in the earlier meeting Committee had recommended to tag 6 ULBs with the fresh waste plant of nearest ULB and negotiate the matter with the awarded agency of that plant for 6 non responsive bids (upto 3rd call) of Kharar, Tufanganj, Kaliaganj, Khirpai, Haldibari and Taherpur, in the present meeting the Committee has reviewed the decision and recommended to go for 4th call of these 6 bids alongwith the above mentioned 9 cancelled bids and Kanchrapara. Before floating the 4th call of these 16 tenders, the Committee recommended to organise pre-tender meeting for seeking more participation from the bidders.

The Committee strictly recommended that all the agencies engaged for fresh waste processing should implement as per SWM Rules, 2016 and CPHEEO manual and should establish Sanitary Landfill site.

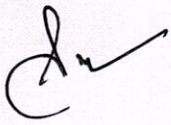
Superintending Engineer, North Circle, SD & SWM Sector, KMDA had presented the e-tender (RfP) to be floated for bio-mining of legacy waste and land reclamation of dumpsites using scientific approach for 6 clusters comprising of 11 dump sites in 9 ULBs viz. Dhulian, Kandi, Englinshbazar, Jhargram, Nalhati, Basirhat, Coopers Camp, Bansberia and Jhalda all the clauses had been accepted by the members of the Committee excepting the method of selection of concessionaire. LCM method to be followed for selection of the bidder where technical qualifying marks should be atleast 70. These 6 RfPs for 11 dump sites in 9 ULBs are accepted by the Committee which should be floated immediately. Thereafter the tender for the rest of 4 ULBs of the Hills viz. Darjeeling,

Kurseong, Kalimpong and Mirikto be floated estimating the quantum of legacy waste in due course of time.

With no other issue for discussion the meeting ended with vote of thanks to and from the chair.

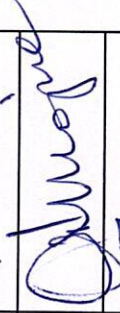
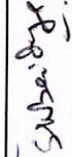
