

Minutes of the 79th Meeting of State Level Task Force on Solid Waste Management for discussion on several issues of solid waste management

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Director, State Urban Development Agency (SUDA) chaired the meeting.

At the outset, he welcomed all the members present and explained the discussion points of the meeting.

After threadbare discussion the following decisions were arrived at:

1. Based on the recommendation of 76th SLTF Meeting held on 16.10.2025 at point no.1, the TIA opened the financial bid of the project of legacy waste processing of Baruipur, Diamond Harbour, Budge Budge and Joynagar-Mazilpur. After opening of the financial bid the committee noted that M/s Aakanksha Enterprises quoted the rate of Rs. 427.00 per ton and M/s Geron Engineering quoted the rate of Rs. 515.00 per ton. L-1 bidder is M/s Aakanksha Enterprises. Since there are two bidders so the Committee recommended that as per extant order of the Finance Department, the UD&MA Department may place it before SDTC.
2. Based on the recommendation of 76th SLTF Meeting held on 16.10.2025 at point no.1, the TIA opened the technical bid of the project of legacy waste processing of Purulia and Raghunathpur. After opening and evaluation of the technical bid the committee noted that M/s Aayushi Hygiene And Care Pvt. Ltd. and M/s Madhav Enterprises, both are technically qualified. The Committee recommended to open the financial bid and place the same in next SLTF meeting.
3. The Committee noted the specifications of different capacity of cesspool and SWM vehicles as recommended by the Technical Sub Committee for Vehicle in its meeting held on 07.01.2026. The Committee accepted the recommendation. The detailed specification of the cesspools and SWM vehicles are placed at **Annexure-I**.
4. The Committee noted that Cesspool, Tractor (to support trailer mount cesspool) and high-pressure Suction cum Jetting Machine (Super sucker) may be provided to different ULBs. Initially it may be provided to the ULBs of North 24 Parganas, South 24 Parganas, Murshidabad, Nadia and Hooghly Districts as detailed at **Annexure-II** (where ULBs have been tagged with functional STP/FSTP following advisory issued by the UD & MA Department which is placed at **Annexure-III**). The Committee accepted the proposal.
5. In furtherance of 76th SLTF meeting held on 16.10.2025 regarding specification of machineries to be installed at plant below 20 TPD, the Committee after detailed deliberation and due diligence suggested for procurement, installation and commissioning of following equipment-

- a. Organic Shredder with Belt Conveyor Machine
- b. Fully Automatic Wheel Mounted Trommel Machine
- c. Organic Fertilizer Crusher Machine
- d. Dust Removal Air Blower (Fatka)
- e. Conveyor Belt for Dry Waste Segregation Machine
- f. Plastic Shredder Machine
- g. Garbage Vertical Hydraulic Baler Machine

The machinery/equipment wise specifications are placed at **Annexure-IV** and made a part of the minutes. The Committee has also been apprised that SUDA had invited online quotation to discover the market price of the machineries as per the specification given as all the 7 different machineries/equipment are non scheduled items . On receipt of offers from different companies , a comparative statement was prepared and rate against the specification of all the 7 different machineries/equipment have been vetted by the Superintending Engineer, MED . The vetted amount includes one year warranty period and further 3 years of comprehensive onsite maintenance support . As part of the contract all the 7 different machineries/equipment are to be serviced , installed and made operational within 24 hours in the event of breakdown . The comprehensive maintenance contract shall include onsite servicing, spares and consumables as well as restoration in the event of breakdown with a response time within 24 hours for ULBs within South zone and 36 hours for ULBs in North zone. The Bidder should have a 24*7 helpline number and also shall have the mandate to impart onsite training to the operator/user for as much time as will be required till he is fully conversant and at ease with operation of machineries/equipment. The bidder should also quote the comprehensive annual maintenance cost factoring in the depreciation value of the machineries/equipment for the 5th , 6th and 7th year . Since the rates of these non schedule items has duly been vetted by the MED , therefore the Committee suggested that TIA is at liberty to go for eTender for procurement, commissioning and installation of machineries/equipment.

6. The Committee noted that INSDAG visited the earlier existing structure of fresh waste processing plant at Mangalpur, Ranigunj and submitted a report on the viability of using the earlier structure for the proposed fresh waste processing plant. In the report they have mentioned that earlier structure may be used for constructing the present fresh waste processing plant subject to rectification or modification of the existing structure. In this context, the Committee recommended that NACOF may be instructed to prepare the design considering the observation of INSDAG and will submit the same getting it vetted by INSDAG.
7. In 74th SLTF meeting held on 13th August, 2025 (Ref. MOM Serial no 03.2) the committee recommended the projects of "Construction of concrete road from Rathtala More to Compost Plant Border (Trenching Ground Road) at Ward No. 14" of Baidyabati Municipality with total project cost of Rs.46,48,367.00. Due to some rate modification in schedule items of work the revised cost became Rs.59,75,461.00. The committee may accept the proposal.

8. The Committee was apprised that in 69 ULBs fresh waste processing plant with capacity less than 50 TPD and in 15 ULBs beyond 50 TPD are under various stages of execution by MED. The capital cost that includes civil & electrical infrastructure as well as procurement, installation and commissioning of various machineries are being borne out of SBM(U). Now to make those plants functional operators are to be engaged for plants below 50 TPD capacity whereas agency may be engaged for plants beyond 50 TPD capacity. Where agency is to be engaged for processing and disposal of daily incoming fresh waste, the tipping fee model may be adopted. In this connection, a draft RfP was prepared for engagement of agency for operation & maintenance of fresh waste processing plant and presented before the Committee. The Committee suggested to rectify some clauses and place before the TIA for inviting tender.
9. A presentation was made on the draft RfP prepared for engagement of consultant for preparation of DPR for used water management of 73 ULBs having population below 1 lakh. The Committee accepted the draft RfP and recommended for next course of action to take approval of the State Government and floating the tender.
10. The Committee noted that Hon'ble East Zone Bench of National Green Tribunal in their order vide O.A. No. 50 and MA 5 directed to submit timelines of work in progress in connection with Darjeeling SWM and Promodnagar SWM Projects work. In this connection the Committee opined that i) Promodnagar SWM Projects has been completed and ii) the Committee should visit Darjeeling SWM site, thereafter timeline may be given.

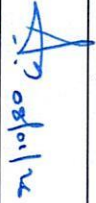
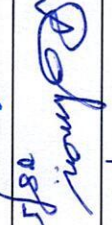
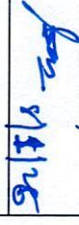
With no other issue for discussion the meeting ended with vote of tanks to and from the chair.
