Minutes of the 17th Meeting of State Level Task Force on Solid Waste Management

Date : 04.03.2021

Time : 12.00 Noon

Venue: Conference Hall of SUDA

List of participants annexed.

Director, State Urban Development Agency (SUDA) chaired the meeting.

At the outset, he welcomed all the members and explained the discussion points of the meeting. After that, a threadbare discussion was held among the members and the following discussions and decisions have been made in the meeting.

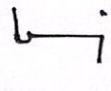
- (1) Kolkata Metropolitan Development Authority (KMDA) had floated tender for engagement of agency for bio-mining of legacy waste of 69 ULBs in 29 clusters. Out of that, after maturity of tender, KMDA had given work order for commencement of work in 41 ULBs of 18 clusters.
- (2) For remaining 28 ULBs of 11 clusters, KMDA had floated tender (3rd call) for engagement of agency for bio-mining of legacy waste, out of which, tender matured (both Technical and Financial) for 26 ULBs in 10 cluster except the cluster of Arambagh and Tarakeswar (details enclosed in **Annexure-1**). The Committee recommended that:
 - a. The rate of H-1 bidder/s of 10 clusters is accepted and may proceed for further issuance of AA&FS from the Department subject to clearance by Election Commission of India.
 - b. As the Quantity of legacy waste (12756 MT) of Arambagh and Tarakeswar is minimum and even after 3rd call no bidders participated, hence the work of this cluster may be provided to the awarded H-1 bidder of nearest cluster in similar Rate and Terms & Conditions, and may proceed for issuance of AA&FS from the Department subject to clearance by Election Commission of India or the legacy waste may be transferred to the nearest legacy waste processing site and the rate for transportation to be proposed by KMDA which is subsequently be ratified by the Finance Department.
- (3) The Committee reviewed the progress of work of bio-mining of legacy waste of 41 ULBs of 18 clusters details enclosed in **Annexure-2**) and suggested that:
 - a. KMDA to prepare a template for regular review and share the same to engaged agencies for regular review.
 - b. A communication should be made to all the agencies engaged in bio mining of legacy waste to install leachate treatment facility in all legacy waste site quoting the order of Central Pollution Control Board
 - c. In this connection, it was decided that a Video Conference will be organized by KMDA on 10.03.2021 at 12 Noon in presence of the Technical Experts of SLTF with all the awarded agencies for sharing the template, understanding the compliance of CPCB

order of leachate treatment and asking for methodology & work plan for execution of bio-mining work.

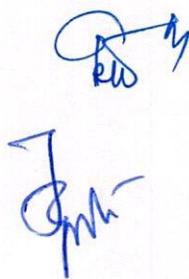
(4) SUDA has floated tender for engagement of agency for bio-mining of legacy waste of Asansol and Durgapur MC. The pre bid meeting was held on 01.03.2021. The queries of the bidders raised in the pre-bid meeting were placed before the committee and the Committee has recommended the following:

- a. Commencement of the work of processing of legacy waste may started within 3 months from the date of issue of work order instead of 1 month mentioned in the RfP document.
- b. Security deposit @3% may be allowed as per latest order of Finance Department, Government of West Bengal.
- c. The time limit for work completion of Asansol MC to be increased to 2 year instead of 1 year after 3 months initial commissioning period.
- d. Air quality monitoring at site to be done twice a week instead of round the clock monitoring.
- e. As Model Code of Conduct has come into force for General Assembly Election, 2021 of West Bengal, so necessary permission related to issuing corrigendum and allied works related to tender to be taken from Election Commission of India.

With no other issue for discussion the meeting ended with vote of thanks to and from the chair.
