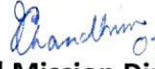

You are requested kindly to attend the meeting as a member of the committee on the above mentioned date, time and venue.

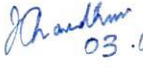

Minutes of the 25th Meeting of State Level Task Force on Solid Waste Management for discussion on tender issues of fresh waste and legacy waste management

Date : 04.06.2021

Time : 12.00 Noon

Venue: Conference Hall of SUDA

List of participants annexed.

Director, State Urban Development Agency (SUDA) chaired the meeting.

At the outset, he welcomed all the members and explained the discussion points of the meeting. After that, financial bid of fresh waste and legacy waste e-tenders of Asansol MC And Durgapur MC and Financial bid of legacy waste of Naihati Municipality opened. Then following decisions have been taken in the meeting.

1. Fresh Waste tenders:

- i. For Asansol MC tipping fee quoted by M/s NACOF is Rs.424/- per MT, M/s Eastern Organic Fertilizer Pvt. Ltd. is Rs.469/- per MT, M/s Aakanksha Enterprises is Rs.555/- per MT and M/s Emdee Digitronics Pvt. Ltd. is Rs.477.90/- per MT Hence, Committee recommended to the L-1 bidder i.e. M/s NACOF for the work of Asansol MC to be considered by the Department.
- ii. For Durgapur MC tipping fee quoted by M/s NACOF is Rs.415/- per MT, M/s Eastern Organic Fertilizer Pvt. Ltd. is Rs.469/- per MT, M/s Aakanksha Enterprises is Rs.555/- per MT and M/s Emdee Digitronics Pvt. Ltd. is Rs.477.90/- per MT. Hence, Committee recommended M/s NACOF for the work of Durgapur MC to be considered by the Department.

2. Legacy Waste tenders:

- i. For Asansol MC tipping fee quoted by M/s NACOF is Rs.424/- per MT, M/s Eastern Organic Fertilizer Pvt. Ltd. is Rs.775/- per MT, M/s Aakanksha Enterprises is Rs.560/- per MT and M/s Zigma Global Environ Sollutions Pvt. Ltd. is Rs.887/- per MT Hence, Committee the L-1 bidder i.e. M/s NACOF for the work of Asansol MC to be considered by the Department.
- ii. For Durgapur MC tipping fee quoted by M/s NACOF is Rs.415/- per MT, M/s Eastern Organic Fertilizer Pvt. Ltd. is Rs.775/- per MT, M/s Aakanksha Enterprises is Rs.565/- per MT and M/s Zigma Global Environ Sollutions Pvt. Ltd. is Rs.887/- per MT Hence, Committee the L-1 bidder i.e. M/s NACOF for the work of Durgapur MC to be considered by the Department.
- iii. For Naihati Municipality, tipping fee quoted by M/s Aakanksha Enterprises is Rs.560/- per MT as single bidder. Hence, Committee recommended the M/s

Aakanksha Enterprises for the work of Naihati Municipality to be considered by the Department.

M/s Simoco Telecommunication (South Asia) Ltd. participated in 28 tenders as single bidder. The name of the ULBs are Bankura, Jalpaiguri, Hooghly-Chinsurah, Suri, Coochbehar, Jhargram, Balurghat, Arambagh, Berhampore, Panskura, Rampurhat, Kanchrapara, Kalyani, Halisahar, Garulai, Chakdah, Budge budge, Bongaon, Basirhat, Barrackpore, Naihati, Titagarh, Ranaghat, Murshidabad, Khardah, Gayeshpur, Domkal and Dhulian. Though in the earlier meeting, Committee expressed its concern whether one agency would be able to justice to such large no. of projects and recommended to go for a 3rd call, yet the Committee reviewed the decision and asked M/s Simoco Telecommunication (South Asia) Ltd. to deliver technical presentation before the Committee. After the technical presentation made by M/s Simoco Telecommunication (South Asia) Ltd., the committee made the technical evaluation, where except the tender of Kanchrapa other 27 bids have qualified. The Committee recommended for opening the financial bid of abovementioned 27 ULBs.

In the earlier meetings, the committee had approved 13 SWM DPR of Siliguri MC, Chandernagore MC, Kharagpur, Uluberia, Barasat, Maheshtala, Raiganj, Midnapure, Nabadwip, Santipur, Madhyamgram, Rajpur-Sonarpur and Bardhaman Municipality submitted by respective Micro Planning Organizations.

In the present meeting, the Committee approved the DPR on Solid Waste Management of 77 ULBs - Alipurduar, Bankura, Bishnupur, Sonamukhi, Dubrajpur, Nalhati, Rampurhat, Sainthia, Suri, Coochbehar, Dinhata, Haldibari, Mathabhanga, Mekhliganj, Tufangan, Arambag, Baidyabati, Bansberia, Bhadreswar, Champdany, Dankuni, Hooghly-Chinsurah, Konnagar, Rishra, Serampore, Tarakeswar, Uttarpara-Kotrung, Howrah MC, Dhupguri, Jalpaiguri, Mal, Berhampore, Jiaganj-Azimganj, Murshidabad, Birnagar, Chakdah, Coopers Camp NAA, Gayespur, Haringhata, Kalyani, Krishnagar, Ranaghat, Taherpur NAA., Ashoknagar-Kalyangarh, Baduria, Baranagar, Barrackpore, Basirhat, Bidhannagar MC, Dum Dum, Gobordanga, Habra, Halisahar, Kamarhati, Kanchraparar, Khardah, New Barrackpore, North Dum Dum, Panihati, South Dum Dum, Taki, Titagarh, Asansol MC, Durgapur MC, Haldia, Tamralipta, Jhalda, Purulia, Raghunathpur, Baruipur, Budge Budge, Diamond Harbour, Jaynagar Mazilpur, Pujali, Dalkhola, Islampur and Kaliyaganj submitted by the respective Micro Planning Organizations.

As per decision of the Committee in the earlier meeting tender for 3rd call was floated for non responsive bids for 17 bids of 17 ULBs for fresh waste management. Out of that, no response received for 6 bids, single bidder [Simoco Telecommunication (South Asia) Ltd.] participated in 9 bids and M/s Parasmoni Organic and Agri Products Pvt. Ltd. and Simoco Telecommunication (South Asia) Ltd. participated in 2 bids – Alipurduar and Islampur. After the technical presentation made

by M/s Parasmoni Organic and Agri Products Pvt. Ltd. and Simoco Telecommunication (South Asia) Ltd. before the Committee, the Committee recommended that:

1. M/s Parasmoni Organic and Agri Products Pvt. Ltd. and Simoco Telecommunication (South Asia) Ltd. both are technically qualified for Alipurduar and Islampur Municipalities and Simoco Telecommunication (South Asia) Ltd. is technically qualified for Beldanga, Birnagar, Dalkhola, Dubrajpur, Egra, Gangarampur, Gushkara, Mathabhanga and Taki, and recommended for opening of Financial bid.
2. As the quantity of waste of 6 non responsive bids (upto 3rd call) of Kharar, Tufanganj, Kaliaganj, Khirpai, Haldibari and Taherpur are very small, hence the Committee recommended to tag these ULBs with the fresh waste plant of nearest ULB and negotiate the matter with the awarded agency of that plant and place before the Committee in the next meeting.

The other decisions of the Committee are placed below:

1. The Committee recommended that the evaluation of all SWM related tenders (both for fresh and legacy waste) to be done using LCM method only. Cut off mark for technical evaluation should be atleast 70.
2. For re-assessing the Environmental Compensation for legacy waste management of the ULBs by WBPCB, KMDA will submit to WBPCB the detailed information of bio mining of legacy waste of the ULBs as per prescribed format including the date of commencement of work.
3. Before execution of fresh waste processing unit, the ULB/ concerned agency should submit online application for consent to operate in Form-I to WBPCB.
4. All the agencies who are/ to be engaged for fresh waste and legacy waste management will be asked to submit the plan of action at first as per prescribed format to be provided from SUDA.

With no other issue for discussion the meeting ended with vote of tanks to and from the chair.

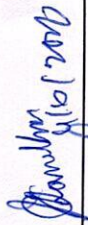
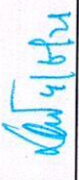
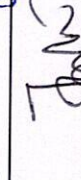
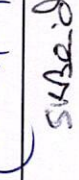
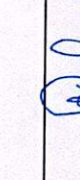
