I, Manoj Kumar Agarwal, S/o Surendra Kumar Agarwal, aged about 60 years, by faith- Hindu, by Occupation- Government Service, working as the Chief Secretary, Government of West Bengal having office at Nabanna, 325, Sarat Chatterjee Road, Howrah, do hereby solemnly declare and say as follows:-

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1. That, I am holding the post of Chief Secretary, Government of West Bengal and I have made myself well acquainted with the facts and circumstances of the instant case and have gone through the documents and reports pertaining to the subject matter of the instant Original Application. Hence, I am competent to affirm this instant affidavit before the Hon'ble Tribunal.
2. That the present affidavit is being affirmed pursuant to the directions passed by this Hon'ble Tribunal in the solemn order dated 02.09.2025 directing the Chief Secretary, State of West Bengal to file the next six monthly report in the form of affidavit addressing the gaps and deficiencies in the execution of the Solid and Liquid Waste Management.
3. That in pursuance of the above-mentioned directions, Urban Development & Municipal Affairs Department has reported the status of Solid Waste Management in the State including Fresh Waste Management across 128 Urban Local Bodies, Status of Bio-Mining and Remediation of Legacy Waste and daily liquid waste (sewage) generation and treatment and bio-mining and bio remediation of legacy waste of 115 ULBs and within the State of West Bengal.

I. STATUS OF BIO-MINING AND REMEDIATION OF LEGACY WASTE

LEGACY ACCUMULATION:

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That across 126 legacy waste dump sites spanning 115 targeted ULBs, the absolute metrics of legacy waste stand as follows:

Quantity of Legacy Waste Reported: 2,78,90,819.71 MT

Present Quantity of Legacy Waste: 1,48,77,937.52 MT

Daily Legacy Waste added as Unprocessed Waste (TPD): 7916.15



That Darjeeling, Kalimpong, Mirik and Kurseong have achieved 100% completion in clearing their sites. In rest of the municipal hubs, the process of quantification and utilization of bio-mining and bio-remediation is ongoing.

II. FRESH WASTE GENERATION PROFILES AND PROCESSING DEFICITS

QUANTUM OF DAILY ARRIVALS:

The State of West Bengal generates an aggregate total of 10,227 Tons Per Day (TPD) of fresh municipal solid waste, with Kolkata Municipal Corporation generating the peak load of 3,668 TPD.

COMPOSITIONAL ANALYSIS:

That the physical characterization of the daily generated fresh solid waste yields the following categorical division:

Biodegradable (Wet Fraction): 5,641.9 TPD

Dry / Recyclable Fraction: 3,574.7 TPD

Inert Elements Segment: 1,010.4 TPD

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CURRENT PROCESSING CAPACITIES:

That active processing infrastructure interventions are restricted to the following operational parameters.

Active Composting Intake: 1,521.35 TPD of fresh wet waste resulting in 381.50 TPD of finished compost for agricultural use.

Capacity of Plant : 636.25 TPD

Refuse Derived Fuel (RDF): 629.64 TPD produced from dry waste, fed directly into industrial cement plants and road construction projects.

Waste-to-Energy Processing: Thermal and methanation processing remain virtual non-existent, save for a singular unit in Kolkata Municipal Corporation processing 5 TPD of wet waste into 0.16 TPD of energy.

III. TIME-BOUND STRATEGIC ACTION PLAN TO BRIDGE THE DEFICIT

To eliminate the processing gap in waste generation of 8,069.4 TPD, time-bound statutory action plan has been enforced upon all deficient ULBs with targets staggered between June, 2026 and December, 2027.

Infrastructure installations are actively underway across majority of municipalities with targeted commissioning on June, 2026, December, 2026, and March, 2027.

Heavy-volume Municipal Corporations, specifically Kolkata Municipal Corporation, Howrah Municipal Corporation are legally bound to complete construction and achieve full processing parity by June, 2027 to December, 2027.

For critical sites lagging behind in preliminary phases of land identification



respective district administrations have been issued direct orders to finalize land parcels immediately.

IV. LIQUID WASTE MANAGEMENT

That the Kolkata Metropolitan Development Authority (KMDA) has reported that the newly constructed STPs which are tendered after 2019 are compliant with the standard set by Hon'ble National Green Tribunal. Old STPs are compliant with the standard set by MOEF&CC vide its Notification dated 13.10.2017. KMDA has planned for setting up of STPs/FSTPs for the projected population in the year 2037 for mitigating the gap in a phased manner. Details of daily liquid waste (sewage) generation, installed treatment capacities of existing Sewage Treatment Plants (STPs), capacity utilization, existing treatment gaps, and ongoing or future mitigation plans across nine key districts/urban areas under KMDA jurisdiction are enclosed in the report.

Further an Advisory has been issued by UD&MA Department on 12.06.2025 to map the existing functional STPs to the adjacent ULBs for sewage and septage to be transported to the STPs mapped for better and optimal utilization of functional STPs and to stop open dumping of sewage and septage.

The water quality data of West Bengal Pollution Control Board for the month of March, 2026 shows remarkable improvement for river Ganga. It is now placed in the least priority category i.e. Category-V.

Biological Oxygen Dissolved (BOD) level for the entire stretch of Ganga is below

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3 mg/l. The BOD has dropped significantly from 12mg/l to 2.95mg/l. As per the latest report polluted river stretch came down from 13 to 11, with delisting of 6 river stretches.

Copy of the report of the solid and liquid waste of Urban Development & Municipal Affairs Department is marked and annexed as Annexure R/1(colly).

V. That in compliance with the directives of this Hon'ble Tribunal, a single dedicated Ring Fence Account system has been created with a fund of Rs 35,00,00,000 /- in accordance with Finance Department, Government of West Bengal U.O. No. 3407 dated 28.10.2022, for implementation of solid and liquid waste management across all Urban Local Bodies in the State. The total amount utilized from the said Ring Fence Account for the stated purpose is Rs.426,13,26,320/- (Four hundred twenty six crore thirteen lakh twenty six thousand three hundred twenty).

Copy of the report of the Ring fenced Account is marked and annexed as Annexure R/2.

VI. That in pursuance of the directions this Hon'ble Tribunal dated 27.04.2026, the Panchayats and Rural Development Department has deposited the cost of Rs 10,000/- with NGT Bar Association vide Memo No.959/ENV-15016/1/2023 dated 17.06.2026 .

The Panchayats and Rural Development Department has provided detail report

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RURAL SOLID WASTE GENERATORS

Regular solid waste collection takes place at all Gram Panchayats and transported to Solid Waste Units / Material Recovery Facility / Central Processing Unit / Plastic Waste Management Unit.

BIODEGRADABLE WASTE PROCESSING (COMPOSTING)

Gram Panchayats utilize distinct, decentralized biological treatment methods:

- **Vermi-composting / Organic composting:** Used by the majority of GPs (e.g., Cooch Behar, Dakshin Dinajpur, Purba Medinipur).
- **Windrow Composting:** Used at Howrah (Radhapur, Basudevpur, Dakshin Jhapardaha) and Nadia (Ruipukur, Anulia, Karimpur-1)
- **Aerobic Composting:** Highly successful in Hooghly (Rajbalhat-I, Chandrahati-I, Shripur-Balagarh), utilized in local crop cultivation.
- **Anerobic Composting:** Highly successful in Jalpaiguri (Kharija, Berubari-1, Khagrabari-II Sulkapara), utilized as manure.

Composts are actively sold to local tea gardens, farmers, nurseries, and government departments, or distributed to schools for kitchen gardens.

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DRY & PLASTIC WASTE PROCESSING ("OTHER PROCESSING")

Rural West Bengal has developed a robust system for routing plastic waste into infrastructure projects:

- **Shredding & Bituminous Road Construction:** Segregated plastic waste (PET, HDPE, LDPE, PP, MLP) is sent to Plastic Waste Management Units (PWMUs) for shredding and baling. The processed plastic is then integrated directly into bituminous road construction.
- **Eco-Bricks:** Gitabaling (Kalimpong) converts non-recyclable plastics into eco-bricks for local construction.
- **Diaper & Sanitary Napkin Management:** North 24 Parganas processes highly hazardous sanitary waste via dedicated, localized incinerators.

The Panchayats and Rural Development Department has officially replaced individual GP SBM (G) bank accounts with the centralized state-level SNA-SPARSH system.

Report of waste generation, composting method and utilization, other processing waste, legacy waste dumpsite, sewage generation, sewage treatment and utilization of the Panchayat and Rural Development Department as per the format of this Hon'ble Tribunal is marked and annexed as **Annexure R/3(colly)**.

- VII. That the report of New Town Development Authority (NKDA) with regard to solid waste and sewage management is stated below:

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Solid Waste Management

I. Daily Statistics:

- **Total Waste Generation:** 135 TPD (Tons Per Day)
- **Total Waste Collected:** 135 TPD
- **Waste Transported:** 127 TPD
- **Final Destination:** Dhapa Dumping Ground (KMC)

II. Waste Composition:

- **Biodegradable:** 83.7 TPD (62.0%)
- **Dry/Recyclable:** 46.17 TPD (34.2%)
- **Inserts:** 5.13 TPD (3.8%)



III. Waste Processing (Waste to Energy):

- **Plant Capacity:** 5.0 TPD
- **Daily Inputs:** 8.0 TPD (Sourced from residential areas, hotels, and markets)
- **Output:** 61.0 KW of energy
- **Residue Management:** Disposed of at the dumping ground
- To address the gap in waste generation and processing, NKDA has a time-bound plan to establish 200 TPD Bio-gas CBG (Compressed Biogas) Plant and 125 TPD MRF (Material Recovery Facility) + RDF (Refuse Derived Fuel) Plant within the next 2 to 3 years (funded by the CITIIS 2.0 program by NIUA and State/NKDA funds):

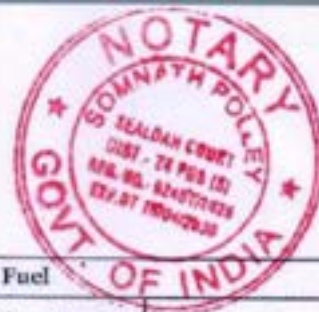

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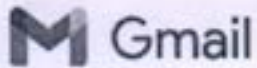

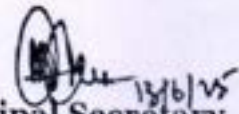

ADVISORY

This Department under different schemes has set up & commissioned Sewage Treatment Plants (STPs) at different ULBs. As per the reports, all the STPs have been commissioned and functional but are operating at a sub-optimal level due to inadequate feed coming to the plants.

- (2) At the same time, there are Municipalities adjacent to the location of the functional STPs where there is neither a STP nor a Faecal Sludge Treatment Plant (FSTP).
- (3) After careful consideration, it has been decided to map the existing functional STPs to the adjacent ULB(s) for the sewage and septage to be transported to the STPs mapped for better and optimum utilisation of the functional STPs and at the same time open dumping of sewage and septage can also be stopped. The STP-wise mapping of the ULBs is annexed.
- (4) The sewage and septage are to be transported to the designated STP by Cess Pools. ULB-wise STPs mapped is annexed.
- (5) This arrangement shall continue till such time a functional Liquid Waste Management facility is set up at the tagged ULBs.
- (6) This arrangement shall take immediate effect.
