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Minutes of the meeting of the State Level Task Force on Solid Waste Management for Cluster-II Project covering Bidhannagar MC, NKDA, NDITA & part of Kolkata MC.

Date: 19.08.2020

Time: 4:00 pm onwards

Venue: 2nd Floor Conference Hall at SUDA

Price Water House Coopers joined the meeting on webinar.

Director, SUDA chaired the meeting.

The members initially had a discussion with the Price Water House Coopers (PWHC), the Transaction Adviser engaged by SUDA to prepare the draft DPR of Cluster-II. PWHC Officials briefed the house on their proposition for scientific management of solid waste for Bidhannagar MC, NKDA, NDITA & part of Kolkata MC. The following facts are put on record.

- (1) As decided by the UD & MA Department, the processing of the legacy waste of 'Mollar Bheri' of Bidhannagar MC has been tendered out by Bidhannagar MC separately. The 3rd call is currently under evaluation and likely to be finalised shortly.
- (2) Legacy waste for KMC is any way being processed at the Dhapa Dumping Ground. Bids have been opened for a recent tender invited by KMC. It is understood that the financial evaluation is currently under way and will be submitted to the UD & MA Department for approval shortly.
- (3) NKDA & NDITA presently do not have any dumping ground.
- (4) 20 acres of land has been identified at Mouza-Patharghata, Rajarhat for the processing of fresh waste, (i) wet waste (organic waste), (ii) dry waste (in-organic waste) & (iii) construction & demolition waste. UD & MA Department has entrusted KMC as the Nodal Agency for the Patharghata project as part of Cluster-II for execution.
- (5) KMC invited tenders to set up and operate a 500 TPD 'Construction & Demolition Waste' processing plant. Only one bid received. KMC to process further.
- (6) KMC has also invited tenders to set up and operate a 300 TPD 'Material Recovery Facility (MRF)' at Patharghata.

The members took note of the present status as noted above and after detail deliberations proposed a set of decision points.

- (1) Considering the proximity of the Patharghata site to the Netaji Subhas Chandra Bose International Airport, Kolkata, the members suggested that neither bio-compost nor bio-methanation is to be planned at the Patharghata site as this might affect movement of air traffic.
- (2) The 'Construction & Demolition (C&D) Waste' of 500 TPD capacity will be used to process major portion of KMC C&D Waste along with BMC, NKDA and NDITA also.
- (3) The tender invited by KMC for setting up and operation of 300 TPD MRF will have to be augmented through a double shift arrangement and/ or with physical augmentation of

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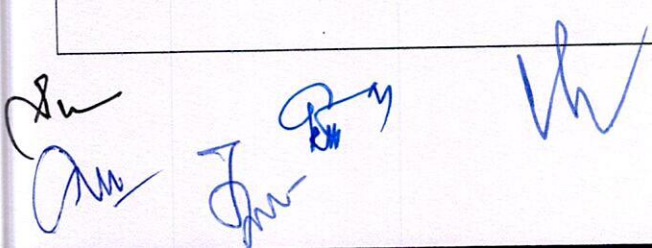
capacity based on an assessment of the quantity of Dry Waste expected to be generated by BMC, NDITA, NKDA. The capacity & the operational plan of the MRF to be finalised accordingly.

- (4) The scope of the tender invited by KMC to set up and operate the MRF, includes the primary collection of the dry waste from the households with their vehicles, upto the secondary transfer points designated by KMC. The scope of the work also includes the IEC/ IPC campaign upto the household for segregation of waste.
- (5) In view of 4 (four) above, BMC, NKDA and NDITA were requested to deliberate and come back with the feedback within the next 7 (seven) days, as to whether they would also like to follow the same model as has been envisaged by KMC for setting up and operating the MRF with the similar scope of work.
- (6) Pending the feedback, KMC has been requested to extend the last date & time for online submission of bids by another 15 days.
- (7) The fresh organic (wet) waste of BMC, NKDA and NDITA may be processed at the bio-compost facility of KMC at Dhapa. Feasibility of augmentation of atleast 500 TPD needs to be explored. The proposal for augmentation of existing compost plant at Dhapa and setting up of other MSW processing projects on the land reclaimed through Bio- mining of legacy waste at Dhapa has to be sent to East Kolkata Wetlands (EKW) authority for approval.
- (8) In the earlier Agreement, it was mentioned that the Patharghata land can be used for Waste to Energy and Sanitary Landfill projects only and division of land was restricted. A Cabinet approval is required for utilising the land for other projects viz. C&D Waste Processing Plant, Setting up of MRF projects and other proposed MSW processing projects.
- (9) A scientific landfill for disposing off the inert/reject material from the processing plants is immediately required.
- (10) The utility services like water supply, road construction, drainage and electricity arrangement etc outside the periphery of the Patharghata land needs to be arranged by NKDA.
- (11) The Processing Fee/Tipping Fee, Development Fee (if any) and Lease Rent required for setting up the MSW processing units at Patharghata will be shared by all the ULBs proportionately.
- (12) The Committee will further deliberate on the projects planned for Cluster-II after the action points suggested above are taken by the concerned authorities.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to and from the Chair.
