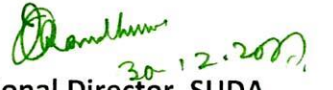

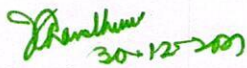

Minutes of the 36th Meeting of State Level Task Force on Solid waste management for discussion on several issues of Solid Waste Management

In the Chair : Director, SUDA

Meeting Date : 31st December, 2021

Director, State Urban Development Agency (SUDA) chaired the meeting.

At the outset, he welcomed all the members and explained the discussion points of the meeting. After detailed deliberation among the members and following decisions were taken.

1. In the 35th Meeting of SLTF, the Committee noted that Bidhannagar MC has submitted a proposal for allotment of fund for procurement of equipments/ machineries alongwith annual maintenance charge with total project cost of Rs.8.18 crore including procurement of 2 stationary compactors. As per decision of that meeting, the Commissioner, Bidhannagar MC attended the present meeting of SLTF for further discussion. The discussion and decision are as under:

A. Sewer system and Drain Cleaning

- ✓ Bidhannagar MC has submitted proposal for thorough cleaning of 7 sectors of BMC constituting 3 sectors of erstwhile Bidhannagar Municipality where sewerage line clearing is required, open drain cleaning of Bidhannagar area in 3 sectors and cleaning of drains in 1 sector located in Rajarhat area.
- ✓ It was estimated that for cleaning of each sector an average of Rs.50 lakh is required. Therefore, a total of Rs.3.5 crore required for this thorough cleaning.
- ✓ The Committee recommended that:
 - Bidhannagar MC will prepare the tender document with in 10.01.2022 and share the draft with Prof. Arunabha Majumder and Dr Tapas Kumar Gupta for necessary concurrence and kind inputs.
 - The tender should be floated immediately after Municipal Elections followed by engagement of the agency. The work should be completed between 15th March to 15th May, 2022.
 - The tender document should include specific time frame for disposal of sludge of drains and cleaning of master taps of sewer line.
 - The SLTF will form a Sub-Committee for supervision and monitoring the work.

B. Drain Cleaning Machine

- ✓ The Committee was informed that Bidhannagar MC has 2 Suction Machines and 2 Suction cum Jetting Machines, which require major repair. The Committee recommended that Bidhannagar MC may repair these 4 machines and the required fund may be provided from the UD&MA Department.
- ✓ Bidhannagar MC proposed that they require 2 more Suction Machines, 2 more Suction cum Jetting Machines and 4 Dumpers. The Committee recommended that instead of procurement of these machines and vehicles, Bidhannagar MC may go for hiring 5 years' mode through open tender. The Committee further recommended that Bidhannagar MC to arrange a pre-tender meeting to be conducted at Bidhannagar MC to understand the pulse of the bidders.

C. Repairing of Sewerage and drainage pumping stations:

- ✓ The Committee noted that Bidhannagar MC had submitted a project for repairing of their 8 sewerage pumping station and one drainage pumping station with total project cost of Rs.8.5 crore to KMDA for vetting. The Committee resolved that the concerned Engineer of Bidhannagar MC will pursue the same with KMDA to expedite the vetting process.
- ✓ The Committee recommended that Bidhannagar MC may strengthen their Electro-Mechanical wing by way of engaging retired experienced Mechanical Engineers on contract with the approval of the UD&MA Department.

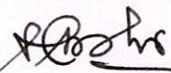
D. Safety Kit for drain cleaning workers:

- ✓ The Committee noted that Bidhannagar MC desires to provide safety kit to their 90 drain cleaning workers, for which Rs.10.73 lakh is required approximately. The Committee recommended that Bidhannagar MC may submit a proposal to UD&MA Department for sanction of fund.

2. The Committee noted that as an interim arrangement, Bidhannagar MC is disposing their municipal solid waste at Dhapa dumping ground of Kolkata MC in a mixed manner. The Commissioner, Bidhannagar MC stated that they can ensure segregation of waste at source in all wards, if sufficient/ demarcated space provided at Dhapa for disposal of dry waste and wet waste separately. The Committee discussed that Bidhannagar MC may disposed wet waste at Dhapa and dry waste at Patharghata, Newtown, and the already existing wet waste composting agency – M/s Eastern Organic Fertilizer Pvt. Ltd. may be requested to augment their capacity to process the wet waste. The committee recommended that organize a meeting with Kolkata MC, Bidhannagar MC, NKDA, NDITA and M/s Eastern Organic Fertilizer Pvt. Ltd. might be organized in presence of SLTF members for detailed discussion and decision in this regard. The meeting may be convened after 15.01.2022.
3. The Committee desired to visit the Bio-Methanation plant of NKDA on 05.01.2022, 2nd half.

4. The Committee was informed that a team of official comprising Sri Amitava Das, Deputy Director, SUDA, Sri Dipak Naskar, EE, SUDA and Sri Bijay Krishna Pal, EE, KMDA visited the 4 hill towns – Darjeeling, Kurseong, Kalimpong and Mirik. Their observations are placed below:
- ✓ As temperature of these towns falls below 10 degree Celsius, only aerobic decomposition is possible in these areas.
 - ✓ Following 3 options may be adopted for wet waste processing in place of Central Processing Unit for the whole town:
 - Home Composting: Through pit/ vermi composting.
 - Vessel Composting with an additional requirement of air blower in decentralized places.
 - In some places windrow composting may be adopted.
 - ✓ An orientation may be organized for Micro Planning/ Facilitation Organizations on home composting/ vessel composting within 31st January, 2022.
5. The Committee noted that the UD&MA Department has given in principle approval for inclusion of Panihati Municipality with Promodhnagar-Kamarhati Cluster Project (Cluster-1).
6. The Committee approved and signed the SWM DPR of 34 ULBs i.e. Dainhat, Gushkara, Kalna, Katwa, Memari, Bolpur, Balurghat, Buniadpur, Gangarampore, Darjeeling, Kalimpong, Kurseong, Mirik, English Bazar, Old Malda, Beldanga, Dhuliyan, Domkal, Jangipur, Kandi, Bhatpara, Bongaon, Garulia, Naihati, North Barrackpore, Chandrakona, Ghatal, Jhargram, Kharar, Khirpai, Ramjibanpur, Contai, Egra and Panskura.
7. The Committee noted that in the tender for biomining and bio remediation of legacy waste at 9 dumpsites of 8 ULBs i.e. Chandrakona, Chakdah, Katwa, Kharar (2), Ramjibanpur, Contai, Alipurduar and Jhalda at 2nd call 2 bidders – M/s Peoples Association for Total Help & Youth Applause and M/s Rohini Fire Safety Pvt. Ltd. have participated and after technical evaluation both the bidders have qualified. Accordingly the Committee recommended opening of the financial bid for evaluation.

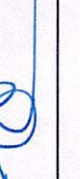
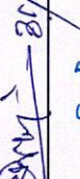
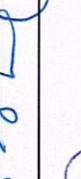
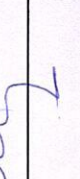
With no other issue for discussion the meeting ended with vote of thanks to and from the chair.
