for discussion on DPR issues and others**

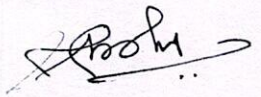
Director, State Urban Development Agency (SUDA) chaired the meeting.

At the outset, he welcomed all the members present and explained the discussion points of the meeting. A threadbare discussion was held regarding the agenda points and following decisions were taken:

1. The Committee has approved the DPR on Solid Waste Management for fresh waste management of Cluster-3 project comprising Ashoknagar-Kalyangarh, Habra and Gobardanga Municipality and all the present members have signed on it.
2. The Committee has approved the DPR on Legacy waste Management for 9 Dumpsites of 8 ULBs i.e. Chandrakona, Chakdah, Katwa, Kharar (2), Ramjibanpur, Contai, Alipurduar and Jhalda and all members present endorsed it.
3. The Committee noted that the model design, drawing and estimate for a 30 TPD compost and MRF plant has been prepared by SUDA and accepted the same for implementation in respective ULBs having waste generation less than or equal to 30 TPD. The Committee further recommended that the design, drawing and estimate should be made ULB specific according to the shape / area of the land available and taking into account the bearing capacity of the soil for which separate agencies may be engaged either from ULB or SUDA end for investigation of soil characteristics.
4. The Committee suggested that a special note may be prepared regarding difficulties faced by KMDA for proper disposal of RDF fractions out from existing legacy waste and forward it to West Bengal Pollution Control Board to facilitate in identification of the agencies capable to take up the RDF from different sites all over the State.
5. The Committee noted that SUDA on behalf of UD & MA Department has prepared the draft 'Action Plan' for phasing out use of Single Use Plastic (SUP) items in Urban Local Bodies of West Bengal and recommended for onward transmission to UD & MA Department for necessary approval and issuance of Govt. Order/Circular incorporating provision to empower ULBs to collect monetary penalty from defaulters and deposit the same in their ULB own fund. Sl. No. 1.2 of the draft Action Plan to be modified accordingly.
6. The Committee noted Sl. No. 2.4 & 2.5 of the above draft 'Action Plan' regarding formation of Project Management Unit (PMU) at UD & MA Deptt. and at District level. At present due to paucity of fund the Committee recommended to empower the PMU on Solid Waste Management to also act as the PMU on Plastic Waste Management as well. Sl. No. 2.4 & 2.5 of the draft Action Plan to be modified accordingly.

7. The Committee ratified the final questionnaire for survey work to inventorise the plastic product manufacturers, recyclers, users and collectors in the districts of North Bengal entrusted to Jalpaiguri Govt. Engineering College in collaboration with Jadavpur University.

With no other issue for discussion the meeting ended with vote of tanks to and from the chair.
