

Minutes of the 33rd Meeting of State Level Task Force on Solid Waste Management for discussion on tender issues of Solid Waste Management

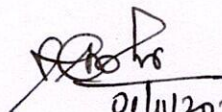
Director, State Urban Development Agency (SUDA) chaired the meeting.

The Chairman welcomed all the members present and explained the discussion points before the house. After detail deliberations the following decisions are minuted.

- (1) Based on the observation of the Finance Department, the Committee relooked at the rates offered by M/s SIMOCO Telecommunication (South Asia) Limited for fresh waste processing in response to 27 bids as the L1 bidder. After due deliberation, the Committee advised that SIMOCO Telecommunication (South Asia) Limited be requested to submit the drawing, design and estimates in connection with the rate analysis already submitted along with plant & machinery to be installed at the site for processing of fresh waste within 7th November, 2021.
- (2) It was informed before the Committee that no response received even after 3rd & 4th call for bids invited for fresh waste processing of 15 Municipalities. Committee resolved that since each of these ULBs generate less than 20 TPD of Municipal Solid waste, the processing may be done in a captive mode involving SHGs by the ULB with necessary supervision of the Micro-Planners / Facilitation Agency. Suitable SHGs are to be selected by the ULBs and they have to be imparted appropriate training by the Micro-Planners / Facilitation Agency to operate the processing facility. Necessary fund will be devolved to the ULB for both capex & opex. If no such SHG is found in the ULBs, they may require to form SHGs for the purpose & train them suitably to equip them with the requisite knowledge and skill.
- (3) The Technical Evaluation of the bids of Bansberia, Baruipur, Contai, Diamond Harbour, Joynagar Mozilpur, Kanchrapara & Midnapore Municipalities were placed before the Committee. After the Technical Evaluation, the Committee noted that:
 - ✓ For Midnapore Municipality: 5 bidders participated, out of that 3 bidders – M/s Tide Technocrats Pvt. Ltd, M/s Rohini Fire Safety Pvt. Ltd. and M/s Aayushi Hygiene and Care Pvt. Ltd. become technically qualified. Accordingly, the Committee recommended opening the financial bid for evaluation.
 - ✓ For Bansberia Municipality: 3 bidders participated, out of that 1 bidder – M/s Tide Technocrats Pvt. Ltd became technically qualified. Accordingly, the Committee recommended opening the financial bid for evaluation.

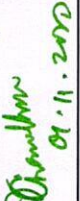
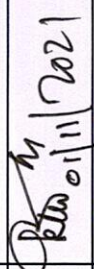
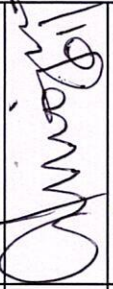
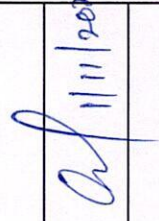
- ✓ For Kanchrapara Municipality: 3 bidders participated, out of that 1 bidder – M/s Tide Technocrats Pvt. Ltd became technically qualified. Accordingly, the Committee recommended opening the financial bid for evaluation
 - ✓ For Baruipur Municipality: 2 bidders participated, out of that 1 bidder – M/s Tide Technocrats Pvt. Ltd has become technically qualified. Accordingly, the Committee recommended opening the financial bid for evaluation
 - ✓ For Diamond Harbour and Joynagar Mozilpur Municipalities : After technical evaluation it was found that no bidders could qualify technically. The Committee further observed that as the generation of waste of these 2 ULBs is less than 30 TPD therefore the Committee recommended to execute the processing in SHG mode.
 - ✓ For Contai Municipality: Even after the 4th call, it was found that no bidder could qualify the technical parameters. Since the generation of MSW in the ULBs is more than 30 TPD, the Committee recommended invitation of 4th call.
- (4) The Committee recommended that fresh call to be invited for processing of legacy waste at Tarakeswar & Arambagh Municipalities.
- (5) It was decided that a joint team from SUDA and KMDA would visit all the 4 Municipalities situated in the hills of the State to evaluate the present status of fresh & legacy waste disposal. Tentatively the visit may take place 12th November, 2021.
- (6) The Committee noted that tender for biomining and bio remediation of legacy waste at 9 dumpsites of 8 ULBs i.e. Chandrakona, Chakdah, Katwa, Kharar (2), Ramjibanpur, Contai, Alipurduar and Jhalda were floated and in the 1st call no bidders participated. Accordingly the Committee recommended inviting 2nd call.
- (7) The Committee further requested WBPCB to share the list of plastic recyclers empanelled, so that the list may be shared with the ULBs for due endorsement to permit collection of plastic waste generated at the ULBs. Further, as part of the Extended Producers Responsibility (EPR) a number of Companies from outside the State were approaching the ULBs for collection and processing of the plastic waste. All such applications may be placed before the Committee for appraisal and further recommendation.

With no other issue for discussion the meeting ended with vote of tanks to and from the chair.
