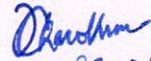

Minutes of the 10th meeting of State Level Technical Committee (SLTC) regarding review and sanction of the projects to be implemented under SBM / MNB-U 2.0.

In the Chair: Additional Chief Secretary, UD & MA Department

Meeting Date: 26th May, 2026

Additional Chief Secretary, UD & MA Department chaired the meeting.

At the outset, a discussion was held regarding several activities of Swachh Bharat Mission.

The Committee observed that :

1. Under SBM-U 2.0, NARC in its 9th Meeting held on 08.06.2023 approved 28768 IHHL with total project cost of Rs.86.30 cr. out of which Central Share is 11.51 cr. and State Share is 74.79 cr.
2. Similarly in 11th Meeting of NARC held on 05.01.2024 approved 6 (six) C&D Waste Processing Plant for Durgapur MC, Siliguri MC, Asansol MC, Howrah MC, Barrackpore Municipality and Haldia Municipality with total capacity of 355 TPD and total project cost of Rs.21 cr. out of that Central share is Rs.6cr. and State Share is Rs.15 cr.

After threadbare discussion, the Committee recommended that

- a) Due to saturation of requirement of IHHL, Govt. of India may be requested to allow utilization of that fund for the purpose of construction of further requirement of 100 Community Toilets and 100 Public Toilets (each having 6 Toilet Seats and 6 Urinal Seats) by the ULBs.
- b) As the construction and demolition waste of the ULBs are being generated in very small amount and being utilized for several purpose like road construction, river bank protection and filling the foundation of newly constructed buildings, Govt. of India may be requested to allow utilization of that fund for the purpose of bio mining and bio remediation of legacy waste of 3 (three) ULBs over the quantity approved by NARC.
