

**Minutes of the 81st Meeting of State Level Task Force on Solid Waste Management
for discussion on several issues of solid waste management**

Director, State Urban Development Agency (SUDA) chaired the meeting.

At the outset, he welcomed all the members present and explained the discussion points of the meeting. After threadbare discussion the following decisions were arrived at:

1. Dr. Partha Sarathi Ghosal, Assistant Professor, School of Water Resources Indian Institute of Technology Kharagpur made a presentation on their model for setting up of Faecal Sludge Management Plant before the Committee, which is being implemented mostly in the rural areas of West Bengal. Already 30 plants are under construction and 23 plants are in tendering stage. Approximately the project cost of 30 KLD FSTP comes to Rs.1.49 crore and the requirement of land is 300-600 sq. mt. The Committee recommended that
 - i. Under the Chairmanship of Dr. Arunabha Majumder, Ex. Director - Professor & Head, Sanitary Engineering Department, All India Institute of Hygiene and Public Health, a team of Engineers of SUDA and KMDA will visit to one of the operational plant of FSTP constructed under the guidance of IIT, Kharagpur within next week.
 - ii. An in-house exercise may be worked out for the ULBs of West Bengal to plan for requirement of construction of STP and co-treatment of FSTP.
2. The Committee noted that SUDA has floated the tender viz. 'Disposal of legacy waste through Bio-remediation and Bio-mining process to reclaim the land of dump site utilizing scientific method' for 8 ULBs separately (Bhadreswar, Bongaon, Gushkara, Jalpaiguri, Kalna, Kanchrapara, Krishnanagar and Ranaghat) under Swachh Bharat Mission (U)/Mission Nirmal

Bangla (U) on 05.02.2026. The Pre-bid meeting was held on 18.02.2026, where some queries raised by the prospective bidders. After threadbare discussion, the Committee recommended the following:

The Committee noted that Kolkata MC vide e-file KMC-80/63/2024-SWM1 SECTION-KMC informed that they have entered into an agreement with M/s Eastern Organic Fertilizer Pvt. Ltd. (EOFPL) on 26.04.2010 for operation of the 500 TPD compost plant at Dhapa. The original agreement expired on 15th June, 2025 and has since been extended twice, each for a period of six months. The present extension remains valid up to 15th June, 2026. Under the prevailing contractual arrangement, KMC does not pay any tipping fee to the operator. Instead, the Corporation receives royalty and lease rent from the agency. KMC has submitted the proposal to augment its capacity from 500 TPD to 1000 TPD, applying the same financial and contractual model within the limitation of existing allotted land. KMC has also mentioned to comply with Environmental Compliance, like-

- Regulations of the East Kolkata Wetlands Management Authority (EKWMA)
- Obligations under the Ramsar Convention
- Directions of the Hon'ble National Green Tribunal (NGT)

- Environmental Clearance and Consent conditions issued by competent authorities
- Compliance with the Solid Waste Management Rules, 2016

KMC has now sought concurrence of the department regarding:

1. Whether the existing work may continue (up to a maximum of 5 years through six-monthly extensions) pending fresh tender, subject to satisfactory performance and SWM Rules, 2016 compliance.
2. Whether augmentation from 500 TPD to 1000 TPD may be permitted and the mode of procurement.
3. Whether the same financial and contractual terms should uniformly apply to the full 1000 TPD.
4. Safeguards to ensure environmental and audit compliance.

In view of the above, UD& MA Department obtained the opinion of State Level Task Force (SLTF) on the above mentioned 1 to 3 points.

After detailed discussion, the Committee is of the view that the matter may be taken up with the Financial Advisor in the UD&MA Department and the Law Cell of the Department.

With no other issue for discussion the meeting ended with vote of thanks to and from the chair.
