Madam/ Sir,

This is in reference to the various orders of Hon'ble Supreme Court in the aforesaid matter, decisions taken in the meetings of SCMC and the above referred directions/letters issued by MoEF&CC and SCMC to Chief Secretaries/ Administrators of respective State /UT for compliance of various actions as mentioned therein.

Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs (MoHUA) has developed a dedicated portal namely Swacchatam Portal vide which information/progress with respect to creation of Special Cells in State/ UTs, legacy dumpsites, monitoring of legacy waste remediation, notification of bye-laws as per SWM



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rules, 2026 etc. are envisaged to be captured and reported to the Hon'ble Supreme Court.

Besides this, there are other Action Taken Report (ATR)/updated status with respect to the directions of the Hon'ble Supreme Court vide Orders dated 19.02.2026, 05.05.2026 and 25.05.2026, as well as direction issued by SCMC & MoEF&CC, which are to be complied for SCMC report preparation. In order to compile the same, a format comprising of details of such directions of Hon'ble Supreme Court, SCMC & MoE&CC and submitting Action Taken Report (ATR)/updated status by States/UTs are enclosed as Annexure-I.

It is requested to kindly submit the ATR/updated status as per the enclosed format as at Annexure-I to the SCMC by 24.07.2026 to enable the SCMC in compiling the information and preparing its report for timely filing before the Hon'ble Supreme Court. It is also kindly informed that in case the said ATR/updated status is not received by 24.07.2026, the compliance shall be reported as pending from State/ UT in the report to be filed by the SCMC before the Hon'ble Supreme Court.
