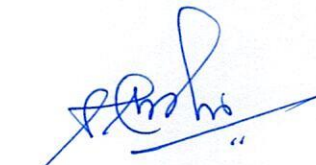
Director, SUDA chaired the meeting of the State Level Task Force (SLTF). Mr. A.K.Gupta, Additional Director, Regional Centre for Urban & Environmental Studies, Lucknow, Government of India alongwith Shri Gyan Prakash Mishra and Mr. Punit Babbar were also present. After detail discussions the following decisions are put on record.

- (1) Power Department may be requested to share a policy regarding evacuation of power generated by a concessionaire from the waste to energy plant at Baidyabati to the nearest sub-station regarding the cost to be borne by the Power Department/ WBSEDCL or the concessionaire awarded the contract. Accordingly the RFP is to be drafted.
- (2) Power Department to share the model Power Purchase Agreement (PPA) to be place before the West Bengal Electricity Regulatory Authority and subsequently incorporated in RfP for integrated solid waste management for Howrah MCand Bally Municipality.
- (3) The power tariff to be arrived as there is no notified tariff for purchase of power from RDF. There is an existing tariff for purchase of power from SWM fixed way back in 2013 and needs to be revisited. The Central Electricity Regularity Commission has already an existing maximum ceiling tariff for generation of power from RDF and MSW fixed in 2015 @ Rs.7.94 and Rs.7.05 respectively. A tariff for purchase of power from RDF and MSW need to be finalized by West Bengal Electricity Regulatory Commission in line with Central Electricity Regulatory Commission.
- (4) A tipping fee to be considered for the projects for Howrah and Bally as a integrated solid waste management model which is inclusive of the secondary transportation to the processing of MSW. The primary collection of segregated waste and transportation shall be with the concerned ULBs.



- (5) The bidding parameter for the Howrah and Bally may be a hybrid of both power tariff and tipping fee wherein the tipping fee to be fixed based on Techno Economic feasibility study.
- (6) Other than Howrah MC & Bally Municipality segregated waste (dry waste) of the 13 ULBs of Hooghly may be delivered at the proposed waste to energy plant at Baidyabati.
- (7) Given the constraint of land both at the dump site of the Howrah MC & Bally Municipality, we may consider processing of the wet waste through an appropriate technology viz. biomethanation as an option.
- (8) KMDA may initiate the process to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding with Regional Centre for Urban & Environmental Studies, Lucknow, an Institute under the Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs, GOI on nomination basis as a technical consultant with the scope upto the signing of the concessionaire agreement and to be extended as a Project Management Consultant subsequently.
- (9) The setting up of waste to energy plant is contingent of viability gap funding to be borne by the State / GOI. Concession period may be for atleast 20 years.
