

**Minutes of the 46th Meeting of State Level Task Force on Solid Waste Management
for discussion on several issues of solid waste management**

Director, State Urban Development Agency (SUDA) chaired the meeting.

At the outset, he welcomed all the members present and explained the discussion points of the meeting. A threadbare discussion was held regarding the agenda points and following decisions were taken:

1. SLTF had recommended earlier to process the fresh waste of 47 ULBs (whose generation of waste is below 30 MT) through SHG mode. A presentation was made before the Committee on the DPR prepared for setting up fresh waste processing plant to be operated through SHGs. The Committee has recommended the DPR for implementation after the technical vetting of MED. The Committee has further recommended to workout a solution for setting up sanitary landfill site. The representative of WBPCB mentioned that consent to establish and consent to operate for processing plant shall be taken from WBPCB and for setting up of common sanitary landfill site environmental clearance shall be taken.
2. Respective District Magistrates shall be approached to identify/ provide land for setting up common SLF.
3. Towards the proposal of Bidhannagar MC for extension of time for 11 months (From August, 2022 to June, 2023) to the biomining agency for completion of bio mining and bio remediation of legacy waste of Mollar Bheri of Bidhannagar MC, the Committee has recommended the same.
4. At present Bidhannagar MC is disposing their collected waste at Dhapa of Kolkata MC. As an alternative site, Bidhannagar may take following options for disposal of waste:
 - ✓ At the Bio-methanation site of NKDA at Newtown, may dispose and process wet waste of Hotels, Restaurants etc in small scale.
 - ✓ UD & MA Department has provided a land to Bidhannagar MC at Bonobitan. That land they may be used for disposal and processing of fresh waste.
 - ✓ One Mouza of Mollar Bheri area is permissible to set up processing plant. Commissioner, Bidhannagar MC requested to approach District Magistrate, North 24 Parganas for demarcation of the Mouza boundary where Bidhannagar MC may set up SWM processing facilities in consonance with Solid Waste Management Rules, 2016.
5. For extension of the time period of the biomining agency of Dhapa, Kolkata MC will submit a proposal.
6. A proposal was forwarded to Finance Department, GoWB to create a budgetary/ allocation for operation and maintenance of SWM activities of the ULBs like fuel of and repair of the vehicles. Finance Department is not willing to provide separate grant for this purpose and hence declined to



open separate head for this grant. The matter was discussed among the Committee members and it was decided that State Government may further be approached to create a corpus fund for this purpose.

7. The Gangasagar Bakkhali Development Authority (GBDA) approached Director, SUDA to provide technical and financial support for solid waste management activities of Bakkhali area covering 10 Mouzas having population about 60000 and households about 10000. Total generation of waste at peak season is 21 MTD and in normal time 9 MTD. The matter was placed before the Committee and the following recommendation were made:

- ✓ Permission has to be sought from CRZ authority for utilization of the land available with the Collector, South 24 Parganas for setting up of fresh waste processing plant. For this GBDA will sent a letter to SUDA providing land details and SUDA in turn will submit the same to the CRZ authority for permission. In the meanwhile, GBDA will search for alternative site, in case permission is not granted from CRZ authority.
- ✓ Since the jurisdiction of GBDA covers Panchayat areas of 2 Blocks, Namkhala & Sagar of South 24 Parganas, the committee opine that Panchayat & Rural Development Department may also be requested for sharing of fund to set up the Solid Waste Processing Plant.
- ✓ SUDA will engage a micro planning organization(s) for preparing the DPR (for both Liquid & Solid Waste Management).
- ✓ As the area is predominantly rural, hence composting (vermi composting/ home composting) for wet waste processing is suitable and a separate MRF may be constructed for dry waste processing.
- ✓ For Liquid Waste Management the best solution is kitchen garden, soak pit, small bore sewer for densely populated areas. Low technology natural system should be used.
- ✓ SUDA will issue a separate guideline to GBDA for actions (roadmap) to be taken up in the interim period till finalization and sanction of DPR, considering declaration of no plastic zone, starting segregation of waste at source within 1st January, 2023, prohibiting littering in the beach area etc.

8. KMDA shall publish the second call of Howrah MC for engagement of agency for biomining and bioremediation of legacy waste within 04.11.2022.
9. KMDA will float the tender of Kharagpur Municipality for engagement of agency for biomining and bioremediation of legacy waste of additional quantity within 04.11.2022.
10. KMDA had floated the tender of Bally Municipality for engagement of agency for biomining and bioremediation of legacy waste, where 3 bidders have submitted their bids. It was decided that within 10.11.2022 the technical bid shall be finalized.
11. As the draft DPRs of Cluster-5, Cluster-6 & Cluster-7 submitted by the Transaction Advisor KPMG cannot be accepted hence no further payment can be released.
12. M/s Tide Technocrats Pvt. Ltd. has submitted the layout plan and project report for setting up fresh waste processing plant at Kanchrapara, Bansberia, Medinipur and Baruipur. The Committee has approved the same and directed to submit the drawing and design.
13. A presentation was made on the SoP prepared for the maintenance of pedal tri cycle before the Committee and the Committee recommended to circulate the same to all the ULBs for proper maintenance of the PTCs.



14. SUDA had procured Battery Operated Tipper and Compactor for the ULBs of West Bengal for secondary collection/ transportation of solid waste. But as per the Solid Waste Management Rules, 2016 use of Compactors are not permissible. For Battery Operated Tippers (BOT) there functionality has been reported as unsatisfactory for most ULBs.

At present the ULBs have started procuring secondary vehicle like Battery Operated Tipper and Compactor from their 15th Finance Commission grant, hence considering the above observations, the Committee recommended to issue a direction to the ULBs not to procure Battery Operated Tipper and Compactor for secondary collection and transportation of solid waste.

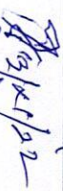
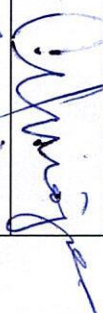
With no other issue for discussion the meeting ended with vote of thanks to and from the chair.

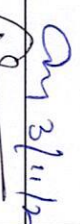
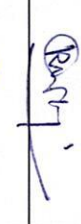
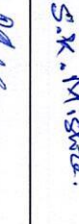
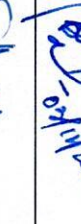
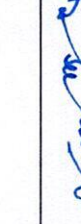
