

Minutes of the 77th Meeting of State Level Task Force on Solid Waste Management for discussion on several issues of solid waste management

Director, State Urban Development Agency (SUDA) chaired the meeting.

At the outset, he welcomed all the members present and explained the discussion points of the meeting.

After the bare discussion the following decisions were arrived at:

1. With the approval of the Department, SUDA issued AA&FS for the setting up of the 200 TPD Municipal Solid Waste Processing Plant within Barasat Municipality. MED was awarded the contracts for the implementation of the project. The Committee was apprised of the physical progress made so far and the civil & electrical works of the plant are expected to be completed within March, 2026.

After due deliberation, Committee proposed for engagement of a company/ agency for the operation & maintenance of the 200 TPD Fresh Waste Processing plant strictly complying with the guidelines of SWM Rule 2016, PWM Rule 2016, subsequent Amendments thereof along with the CPHEEO Manual and Operational Guidelines of MRF Toolkits published by MoHUA. It is needed as because at present Barasat Municipality is not in a position to operate and manage the 200 TPD plant for want of required technical and managerial expertise. Therefore the Committee recommended that :

- i. The agency may be engaged on tipping fee basis (that may be revenue positive or negative) for operation of the plant through open tender.
- ii. The procurement of machineries and equipment is to be upon Agency ; detailed specification of machineries and equipment to be required will be provided by TIA to the agency and the Agency will procure, install, commission and operate upon trial run. TIA will reimburse cost of such procurement to the Agency in a staggered manner on being duly satisfied with the quality of the machineries and equipment by a 3rd Party to be engaged by TIA who will make visit to the Plant where these machineries are manufactured and will emboss their sign on batch number.

The sub-group of the SLTF to prepare the e-RfP based on the deliverable noted above.

SUDA as the TIA may publish the e-RfP by the end of November, 2025 for the operator to be finalised by the last week of December, 2025/ first week of January, 2026 with a maximum timeline of 60 (sixty) days to make the plant functional.

2. The Committee noted that M/s NACOF, the agency awarded the contract both for bio-mining and bio-remediation of legacy waste and setting up of Fresh Waste Processing plant at Asansol Municipal Corporation has submitted a proposal vide letter no. Nil dated. 15.11.2025 with the submission to allow them to utilize some of the existing structures located at Mongolpur, Raniganj subject to structural stability to be retrofitted to take care of the partial infrastructure requirement for setting up of the Fresh Waste Processing Plant. The Committee further noted that the condition as mentioned in the e-RFP mentions that SUDA as the TIA shall 'Provide land of suitable size for setting up the plants and construction of Sanitary Landfill to the agency'. Therefore, after due consideration and deliberation, the Committee was of the view to get the existing structures inspected and examined by INSDAG, the expert third party organization already working with SUDA. On submission of the report by INSDAG regarding structural stability and safety during the entire period of Contract, the Committee to decide on the further course of action.
3. The Committee noted that M/s NACOF, the agency awarded the contract for setting up of Fresh Waste Processing Plant of Durgapur Municipal Corporation has submitted a prayer vide letter no. Nil dated. 15.11.2025 with the submission that despite the lapse of 3½ years the site could not be handed over to M/s NACOF to set up the fresh waste processing plant of Durgapur MC. The Committee further noted that the several times Durgapur MC has requested to make necessary arrangement for their land to setup the fresh waste processing plant (correspondence of Durgapur MC are enclosed) but despite several efforts it could not be arranged.
- The Committee members arrived at a consensus to rescind the contract with the agency (i.e., M/s NACOF) on the ground of non-availability of encumbrance free land and without penalising the agency as in terms of the RFP, the TIA/ULB was required to provide encumbrance free land, however, it couldn't be provided due to repeated local resistance and agitations at the site.
4. The committee noted that the DPR to set up & commissioning of integrated solid waste processing plant at Berhumpore, Jagunj-Azimgunj, Tarakeswar, Krishnanagar, Kancharapara, Raghunathpur, Bansberia & Jhalda municipalities have been sent to the Chief Engineer, South Zone, MED for technical sanction and after receiving technical sanction from MED, the committee recommended to take further action immediately.

With no other issue for discussion the meeting ended with vote of thanks to and from the chair.

Sub: Request for the allotment of land for setting up Fresh Waste Processing Unit for Solid waste Management under DMC.

Sir,

In connection with the above mentioned subject, this is to inform you that after being faced the agitations created by the local people, initially the focus had to be shifted from Shankarpur (Kaligaunj Mouja) to the U-block under Radhamadhabpur Mouja (near DPL ash pond). However, the same thing was faced at that site also as reported and thereafter a rigorous search of land again consequently, the following mentioned land is available as option.

The said land, having area approximately 33.90 acres, is situated within the Block no-11 (Mouza- Gopinathpur, J.L-85, plot-1710, area-12.006 acre), Block no-12 (Mouza- Gopinathpur, J.L-85, plot-1710, area-7.84 acre), Block no-13 [(i) Mouza- Gopinathpur, J.L-85, plot-1710, area-0.827 acre; (ii) Mouza- Birbhanpur, J.L-91, plot-102, area-5.055 acre] & Block no-25 (Mouza- Birbhanpur, J.L-91, plot-126, area-8.179 acre) (please refer the attached map), owned by Durgapur Projects Limited (DPL) which has already been inspected and found to be suitable for setting up the Fresh Waste Processing Unit. A meeting was also arranged on 02/12/2023 for the said matter in presence of the officials from District Administration, DPL, DSP and ADDA along with the officials from DMC (please refer the minutes of the meeting attached herewith). In the said meeting CM (HR & A), DPL stated that the said land has been proposed for monetization, however, it has not been settled yet and thus it may be utilized for SWM project.

In this regard it is important to mention here that there is no other land available within this city which may be suitable for the same. Besides, there is no processing unit available under this city to handle the regular waste produced by the citizens of Durgapur till date. Thus, the SWM service provided by this Corporation is presently on the verge of interruption.

Therefore, in order to run the public service in a smooth way, you are requested to make necessary arrangements so that the said land may be handed over to DMC at the earliest for early set up of SWM unit at the proposed land.

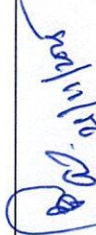
