

**Minutes of the 43rd Meeting of State Level Task Force on Solid Waste Management
for discussion on several issues of solid waste management**

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Director, State Urban Development Agency (SUDA) chaired the meeting.

At the outset, he welcomed all the members present and explained the discussion points of the meeting. A threadbare discussion was held regarding the agenda points and following decisions were taken:

1. UD&MA Department has entrusted KMDA to execute the work of biomining and bioremediation of legacy waste for Belgachia dumpsite of Howrah MC and Chandmari dumpsite of Bally Municipality. For this KMDA has prepared the RfPs for floating the e-tenders. Committee after detail discussions suggested that KMDA may convene a pre-tender meeting with all prospective bidders and obtain their inputs on the draft RfP. The feedback from the prospective bidders summarised by KMDA may be placed before the next meeting of the SLTF for consideration and further action.
2. KMDA will hand over the site of fresh waste processing unit of Bhatpara Municipality after the joint visit to be made by SUDA, KMDA and ULB shortly. The expenditure being incurred by KMDA for the security arrangement for the site to be informed to SUDA and accordingly SUDA will make the payment. In the meanwhile SUDA will publish an e-tender for engagement of agency for completion of remaining works of the fresh waste processing unit alongwith 10 years of O&M.
3. It was discussed that for processing of legacy waste at Jhargram town dump site a tender has already been invited and after 2nd call it has been found that no bidder has participated in the tender. It is apprehended that as the quantity of legacy waste is very less (around 4000 MT), prospective bidders even who are already engaged in other nearest working dump sites are not interested to participate in the tender.

In this context, to find out a rationale solution, it has been proposed that instead of further inviting a fresh tender for the processing of legacy waste at Jhargram, steps may be taken as follows:

- a) On approval from the Department, SUDA may request Jhargram Municipality to transport the legacy waste from their dump site to the dump site at Midnapore town. On submission of the actual costs towards transportation of legacy waste

from Jhargram dump site to Midnapore town dump site by Jhargram Municipality, the fund to be reimbursed by SUDA.

- b) Midnapore Municipality may be requested to allow dumping of the same waste at their dump site for processing by the existing agency.
- c) Concerned Agency engaged by KMDA for processing the legacy waste at Midnapore town, will process the carried waste of Jhargram at Midnapore town dump site with the same awarded processing rate and with the present set up at Midnapore. Additional quantity variation against the original contract will be approximately 3-4 % of the total quantity awarded to the agency and this will be well within the scope of work as per the tender. Necessary consent from the agency is also to be taken.

Accordingly matter may be placed to the competent authority for approval and further course of action.

- 4. The Committee noted that SUDA had floated the tender for engagement of agency for Fresh Waste Processing of Englishbazar and Old Malda Municipalities in a cluster mode and after the 1st call 3 (three) agencies namely – M/s Rohini Fire Safety Pvt Ltd., M/s Akanksha Enterprises and M/s Eastern Organic Fertilizer Pvt. Ltd have participated. As per recommendation at the earlier meeting, Financial Bids had been opened and it was observed that M/s Rohini Fire Safety Pvt Ltd. quoted Rs.499/- per MT, M/s Akanksha Enterprises quoted Rs.496/- per MT, and M/s Eastern Organic Fertilizer Pvt. Ltd. quoted Rs.625/- per MT. Hence, the Committee recommended that the tender may be awarded to the L-1 bidder M/s Akanksha Enterprises as per the approval to be accorded by the competent authority.

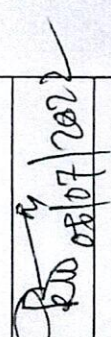
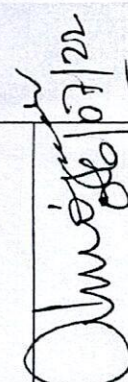
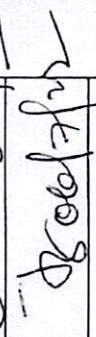
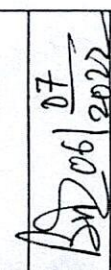
With no other issue for discussion the meeting ended with vote of tanks to and from the chair.
