

Minutes of the meeting on review on Public Health Programme

In the Chair : Director, SUDA

Meeting Date : 12th July, 2026

Meeting Venue : 3rd floor conference hall of SUDA

Meeting Time : 3.00 PM

The Director, State Urban Development Agency (SUDA), chaired an introductory meeting to review the activities being undertaken by the Health Section of SUDA. The meeting was attended by the Deputy Director, SUDA, all concerned officials of the Health Section, and the Programme Coordinator, PMAY(U).

After detailed discussions and deliberations, the following decisions were taken:

1. The construction of Urban Health & Wellness Centres (U-H&WCs) shall be undertaken by the respective implementing agencies within their jurisdictions, namely:
 - a) Bidhannagar Municipal Corporation for its jurisdiction;
 - b) Howrah Municipal Corporation for its jurisdiction;
 - c) Kolkata Municipal Corporation for its jurisdiction; and
 - d) New Town Kolkata Development Authority (NKDA) for its jurisdiction.
2. The current progress status of all Urban Health & Wellness Centres (U-H&WCs) where construction work is in progress shall be submitted to the competent authority along with recent site photographs.
3. A detailed report shall be submitted to the competent authority indicating the exact reasons for land-related issues affecting the construction of Urban Health & Wellness Centres (U-H&WCs), including the 79 sites where proposals have been cancelled due to land constraints.
4. The site-wise construction status of all Urban Primary Health Centres (U-PHCs) shall be submitted to the competent authority along with recent site photographs.
5. A comprehensive review shall be undertaken regarding the functionality of all rented Sub-Centres operating under the Urban Primary Health Care Services (UPHCS) and Comprehensive Basic Primary Health Care Services (CBPHCS).
6. It was noted that an e-file (File No. SUDA-11017(99)/4/2025-HFA SEC-SUDA; Computer No. 1190742) has been processed for the establishment of Mobile Medical Units (MMUs). The proposal envisages procurement in two stages:
 - a) Procurement of base vehicles for Mobile Medical Units through the GeM Portal; and
 - b) E-tendering for fabrication of customised Mobile Medical Units.

Feasibility of procuring fully fabricated Mobile Medical Units (MMUs) through a single procurement process, instead of procuring the base vehicles separately, should be examined and a detailed note submitted.

7. A report indicating the expenditure incurred on operating Urban Health & Wellness Centres (U-H&WCs) from rented premises shall be submitted to the competent authority.
8. The Programme Coordinator, PMAY(U) may hand over all records, data, and relevant documents pertaining to the Health Section to the Health Section for further management and record maintenance.
