Director, State Urban Development Agency and State Mission Director, Swachh Bharat Mission (Urban)/Mission Nirmal Bangla (Urban) chaired the meeting.

At the outset, the Joint Secretary, UD & MA Department, Government of West Bengal and Additional State Mission Director, SBM(U) welcomed all the members of the Committee and explained the need of the meeting held this day. He requested the Chief Engineer, S&SWM Wing, W&S Sector, KMDA to start with a brief description on the background of the Request for Proposals floated for 'Bio-mining of legacy wastes and land reclamation of dumpsites utilising scientific method located at different municipalities across West Bengal on Turnkey basis'.

With permission of the Chief Engineer, S&SWM Wing, W&S Sector, KMDA, the Superintending Engineer, North Circle of the same Wing in KMDA and the RfP Inviting Authority started the meeting with a short description on the 29 Request for Proposals floated for 69 Urban Local Bodies. He had mentioned that 29 electronic-RfPs had been floated by him for 29 clusters having 69 ULBs located at different parts of the state, aiming to remove a total of 33,50,376 MT of year-old dumped legacy waste through Bio-Mining.

The RfPs were published at the Government of West Bengal website: www.wbtenders.gov.in on 18.03.2020, with a Nationwide News Paper publication on 18.03.2020, at i) Bartaman, ii) Akbar-e-Mashriq, iii) Millennium Post, iv) Sanmarg and v) Times of India. Due to COVID-19 pandemic the pre-bid meeting was arranged on 11.06.2020 at 12:00 noon in the Conference Hall at Unnayan Bhawan, 3rd Floor through Video Conference via 'Google Meet'. The last date for submission of Bids was 30.06.2020 and Part- A of Technical Bids were opened on 02.07.2020. Evaluation of Part- A of Technical Bids was done by the respective Superintending Engineers in S&SWM Wing of KMDA.

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The status of Part- A technical evaluation of all the 29 e-RfPs, in its 1st call, was discussed elaborately in front of all the members present in the meeting. Out of total 29 e-RfPs/clusters, KMDA had received sufficient bids (three or more) for only 10 (ten) such clusters. Before the presentation for all those bidders who participated in the bidding process, it has been mentioned that all the bidders except Greentech Environ Management Pvt. Ltd., TAAS Enterprise and Krishna Multistructure Engineering Pvt. Ltd. are having minimum eligibility criteria to participate in the bid.

Because of non-availability of minimum three qualified responsive bidders, only 4 (four) such RfPs, out of 10 (ten) may be matured in the 1st call.

The total scenario of this 1st call of e-RfP is given in Annexure – II.

After detailed discussion on shortfall of minimum qualified responsive bidders, due to which only 4 bids/clusters (6 legacy dumpsites) happened to be responsive out of 10, it is decided that all the non-qualified bidders may be requested to explain their position. However, it has been decided that KMDA may go for 2nd call for the electronic-RfP as soon as possible, to have concessionaire to remove the legacy dumped waste from the remaining 25 (twenty-five) clusters.

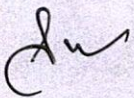
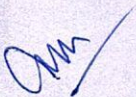
All the participant bidders were allowed to deliver their presentation on how they will do their job of Bio-Mining. The presentation was done through webinar.

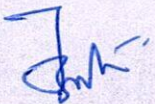
The members awarded marks (Maximum 5) after the presentation by the bidders. Scoresheet enclose at Annexure-III.
