

**Sub. : Proposal for enhancement of honorarium in respect of grass-root level Health functionaries working under Community Based Primary Health Care Services in 63 Non-KMA ULBs.**

HHWs & FTSs working under Community Based Primary Health Care Services (CBPHCS) in 63 Non-KMA ULBs receive honorarium @ Rs. 1,000/- p.m. & Rs. 1,170/- p.m. respectively as per project proposal @ the then existing rate of honorarium of other Community Based Health Programme. In the mean time, honorarium for grass root level workers was enhanced @ Rs. 250/- p.m. w.e.f. 01.07.2006 burring grass root level functionaries of DFID assisted HHW Scheme and CBPHCS.

Principal Secretary, Dept. of MA had forwarded a proposal with regard to enhancement of honorarium of grass root level health functionaries for both the programmes, out of which we obtained approval of DHFW in respect of HHW Scheme. But approval in respect of CBPHCS is still awaited from DHFW. In the mean time, with concurrence of Finance Dept., Dept. of Municipal Affairs enhanced honorarium of grass root level Health functionaries @ Rs. 500/- p.m. with effect from 01.04.2008 for which concurrence be obtained from DHFW in respect of both the CBPHCS and DFID assisted HHW Scheme.

After signature the file along with letters may be returned to the undersigned so that the letters could be handed over to DHFW personally. This is as per discussion with DHFW.

The State Government has increased the rate of Honorarium for Grass Root Level Workers under IPP VIII, IPP VIII(Extn.), CUDP-III etc. by an amount of Rs.250/- per month with effect from 01.10.2004

Again, the State Government has increased the rate of Honorarium for Grass Root Level Workers under IPP VIII, IPP VIII(Extn.), CUDP-III etc. by a further amount of Rs.250/- per month with effect from 01.07.2006.

This is to mention here that training of HHWs has already been initiated in 53 ULBs, out of which 45 ULBs completed such training as on 2<sup>nd</sup> July, 2007. After completion of training, the HHWs had been engaged by the ULBs and the service implementation started. These HHWs are entitled to receive their honorarium from the date of engagement by the respective ULBs.

After working in the field for a period of continuous six months, one FTS is to be selected amongst the five HHWs. These selected FTSs will undergo supervisory training, on completion of which they will be engaged by the ULBs as FTSs and will be entitled to receive the honorarium for FTSs.

According to project proposal the present honorarium of HHWs & FTSs are Rs. 1,000/- and Rs. 1,170/- respectively. The State Govt. and the Dept. of Health & Family Welfare has already increased the rate of honorarium of HHWs & FTSs by a further amount of Rs. 250/- p.m. with effect from 01.07.2006, working under IPP-VIII, IPP-VIII (Extn.), CUDP III and HHW Scheme in 11 Non-KMA ULBs. Since the nature of job of HHWs & FTSs are similar in all the schemes, the increased rate of honorarium should also be applicable to such HHWs & FTSs engaged under Community Based Primary Health Care Services in 63 Non-KMA ULBs.

After working in the field for a period of continuous six months, one FTS is to be selected amongst the five HHWs. These selected FTSSs will undergo supervisory training, on completion of which they will be engaged by the ULBs as FTSSs and will be entitled to receive the honorarium for FTSSs.

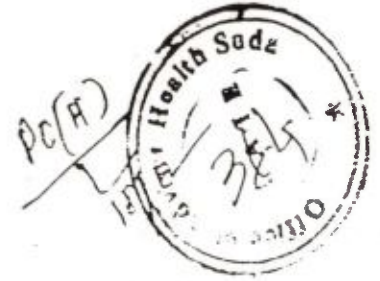

Again, the State Government has increased the rate of Honorarium for Grass Root Level Workers under IPP VIII, IPP VIII(Extn.), CUDP-III etc. by a further amount of Rs.250/- per month with effect from 01.07.2006.

Now since the nature of the job is similar in all such schemes the increase rate of Honorarium should be applicable to the health workers under the DFID assisted programme also.

2) Honorarium for HHWs and FTSS under the Community Based Primary Health Care Services ~~has been~~ fixed at Rs.1250/- and Rs.1400/- per month respectively and provided to them from the actual date of operation.

Honorarium for H.O., M.O., S.I, Health Asstt., Accounts Asstt. MHW cum SK has been fixed either in consolidated pay in respective scale of pay or may be allowed respective scale of pay like other Municipal Employees. Hence their cases may not be taken up consideration.

The aforesaid two proposals, therefore, may kindly be considered at an early date.
