Proposal for Study

e-governance:

- 1. Support to roll out of e-governance software to 31 Non-KMA ULBs where hardware (server, networking etc.) items are being provided.
- 2. Support for setting up of Central Data Centre and Development & Staging Centre for establishment of integrated e-governance system in all the ULBs of the State.
- 3. Support for strengthening and stabilizing the system which has just started functioning in the KMA ULBs for logical conclusion of the endeavour.

Sustenance of Reforms under KUSP:

- 1. <u>Draft Development Plan</u>: Support for preparation of 2nd generation Draft Development Plans for all the ULBs in West Bengal. For stabilising the preparation of DDPs in house, support for preparation of another 5-year DDP may help the ULBs to its internalisation.
- 2. Accounting Reforms: Support for updation of the Municipal Accounting Manual/Rules will help for inclusion of new activities of the ULBs vis-à-vis revision of any existing provision/system.

Housing:

Survey on Citizen Service Delivery satisfaction, particularly for urban poor to ascertain the situation on improvement of daily living of the urban poor and assess the extent upto which the various social / infrastructural scheme taken up during these days have actually reached the targeted group/urban poor.
- Survey of Central Government properties within ULBs to ascertain the quantum and valuation for assessment of the service charge of Central Government properties payable to ULBs.
