

On 28.11.2001 in the meeting held at SUDA
Smt. N. Chatterjee IAS. of the World Bank
suggested that training of the

be arranged at local levels
in the U.Bs, because this will
ensure male partnership in
RCH activities in the years to come.

Moreover, if motivated their
services will be available for
transmission of the ~~message~~ messages
of small-family-norm and prevention
of RTI./S.T.I., particularly HIV infection.
