

State Assisted Scheme for Provident Fund for Unorganised Workers

(SASPFUW)

Introduced vide Labour Department Resolution Nos. 180-IR dated 24.01.2001 & 305-IR dated 19.02.2001. The highlights of the Resolutions are --

Coverage under the scheme : List vide annexure-B
-ICDS, IPP-VIII, CUDP-III

Eligibility & Application : wage employed/self employed workers of age 18-55 Yrs.
having an average family income of not more than
Rs. 3500/-pm.

All such eligible workers willing to join the scheme will apply to the Minimum Wages Inspector for enrolment in Form No. 1 annexed, in the proscribed manner.

Contribution : Each worker will contribute a sum of Rs. 20/- per month.
An equal matching amount shall also be contributed by
the State Govt.

At the time of enrolment a worker under the scheme will
be issued an Identity Card - cum Pass Book
in Form II annexed.

Collection & Accounting

Procedure : In each Municipal area/borough of the Municipal
Corporation Jointly by Minimum Wages Inspector and ALC.

Details on maintenance of records, management of the scheme are laid down in the
handout..

If these projects are also included in the said annexure, SASPFUW shall be applicable to them.
