### 2) Approved Cost

The original approved cost was Rs. 165.00 lakhs and the unit costs considered were Rs. 8.5 lakhs for HAU Rs. 23.00 lakhs for OPD cum MH and Rs. 8.5 lakhs Medical Store.

There were certain errors in the above mentioned unit costs and a revised estimated amount of Rs. 305.00 lakhs for Civil Construction Work as per the following break up was sent to the Govt. of India/World Bank for their approval and the programme is being executed in anticipation of approval of the above estimated amount -

This upward revision in the cost of Civil Works from Rs. 165 lakhs to Rs. 305 lakhs consequently raises the total cost of this programme from Rs. 857 lakhs to Rs. 997 lakkhs.

GOI/World Bank are to be requested to convey their formal concurrence to the upward revision in cost.

### 3) Status of Bidding

Bids were invited for 8 HAU and 2 OPD cum MH in the first phase. The Bid Evaluation reports for the first three groups (6 nos. HAU) were sent to the Bank and they had approved the lowest bid price received. With subsequent Govt. approval work orders were issued in Feb, 2000 and works in respect of the 5 HAUs have been completed. AMC is to take over the completed Buildings.

Govt. approval for the remaining 2 HAUs and 2 OPD cum MH in the first phase has been obtained and work orders for all the units have been issued. Works in respect of all the units are in progress. The lowest bid price received in respect of 8 HAU and 2 OPD cum MH is Rs. 201.30 lakhs.

The bidding process for 5 HAUs and 1 MS have been completed and work orders have been issued for all the units. Work will start soon.

### 4) Status of Land

Lands for second phase units have been identified. However, handing over of specific sites by AMC is awaited.

### 5) Status of Construction

Construction works of 1 OPD cum MH and 6 HAUs have been completed. Construction of 2 HAUs and 2 OPD cum MH are in progress.

I am to invite a reference to your D.O letter bearing No. L-19013/1/99-AP.I dated 30.8.99 addressed to Ms. N Saggi Secretary Family Welfare, Govt. of West Bengal with copy to br. N.G.Gangopadhyay, Adviser (Health), SUDA in connection with revision of project cost.

It may be recalled that civil works in Asansol Sub-Project was originally ear \_\_\_\_ marked at Rs. 165 lakhs out of approved total project out lay of Rs. 857 lakhs. Subsequently Model Bid bocuments [MBD] with revision in the lay out of buildings were prepared from this end and sent to the Ministry and World Bank and the cost approved in the approved M B D was Rs. 232 lakhs (approx) @ Rs. 11.40 lakhs per HAU, Rs. 37.55 lakhs per ESOPD cum MH and Rs. 8.50 lakhs for the Medical Store.

The M B D were approved in the year 1997 and during the last two years we have been in correspondence with Govt of India / Bank to wards finalization of formalities. By this time the price index for civil works has escalated by 30% (@ 15% per year). The escalation elements on the base price of 232 lakhs as per approxed M B D works out to Rs. 73 lakhs (approx) and the total estimated cost for civil works hence comes to Rs. 305 lakhs.

To justify the increase in the cost, it may be mentioned that we had adopted the lay out of buildings duly approved by the World Bank and the Ministry and this revision in the building lay out as mentioned above caters for an increase of Rs. 67 lakhs. Further, time period of two years has already elapsed towards finilization of formalities and to obtain the clearance the from Govt. of India/Bank for issuance of work order, the price escalation @ 15% per year has justified/required to be incorporated.

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Hence the total additional fund requrement on account of civil works comes to Rs. 140 lakhs and the total project out lay will stand revised to R. 997 lakhs instead of R. 857 lakhs.

Incidentally, it may be mentioned that in IPP-VIII(Extn) which is understood to have been approved by the E F C, the lay out plan and plinth area of the buildings are the same as the ones adopted in RCH Sub Project in Asansol.

It may also be mentioned that while the percentage cost to civil works total cost for IPP-VIII (Extn) is 33%, the same for RCH Asansol comes to approximately 30%.

Your letter was received here on 13th Sept. 99 and instead of our best efforts we could not send the reply by the 15th as envisaged therein. The madner but dely is duffy regrelled.

I would now request you kindly to approve the total out lay of Rs. 997 lakhs incorporating for the RCH sub project, Asansol inconsideration of lescalation of civil works as elaborated above.

Under the World Bank assisted RCH Programme and since October, 1997, a district sub-project in Murshidabad district and a city sub-project in Asansole are under implementation at a cost of Rs. 13.53 crores and Rs. 8.57 crores respectively.

As per our records, Rs. 497 lakhs in Murshidabad district and Rs. 165 lakhs in Asansole city were earmarked for civil works (towards new construction as well as add-ons / up-gradation/repair). Some State Governments have conveyed that the expenditure under civil works is likely to exceed the cost originally are allocated, on account of price/cost escalation or delay in start up of construction activities, and have requested for additional funds for completion of civil works activities. This item has been considered in the Ministry in consultation with the World Bank.

To facilitate an early decision, kindly furnish information on i) the amount committed on works already awarded (item-wise) (ii) the amount originally envisaged and the likely revised estimates for civil works activities yet to be undertaken, for new construction works, as well as for proposed upgrading/addson/rapairs etc. (iii) justification and rationale behind increase in the cost of civil works including whether the increase in cost of civil works is due to delay in startup of construction activities or because of price/cost escalation etc. It would be useful if this information reached this Ministry by 15th September, 1999.

In the absence of this information, we may be constrained to presume that all civil works under the Sub-projects are being completed within the originally allocated amount.

Further, while approving the Sub-projects in your State, it was envisaged that the fresh construction activities would be completed by the end of the second year

of implementation. Kindly ensure that the construction of civil works are indeed completed on schedule. Finally, do also forward quickly the current physical and financial progress report, alongwith your claims on the expenditure already claims incurred.

I am to invite a reference to your D.O letter bearing No. L-19013/1/99-AP.I dated 30.8.99 addressed to Ms. II. Saggia Secretary (Family Welfare), Govt. of West Bengal with copy endorsed to the undersigned in connection with revision of project cost.

It may be recalled that civil works in Asansol Sub-Project was originally earmarked at 3. 165 lakhs out of approved total project out lay of 1s. 857 lakhs. Subsequently Model Bid Documents (ABD) with revision in the lay out of buildings were prepared from this end and sent to the Ministry and World Bank and the cost approved in the approved MBD was is. 232 lakins (approx) J &. 11.40 lakhs per HAU, &. 57.55 lakhs per ESUFD cum EH and &. 3.50 lakhs for the Medical Store.

The MBD were approved in the year 1997 and during the last two years we have been in correspondence with Govt. of India/Bank towards finalization of formalities. By this time the price index for civil works has escalated by 30% (3 15% per year). The escalation elements on the base price of 232 lakhs as per approved and works out to 8. 73 lakhs (approx) and the total estimated cost for civil works hence comes to Is. 305 lakhs.

To justify the increase in the cost, it may be mentioned that we had adopted the lay out of buildings duly approved by the World Bank and the Ministry and this revision in the building lay out as mentioned above caters for an increase of Rs. 67 lakhs. Further, time period of two years has already elapsed towards finilization of formalities and to obtain the clearance from Govt. of India/Bank for issuance of work order, the price escalation @ 15% per year has justifiedly required to be incorporated.

Hence the total additional fund requirement on account of civil works comes to Rs. 140 lakhs and the total project out lay will stand revised to Rs. 997 lakhs instead of Rs. 857 lakhs.

Incidentally, it may be mentioned that in IPP-VIII(Extn) which is understood to have been approved by the E F C, the lay out plan and plinth area of the buildings are the same as the ones adopted in RCH Sub-Project in Asansol.

It may also be mentioned that while the percentage cost to civil works to total cost for IPP-VIII(Extn) is 33%, the same for RCH Asansol comes to approximately 30%.

Your letter was received here on 15th Sept'99 and instead of our best efforts we could not send the reply by the 15th as envisaged therein. The inadvertent delay is deeply regretted.




