With reference to the approval letter of the O.S.D., UHIP Unit K.M.D.A.(Vide No.842/5-12/KMDA/Health/UHIP/05, dated 14/11/2006 Dr. Chanchal Khan of Flat No. 6, Prabhabati Bhawan, Nangi Station Road, P.O. – Batanagar, Kolkata – 700140, is hereby engaged as Medical Officer on part-time basis at a consolidated and fixed fee of Rs. 3350/- only per month on the following terms and conditions :-

- 1) He/She will work as part-time medical Officer purely on "no work no payment basis" for HAU-V under IPP-VIII at Ward-34 with effect from 2<sup>nd</sup> July, 2012.
- 2) The minimum duty hours for him/her would be 4 (four) hours daily till the work is finished whichever is later. *(12 Noon to 04 PM)*
- 3) His/Her duties will be as follows :-
  - (a) He/She will attend to patients on call from the HHWs at the residence of beneficiaries and visit all the Sub-Centres at least once/twice a week according to a pre-determined schedule to provide medical check up to supervise the Immunization and other activities of the Sub-Centre.
  - (b) He/She will submit indents for the Sub-Centre for supply of medicines sera, vaccines, etc. from the stores of the H.A.U.
  - (c) The ambulatory cases requiring hospitalization or Investigation will be referred either by the M.O. or by the *Specialist*.
- 4) The engagement of part-time M.O. will not entitle him/her to any right to any service of permanent/temporary or any other nature at any time in future.
- 5) He/She will be liable to dismissal without assigning any reason thereof and/or notice if he/she fails to perform his/her duties properly or due to circumstances which may not require his/her service.

Your petitioners state that until and unless the status of the petitioners are being declared by the respondent authority, they are not entitled to give any fresh appointment to other candidate on permanent basis and the judicial pronouncement so far made by the Hon'ble Apex Court of India and the Hon'ble High Court at Calcutta provide that such action of the state authority are highly contrary to law and by conduct the temporary nature of service of the petitioners have been changed like anything rather they have already worked more than 9 years continuous service in the said post and the respective appointing authority ought to have been considered on different footing and/or angle and thereby the petitioners are claiming to be absorbed in the permanent post having a necessary scale of pay including all other benefits and ....



and subsequent to that namely after super-annuation the  
retiral benefits are required to be released which a  
permanent employee is entitled to get the same.

18. Your petitioners state that they have been  
discharging their duties in the said post from their  
respective appointments <sup>after</sup> getting appointment letters from  
the competent authority and their status are required  
to be considered as regular employee under the concerned  
authority but the concerned respondents without considering  
the case of the petitioners are trying to give appointment  
in the said post to the candidates of their own choice  
in place of the petitioners herein on permanent basis.  
Unless this Hon'ble Court interferes into the matter  
and restrained the concerned respondents from taking any  
step and/or further steps from giving appointment to other  
candidates on permanent basis, your petitioners will be  
seriously prejudiced in as much as they will permanently  
lose their service for ever in spite of having discharged  
long service in the said post.



19. Your petitioners state that it is surprising enough that the concerned respondents have been utilising the service of the petitioners for a long time for which they are entitled to be protected under certain service rule but the concerned respondents as yet have not laid down any service condition of the petitioners and more to say their status as temporary in nature are not being taken into consideration because they have already rendered more than 9 years service and the authorities have forced the petitioners to uncertainty which is not permissible under the law and although the same is being done by the concerned respondents by treating the petitioners as temporary employee and also trying to oust the petitioners from their service but the situation has changed altogether because of the subsequent event namely the long rendering of their service under the supervision and control of the concerned respondents. It is to be noted here that the manner and procedure in which the respondents are acting in order to oust the petitioners from the zone of consideration is violating .....



is violating of Article 14, 16 and 21 of the Constitution of India and apart from this the petitioners are also being deprived of getting their equal pay for equal work which hits the provisions of Article 39 of the Constitution of India.

20. Your petitioners state that it is apparent from the conduct of the respondent authorities that there is no security, safety as well as protection of service of the petitioners and as a matter of fact the concerned respondents are making attempt to oust the petitioners from the said service, as a result of which the petitioners will out of employment at any day and the manner and procedure the concerned authorities is intending to oust the petitioners from the said post by engaging other candidates of their choice is contrary to the act and rules and the concerned respondents being the model employer cannot do so.

21. Your petitioners state that they are performing their service since a petty long time as such the said

service .....



service should be regularised with immediate effect by introducing proper scale of pay and till such regularisation is made, their service should not and cannot be disturbed in any manner whatsoever but the concerned respondents are going to appoint other candidates in place of the petitioners at their sweet will and choice in their place resulted thereby the petitioners will be without any employment with immediate effect thereafter. It may be stated herein that after doing the job for a long time in the said post, the respondent authorities cannot snatch away the service of the petitioners at their sweet will and their choice, the petitioners recently came to know that as per interview for final selection held on 1st August, 2006 in the chamber of the OSD and in the said interview the petitioners were not allowed to participate the concerned respondents have already prepared a panel of the candidates of their choice and they have taken steps to appoint those candidates in place of the petitioners herein. As soon as the petitioners came to know about the said facts they made representations before the concerned respondents .....



respondents ventilating therein their grievances. They have agitated before the concerned respondents that they are working in the said post since 1998 as temporary employee and are rendering service for a long period in the said post ; the respondent authority cannot make final selection to other candidates without allowing the petitioners to participate in the said selection in the said post. They further requested the respondent authority to absorb the petitioners as permanent employee in the said post instead of giving any fresh appointment to other candidates in their place but the respondent authority are strict in their point and they will give appointment in the said post to other candidates in their place and steps have already been taken to that effect.

22. Your petitioners therefore state that unless this Hon'ble Court interferred into the matter and restrained the concerned respondents from giving any appointment to other ....



other candidates in place of the petitioners, the petitioners will be seriously prejudiced, in as much as they will lose their service for ever.

22. Being aggrieved by dis-satisfied with the illegal steps taken by the concerned respondents from giving appointment to the candidates of their own choice in place of the petitioners herein as well as without considering the case of the petitioners regarding regularisation of their service on permanent basis in the said post, your petitioners beg to move the instant writ petition with the following amongst other :-

GROUND S :

I. For That the respondents cannot deny its obligation after utilising the service of the petitioners for more than 9 years and more particularly they have shown any bonafide attitude towards the petitioners with regard to determine and/or assess the status of the petitioners and as a matter of fact the authorities ....
