The Governor has been pleased to approve recruitment of twenty three Assistant Health Officers for the municipalities in C.M.D.A. area as shown below for a period of one year only, on contract basis, in connection with the implementation of Health and Family Welfare Programmes in municipal areas under I.P.P. Project VIII Sponsored by C.M.D.A. =

The Governor has further been pleased to approve the following recruitment procedures and the duty chart for the aforesaid Assistant Health Officers :-

Method of recruitment : By way of selection through a Selection Committee to be constituted for this purpose.

Qualification : M.B.B.S. with at least two years experience as a private medical practitioner.

Age : Between 25 and 58 years.

Nationality : Must be an Indian Citizen.

Terms & Condition of appointment : An Assistant Health Officer will be appointed on contract basis, for a period of one year only, at a consolidated pay of Rs 3750/- only per month and will not be eligible to draw any other allowances. His appointment may be terminated at any time by giving notice of one month without assigning any reason. He may be allowed 14 days' leave on personal ground in a year.

Duties : (1) An Assistant Health Officer will devote at least 4 hours on each working day in connection with Health & Family Welfare Programmes adopted by the municipality under I.P.P. Project VIII.

(2) He will supervise the functioning of Health Administrative Unit under I.P.P. Project VIII.

(3) He will arrange framing programmes/workshops for the employees attached to the Health and Sanitary Programmes of the municipality, Honorary Health Workers and private voluntary organisations to be involved in I.P.P. VIII project and for the intended beneficiaries of the proper to create awareness among them about Health and Family Welfare including family planning methods, clean sanitary conditions, women's education, child care and nutrition, first aid, creche programme and preventive measures and/or immunisation against Malaria, Tuberculosis, Leprosy, Polio, Typhoid, Measles etc.

(4) He will attend patients on call from the Nonorary Health at the residence of beneficiaries and visit all the sub-centas st once a week according to predetermined scheduled to provide l check-up and supervise immunisation programmes.

(5) He will submit indents for Health Administrative Unit to the al Store for supply of medicines, vaccines etc. through the ective Health Officers.

(6) The ambulatory cases will be referred by him for attendance by specialist.

(7) Cases requiring hospitalisation or investigations will be ecommended and referred by him to the appropriate medical centre.

(8) Chairman of the municipality and the Health Officer entrust any other health and sanitary function on him under I.P.P. Project-VIII.

(9) Assistant Health Officer will function under the overall supervision and control of the Chairman and Health Officer.

In discharging aforesaid duties he will work in close contact with other health and sanitary officers and workers of the municipality.

The expenditure for payment of remuneration to the Assistant Health Officers so appointed will be borne by C.M.D.A.

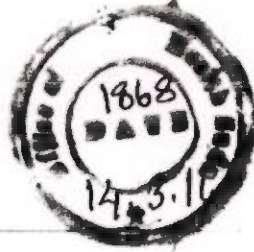


One post of Assistant Health Officer (A. H. O) is lying vacant in this Municipality for a long time.

With reference to your communication vide no.432-MA/P/C-10/1G-5/2007 dt. 1st June,2010,clarification and views with regard to status and positioning of Assistant Health Officer (AHO) and their remuneration of IPP-VIII, IPP-VIII(Extn.)and HHW Scheme are given below , as desired.

In addition to Health Officer (HO), 40 nos. of post of AHO had been sanctioned in phases for the ULBs implementing IPP-VIII to support HO for better supervision and monitoring of IPP-VIII. In this connection, this is to state that there was embargo for engagement of HO at ULB level due to pending court case filed by HO. Hence during implementation of IPP-VIII (Extn.) in 10 Non-KMA ULBs and HHW Scheme in 11 Non-KMA ULBs, post of AHO had also been sanctioned to discharge the duties & responsibilities of HO in the ULBs where there was no HO. In IPP-VIII (Extn.) sanctioned post of AHO was six in no. At present, all the six post of AHO are vacant.

In HHW Scheme out of 11 Non-KMA ULBs, four ULBs are having HO and for the remaining ULBs seven no. of AHO have been engaged in seven ULBs. Thus it may be seen that post of AHO was sanctioned in IPP-VIII in KMA ULBs to supplement the responsibilities of HO, whereas in IPP-VIII (Extn.) and HHW Scheme there was no provision for posting of AHO in the ULBs where there was HO in position.

It is clarified that Berhampur Municipality is not within the IPP-VIII Scheme, but it is implementing HHW Scheme. Hence the count of AHO for the ULBs implementing HHW Scheme does not come in the count of AHO for KMA ULBs implementing IPP-VIII. Moreover, it is not only Berhampur Municipality but also other six ULBs implementing HHW Scheme i.e. Bishnupur, Bolpur, Medinipur, Kalna, Jangipur and Purulia are having AHO.

As AHO of IPP-VIII is supplementing responsibilities of HO of the respective ULBs, their remuneration had been fixed at a much lower rate which have been enhanced time to time, at present which is 6,000/- per AHO per month.

In IPP-VIII (Extn.) and HHW Scheme remuneration of AHO at the initial stage had been fixed to Rs. 8,000/- which was the then starting basic pay in the pay scale of a MBBS. The said basic pay of Rs. 8,000/- has also been enhanced from time to time, raising it to Rs.8,750/- at present. If enhanced remuneration be fixed at Rs. 8,750/-, then AHO of IPP-VIII only will be benefitted. On the other hand AHO under HHW Scheme who are discharging full responsibilities as HO will be deprived to a great extent.

Remuneration of AHO in all the projects namely IPP-VIII, HHW Scheme [no AHO is existing at present under IPP-VIII (Extn.)] may be enhanced uniformly and at par with present remuneration admissible in terms of ROPA, 2009.

It is clarified that Berhampur Municipality is not within the IPP-VIII Scheme, but it is implementing HHW Scheme. The said basic pay of Rs. 8,000/- has also been enhanced time to time, at present which is 8,750/- If enhancement of remuneration be fixed at Rs. 8,750/-, then AHO of IPP-VIII only will be benefitted. On the other hand AHO under HHW Scheme who are discharging full responsibilities as HO will be deprived to a great extent.

Enhancement of remuneration of AHO in all the projects namely IPP-VIII, HHW Scheme [no AHO is existing at present under IPP-VIII (Extn.)] may be [at par with recent remuneration as per ROPA, 2009.]



1. I am directed to invite your kind attention to your U. O. No. SUDA-Health/63ULBS/08/36 dated 05.08.2008 ^{at Flag-A} wherein it was stated that there are posts of Assistant Health Officer under IPP-VIII, IPP-VII (Extn.) and HHW Scheme with different amount of contract pay but in the list of personnel furnished under U. O. No. SUDA 19/2010 dated 08.02.2010 ^{at Flag-B} (manpower - Urban Health Programme) mention has made of only 39 posts of A.H.O. under IPP-VIII scheme but is known that Berhampore Municipality covered by HHW scheme has one post of A.H.O. This difference in information supplied has created confusion.

2. It is also stated earlier that there is difference in the amount of contract pay for A.H.Os engaged under the schemes IPP-VIII, IPP-VII (Extn.) and DFID assisted HHW which exists still now. The A.H.O.s working under IPP-VIII scheme are demanding contract pay @ Rs. 8,500/- equal to that other A.H.O.s are getting.

Under this circumstances, I am further directed to request you to kindly clarify the issue noted at 1 above and offer your views on both the issues mentioned above.

I am directed to state that a pilot project with DFID support to extend the Honorary Health Worker Scheme in 11 Municipalities outside KMDA area has been approved by the Government of India vide their letter no.L-19012/46/02 dated 2.12.2003. The project will basically involve selection/Training and deployment of Honorary Health Worker @ one per 200 B.P.L. households for providing mother child care on IPP pattern. It has been decided to set up a Central Coordinating Cell at SUDA and a Municipal Management Cell at each of the 11 Municipalities to coordinate and implement the project. The entire funding for the project will be provided by DFID for one year, likely to be extended for five years.

2. After careful consideration of the matter the Governor has now been pleased to accord the administrative approval to the DFID funded pilot project to extend Honorary Health Worker Scheme in 11 Municipalities viz. Cooch Behar, Jangipur, Berhampore, Suri, Bolpur, Purulia, Bankura, Bishnupore, Kalna, Krishnanagar and West Midnapore and to create a Central Coordinating Cell at SUDA and a Municipal Management Cell in each of the aforesaid Municipalities as per Annexure-'A' and Annexure-'B' for one year for the present with effect from 1.2.2004. The engagement of personnel in the Municipal Management Cell will be made in accordance with the manner prescribed in the booklet in Bengali circulated to them.

3. The Honorarium liabilities against all the posts of the Central Coordinating Cells at SUDA as well as the Municipal Management Cells will be borne out of the project fund to be provided by DFID.



actual requirement. In consultation with the KMDA and SLDA a realistic assessment of the fund requirement has been made and we are moving the Finance Department for augmentation of the provision.

In terms of this decision I would now request you to please inform the concerned local bodies to renew the contractual engagement of the health workers and other staff as shown in the Annexure on existing terms for another one year from 1.7.02.

It may kindly be emphasized on the local bodies that the intention of the Government is to handover these institutions to the local bodies in the long run and the latter should be able to run them on a self sufficient and sustainable basis through collection of user charges, without compromising on the quality of the vital services being provided. We have already informed the local bodies implementing IPP VIII (Extension) Programme to consider to adopt the user charges that have been fixed under IPP VIII Programme and the item-wise user charges has also been intimated to them for guidance. The Government intends to reduce the financial support in a phased manner over a period of time when it will be possible to run these centres independently.

In the matter of monitoring the programmes at the headquarters, the Government intends to keep a small wing under a single agency which will look after both these two programmes. This wing will function under an advisory body to be chaired by the MOS of this Department. The formation of this advisory body as well as of the monitoring wing will be notified separately. For the present, it is ordered that the existing staff set up at the headquarters both at KMDA and SLDA will be maintained under the existing terms and conditions upto October, 2002. This circular may kindly be brought to the attention of all concerned local bodies.

You are aware that Apex Committee under the Chairmanship of the Chief Secretary on Family Welfare (Urban Slums) Project (IPP VIII) in its 4th meeting held on the 4th June, 1997 recommended that the Municipal Affairs Department would be responsible for maintaining the services created by the Project in the post-project period. Pursuant to this decision, an RE provision of Rs. 4 crore was kept in the budget for the year 2001-02 under the Head "2211-00-108-Selected Area Programme (including IPP Project)-NP-002-31" under Demand No. 34 and funds were also released in the last financial year from this Head in favour of KMDA for continuation of the programme, since KMDA has been supervising IPP VII programme in 40 urban local body areas within the KMDA area. IPP VIII (Extension) programme with assistance from World Bank was also introduced under the supervision of SUDA in 10 local body areas outside KMDA for extending similar facilities and this programme came to an end on 30.6.2002. However, the World Bank has allowed an extension of time upto October 2002 for claiming reimbursement against expenditure incurred upto the 30th June this year. In terms of the decision of the aforesaid Apex Committee the Government has decided that the programme under IPP VIII as well as IPP VII (Extension) will continue as usual for which financial assistance would be provided by the Municipal Affairs Department through KMDA/SUDA. In the budget for the current year there is a provision of Rs. 4.07 crore which is much less than the

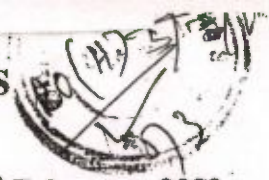


Under the circumstances stated above, it is proposed that :
