On perusal of the said Treatise , Secretary , MA has kindly raised certain
queries on its concluding para.

The reply as to the queries are furnished below seriatim:

Post project maintenance of CUDP-III and CSIP has been the
responsibilities of the Dept. of UD, Govt. of West Bengal. The same for IPP-
VIII, Kolkata is vested on the Dept. of Municipal Affairs. IPP-VIII-(Extn.) 2'x'
in 10 additional cities will enter into maintenance phase from July 1, 2002
after EOP on June 30, 2002. In this context relevant minutes of the Apex
Committee held on 4th June 1997. (pg.no. 3, item no 5(iv) and 18.1.2001
(pg.no. 2 ,item no. 2a)ii) are enclosed for kind perusal.

The above mentioned 3 Projects viz. CUDP-III, CSIP & IPP-VIII, Kolkata 2'x'
are run by K.M.D.A. Proposal for post project maintenance of IPP-VIII-
(Extn.) by MA Dept. has already been submitted to the Dept. and now the
Jt. Secretary (SKD), MA Dept. is being contacted for detail examination as
per advice of the Secretary, MA Dept.

Orders of Secretary prepage.

As per decision in a meeting of the Apex Committee headed by the Chief Secretary funds for post project maintenance of IPP-VII, which came to an end on 30.06.2001, are being provided in the budget of the M.A. Department (budgetary allocation, however, is not adequate to meet the requirement) and M.A. Department has been releasing funds in favour of KMDA, which was the implementing agency for IPP-VIII, for post project maintenance. IPP-VIII (Extn.) which is being implemented by a Cell set up in SUDA, will come to an end on 30.06.2002. For post project maintenance of IPP-VIII(Extn.) funds will have to be provided in the budget of M.A. Department for which action is being taken separately. Since M.A. Department will be responsible for post project maintenance of both IPP-VIII & IPP-VIII (Extn.) it is desirable that the work regarding post project maintenance of both IPP-VIII & IPP-VIII (Extn.) is done by a single Cell.
