NOTIFICATION

A project for taking up Community Based Frankry Healthy Care Services (CBPHC) in 63 Non-KMA Urban Local Bodies (ULBs) has been taken up with the budgetary support of Health & Family Welfare Department in line with the Community Based Health Care Programmes implemented in the remaining Urban Local Bodies earlier under vanous other Health Projects. For successful and smooth implementation of the Scheme, one Health Officer is required to be engaged in each ULB on contract basis with contractual remaneration. The matter was under active consideration of the Government for sometime past.

- 2. After careful consideration of all aspects, the Governor has been pleased to accord sanction to the creation of 63 posts of Health Officer, for the 63 ULBs, for covering Community Based Primary Health Care Nervices (CBPRC). The Health Officer shall be engaged by the concerned Urban Local Body on contractual basis.
- 3. The contractual remuneration of the Health Officers will be fixed taking into account the initial basic pay in the Scale of Rs.8000-13506/- plus Dearness pay as well as Dearness Allowance as is admissible on the date of contractual appointment.
- 4. The Selection of the Health Officer will be made through a selection process by the respective Urban Local Bodies in the manner stated below:

a) Names of Candidates be invited through Natification at least in two daily nowspapers (1 Bengah, 1 English).

b) Candidates must have minimum qualification of MBBS from any recognized

University with desirable qualification of 2 years' practicing experience.

c) Conditions regarding minimum and maximum age and other criteria on nationality. & caste shall be governed by the existing orders of the Government for recruitment of Medical Officers.

- d) A Committee comprising Chairperson of the respective ULB as the Chairman, representative of the District Magistrate, representative of the Chief Medical Officer of Health of the district, an officer nominated by the Director of Local Bodies as the other members shall conduct the selection process.
- 5. This order entails discontinuation, at the same time of Medical Officer who are now continuing in the Urban Local Bodies on contractual pay of Rs.300/- per day subject to a maximum of Rs.6000/- p.m.
- 6. This order issues with the approval of the Cabinet and concurrence of Finance Department vide U.O.No.625 Gr.P(Service) dated 21.2.2008.
- 7. The Principal Accountage General (A&E), West Bengal and all others concerned are being informed accordingly.

MEMORANDUM

Sub: Engagement of Health Officer under CBPHCS Scheme



Clarifications on a number of points in connection with this Department Notification No. 451/MA/C-10/3S-55/2005 Pt. dated 22.4.2008 regarding the captioned subject, were sought by different ULBs from time to time.

The Govt. in this Department is pleased to clarify the points raised as follows

- 1. The contractual remuneration to be reckoned as indicated in the said Notification, may however differ from time to time arising out of difference of the rate of D.A. admissible on the date of contractual engagement or date of renewal of contractual engagement of a H.O. but in no way it will include M.A. or H.R.A. or N.P.A or increment in Pay or other allowance or benefit. However, total contractual remuneration will remain unaltered for one year counted from the date of contractual engagement.
 - 2. Contractual engagement will be made for one person for one ULB for 1(one) calendar year and thereafter if found satisfactory, it may be renewed for further 1(one) year with a gap of atleast 1(one) day between two contracts and so on, until any communication is made in the meantime, otherwise.
 - 3.. The contractual remuneration to the Health Officer is to be paid out of the fund allotted on account of CBPHCS Scheme.
 - Reservation of post for SC/ST/OBC shall be Governed by the existing Circular of the Govt. But there is no mandate to reserve a post for any category having single contractual employee of that post.
 - 5.. The maximum age limit for contractual engagement of a candidate for the first time is fixed at 32 years on the last date-of-birth subject to the relaxation as per Govt. rules for candidates belonging to SC/ST/OBC categories
 - 6.. The Health Officer so engaged shall be entitled to leave as admissible under Rule 213 of the West Bengal Service Rules, Part-I of the Govt of West Bengal.
 - 7. The Chairman of the concerned ULB or any person designated by him for the purpose shall act as the leave sanctioning authority. In case of any dispute as to the leave, the matter will be settled by the DLB., West Bengal.

Enclosed (at Annexure - I) kindly find herewith communication of the Chairman, Haldia Municipality bearing no. 1600/HM/CBPHCS/09 dt. 06.08.2009 which is self explanatory. This sort of problem is being faced not only by Haldia Municipality but also by other ULBs implementing CBPHCS. Hence, engagement of MO may be taken into active consideration for all the 63 ULBs implementing CBPHCS.

From the communication of Dept. of MA bearing no. 239-MA/C-10/3S-55/2005 dt. 07.03.2007 (enclosed for ready reference at Annexure- II) it may be seen that out of 63 ULBs, MO has been allowed for 31 ULBs, each ULB having population 40000 & above as per 2001 Census. At present, the consolidated pay of MO is Rs. 6,750/- per head per month.

Rest 32 ULBs having population less than 40000 are also having Sub-centres to cater different clinics i.e. ANC/PNC, General Treatment, Immunisation etc. by only Health Officer. It is practically very hard by only one HO, to run all the clinics of Sub-Centres, attending training for himself and imparting training to grass-root level health functionaries, attending meeting, doing administrative job, liasoning with District Health Office, implementing school health and National Health Programmes supervision and monitoring of health programmes. This is to mention here that in all Urban Health Programmes other than CBPHCs there are doctors in addition to Health Officer to perform clinic activities at SCs.

Estimation for engagement of MO at clinic based fee to run the clinics at Sub-centre is enclosed at Annexure – III wherein minimum 4 clinics per month for each sub-centre has taken into consideration. For engagement of MO on clinic based fee @ Rs.750/- per clinic for 63 ULBs, cost involvement will be Rs. 98.64 lakhs. As per existing remuneration @ Rs. 6,750/- per month, the cost involvement for 43 doctors of 31 ULBs is Rs. 34.83 lakhs per year. In case of engagement of MO on clinic based fee for 63 ULBs, requirement of fund will exceed Rs. 63.81 lakhs in comparison to existing remuneration per year. However, this can be accommodated in the budget for FY 2009-10. In the event of engagement of MO on clinic based fee @ Rs. 750/- per clinic instead of engaging on fixed remuneration basis, conduct of clinic by 1 MO may be restricted to 20 clinics or less per month.






