The socio economic and educational upliftment of minorities, particularly Muslims has attracted focused attention of Indian society in general and government circles in particular. As you are aware that one of the main objectives of NCM is to analyze issues relating to socio economic and educational development of minorities and to evaluate the progress of development of minorities under the Union and States. There is no doubt that if India aspire to emerge as a major economic and political power on the globe, it can not afford to leave behind a sizeable minority population in the matter of development, as an economic growth without their inclusion would be uneven and lopsided leaving weak patches on the growth map of the country.

The Planning Commission has also reiterated its key theme for the 11th plan of "inclusive growth". The welfare and development of minorities must have a prominent place in making this "inclusive growth" in reality. Realizing the importance of the above factor the Central Government has initiated some schemes for minorities under the Prime Minister's 15 Point Programme. In addition to this, several already existing programmes of the government aimed at improvement of condition of all segments of society including minorities have also been strengthened. The Commission is also aware that some State governments have also taken certain state level initiatives separately in this regard including reservation in government jobs for minorities.

The Commission appreciates the efforts aimed at achieving socio economic and educational upliftment of minorities, especially Muslims. It is, however, felt that most of these schemes do not yield the desired results, and prove ineffective on account of certain major reasons viz: (i) the absence of a Village/Tehsil/District level effective monitoring system for such schemes, (ii) the lack of a proper information dissemination mechanism for publicity of these schemes among minorities, (iii) cumbersome procedural requirements for ban scholarships and grants etc. (iv) indifferent attitude of implementing agencies/official machinery.

There are instances when the funds earmarked by the Government for several schemes were either under-utilized or not at all utilized and surrendered to the Government. Depriving the people who needed these funds the most. The Commission, therefore, feel that there is an urgent need to streamline the system and sensitize the implementing official machinery and the clientele for whom such schemes are meant so that maximum people from minority segments of society can reap benefits of these schemes and more effectively participate in the noble cause of nation building.



Keeping the above facts in view, the Commission has decided that it should seek a quarterly progress report from the concerned ministries/departments of the Central Government as well as from the State Governments on various minorities related schemes being implemented by them. Such quarterly reports can be submitted to this Commission in the format given in annexure to this letter. The first quarterly report may, therefore, be sent to us for the period April-June 2008, in the first week of July 2008. The objective behind getting such report is that the Commission can have an overview of the progress of such schemes on physical and financial parameters and can suggest to the Government and the implementing agencies on the measures to accelerate the pace of these schemes so as to achieve the desired results within a stipulated time frame and also to make such schemes more effective and clientele friendly.

I shall, therefore, be grateful if you could kindly personally look into the matter and issue appropriate directions to the concerned officials and the implementing agencies of your Ministry/Government to work on the lines suggested in the preceding paras and furnish the requisite quarterly report (starting from June 2008) regularly in the annexed format. Your suggestions and recommendations (if any) in this regard will be highly appreciated.
