Sub. : Request of Development & Research Services Pvt. Ltd. for accessing data on Diarrhoeal cases during FY 2012-13 for City Rating on sanitation related parameters.

Prof. Shantanu Kr. Bose, Chief Director, Development & Research Services Pvt. Ltd. visited SUDA office and had a discussion with Director, SUDA and PO. Health regarding non-availability of data relating to Diarrhoeal cases during FY 2012-13 which is urgently required for City Rating on sanitation related parameters. Prof. Bose has provided a DO letter of the Jt. Secretary (UD & MD). Govt. of India addressed to the Principal Secretary, Dept. of Municipal Affairs, Govt. of West Bengal vide DO No. Q-11011/6/2011-PHE-1(Vol. 1) dt. 4<sup>th</sup> April. 2014 along with the list of 59 cities which are placed at Flag A & B respectively.

During discussion. Prof. Bose intimated that in spite of putting their efforts they have not been able to obtain the diarrhoeal data from most of the enlisted 59 ULBs.

In this connection, the following actions may be taken:

- Department may be requested to the respective ULBs for providing such data.
- Department may be requested to take up the matter with Department of Health & Family Welfare for providing such data.
- Keeping in view the urgent requirement of the data by Development & Research Services Pvt. Ltd., the data available with SUDA (Placed at Flag C) may be provided, if approved. This is to mention here that this data pertains to the target (slums / BPL) population fortnightly visited by the Honorary Health Workers under UPHCS, CBPHCS and HHW Scheme and forwarded to SUDA in the prescribed HMIS format. Out of 59 ULBs, the said data is available with SUDA for 57 ULBs (There is no Health Programme in Kulti Municipality. DRS has expressed that they will collect the said data from Kolkata Municipal Corporation directly).
