Urban Health Programmes

(i) Urban Primary Health Care Service (UPHCS)

This programme funded by Department of Municipal Affairs has been successfully implemented in the 41 KMA ULBs and 11 Non-KMA ULBs for health improvement of the people living below poverty line with special focus to women & children covering approx 68.00 lakh population.

The objective of this programme is to bring an overall improvement in Urban Health scenario as a whole with reference to reduction in Crude Birth Rate (CBR), Crude Death Rate (CDR), Maternal Mortality Rate (MMR), Infant Mortality Rate (IMR) and enhancement of Couple Protection Rate (CPR); to provide Primary Health Care Service delivery to the Urban population with focus on Reproductive & Child Health of BPL population; to implement various National Health Programmes, Public Health and to ensure maximum utilization of Government Institutions for referral services.

Primary Health care services are being catered by 8503 nos. of grass root level health functionaries and 1453 nos. of Sub-Centres, 172 nos. of Health Administrative Unit, 48 nos. of Extended Specialised Out Patient Department, 35 nos. of Maternity Home and 22 nos. of Diagnostic Centres. The accommodation of Sub-Centres have been provided either by NGO / CBO or ULBs.

Estimated fund allocation for FY 2014-15 is Rs. 5649.09 lakh.

(ii) Community Based Primary Health Care Services (CBPHCS) and HHW Scheme

To cover the remaining 74 ULBs in Non-KMA, which was not covered by any of the Primary Health Care Programmes earlier, both the Programmes have been taken up by the Health & FW Department in co-ordination with the Municipal Affairs Department. It covers total Urban population (34.03 lakhs) with special focus to BPL & marginalized (13.09 lakhs).

Objective of this Programme is of similar nature as described under Urban Primary Health Care Service.

Fund allocation - Rs. 2657.22 lakh for FY 2014-15.

(iii) Urban RCH Programme

Urban RCH Programme is implemented by Department of Health & Family Welfare in 99 Municipalities w.e.f. August, 2012 for strengthening of existing Reproductive & Child Health (RCH) services. Out of sanctioned no. of 99 MO & 397 ANM, 56 MO & 135 ANM are existing.

A fund of Rs. 279.75 lakh in FY 2012-13 and Rs. 61.41 lakh in FY 2013-14, thus totaling Rs. 341.16 has been released so far by DHFW to meet up the expenditure.

(iv) National Urban Health Mission (NUHM)

To strengthen existing Urban Health services, NUHM will be implemented in 92 ULBs (each ULB having population 50,000 & above) covering approx two Crore population. The service provision will include OPD, basic Lab. Diagnosis, Drug / contraceptive dispensing, delivery of Reproductive & Child Health services as well as preventive & promotive aspects of all communicable and non-communicable diseases. For the purpose, Project Implementation Plan (PIP) has been prepared in 1st phase by DHFW in consultation with the concerned 26 Municipalities (District towns) and 06 Municipal Corporations & SUDA. The PIP for 32 Urban Local Bodies (ULBs) has been approved by Govt. of India for FY 2013-14 for which a dissemination meeting was held on 24.03.2014 wherein Department of Health & Family Welfare, Department of Municipal Affairs, CMOH of all the Health Districts and the representative of 32 ULBs participated. Furthermore, PIP is under preparation for the said 32 ULBs as well as rest of 60 ULBs for FY 2014-15.

(v) Janani Suraksha Yojana (JSY)

Janani Suraksha Yojana has been introduced by the Govt. of India, aiming at reducing overall Maternal Mortality Rate & Infant Mortality Rate by providing Antenatal care, identifying pregnancy related complications and increasing Institutional Deliveries.

Pregnant women of BPL, SC & ST category after completion of 3rd Antenatal Checkup will receive incentive of Rs. 900/- only in case of Institutional Delivery and Rs. 500/- in case of home delivery through A/C Payee Cheque.

Health & Family Welfare Dept. is the Nodal Department of the State. Since Financial Year 2006-07, State Urban Development Agency has been functioning as the Nodal Agency for Urban JSY of the State. So far total amount of JSY Fund of Rs. 20.75 Crore has been received from Health & Family Welfare Dept. An amount of Rs. 16.89 Crore have been utilized for the purpose. Total no. of JSY beneficiaries stands at 3.06 lakh.

(vi) Prevention & Control of Vector Borne Diseases

- Out of total sanctioned amount of Rs. 449.46 lakh, Rs. 224.74 lakh has been released to 126 ULBs in FY 2013-14 for purchase of Larvicidal Oil, IEC, printing of leaflet & Training.
- House to house visit for surveillance of fever cases due to Dengue / Malaria will be held in 41 ULBs as identified by DHFW w.e.f. June, 2014. For the purpose, a trainers training has already been held at SUDA on 22.05.2014 and Micro-plan for conduct of house to house visit have already been received from the 41 ULBs.

PHACO কি?

এটি একটি আধুনিক পদ্ধতি যেখানে Ultrasonic Energy ব্যবহার করা হয় এবং তার দ্বারা একটি ছোট ছিড্রের (২ মি.মি.) মাধ্যমে ছানি বার করে দেওয়া হয়। এই operation অত্যন্ত দ্রুত হয় ও বেদনহীন। চোখে অনুভূতি বিলোপ করে করা হয় তাই রোগী কোন ব্যথা অনুভব করে না।

- খুব ছোট ছিড্র নিয়ে করা হয়। (২ মি.মি.)
- সেলাই এর দরকার হয় না।

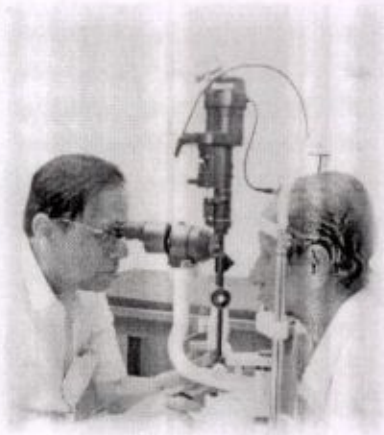

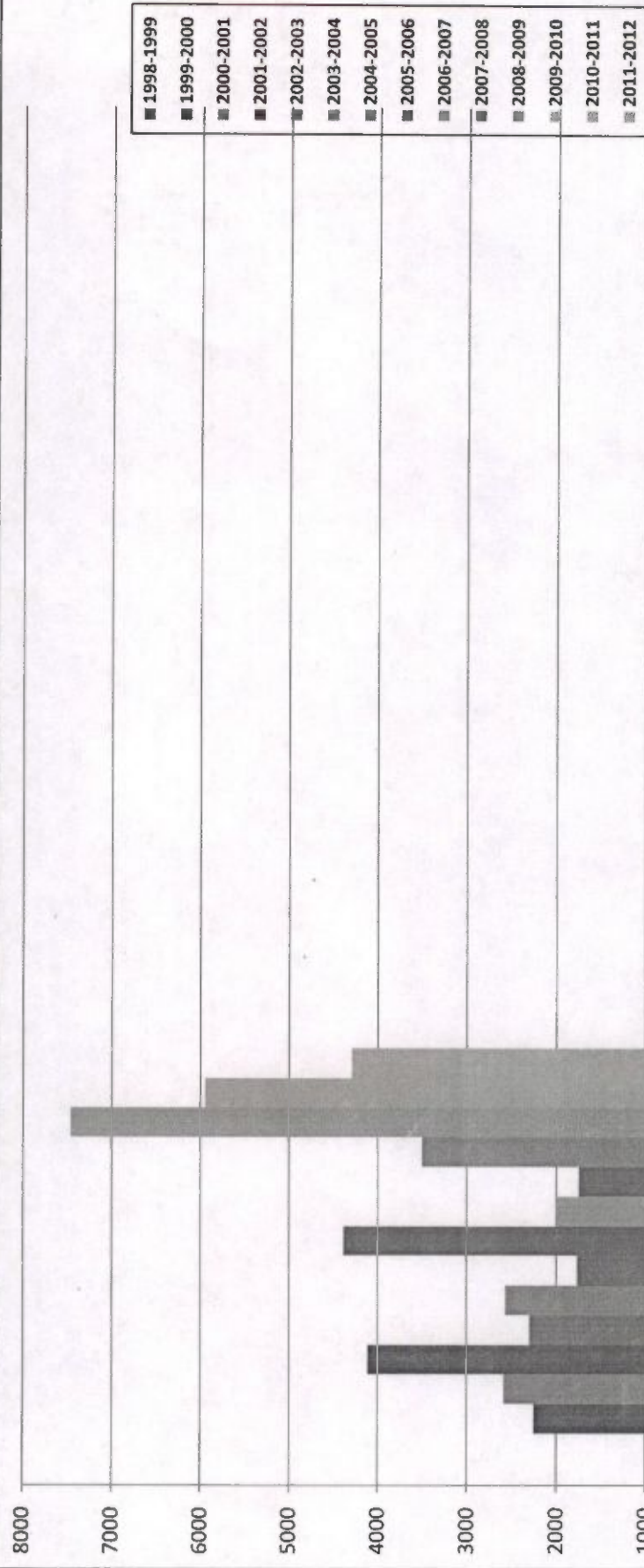
