Hon'ble Chief Minister, West Bengal has several times stressed the importance toward prevention and control of Vector Borne Diseases in Urban areas. For this purpose adequate measures for the prevention of disease which include vigorous activities like procurement of sufficient Larvicidal Oil is required at the same time intensive campaign among the communities including printing of leaflet, training of health functionaries and others to develop the awareness and to keep vigil on the Vector Borne Diseases is ^{also} the utmost important.

To ensure the above stated activities ULB wise requirement of fund has been estimated in most conservative manner and it comes to Rs.809.62 lakh. Normally, the required fund is being provided by the Municipal Affairs Department from Budgetary Allotment but at the fag end of the Financial Year 2013-14, Municipal Affairs Department has expressed inability to accommodate the additional fund ^{from} the budget of the Financial Year. However it has been assured that due care would be taken of regarding allotment of fund in next financial year.

Considering the importance and urgency of the above stated programme it is suggested that we may utilise the required amount from the fund available under IPP-VIII subject to replenishment of the fund as soon as the allotment for the purpose is received from the M.A. Department.
