Sub. : Proposal for allotment of additional no. of HHWs under CBPHCS submitted by the ULBs

As per project proposal of CBPHCS, one HHW is to be allotted for a population not exceeding 1000 BPL contained in a single ward. A ward having less than 1000 BPL population will also have one HHW; a ward having BPL population between 1000 – 2000 will have 2 HHWs and so on. There will be minimum one HHW per ward regardless of whether that ward has BPL population or not.

CBPHCS has been launched with the approval of DHFW in the year 2006. In the project proposal 1266 nos. of HHWs was approved on the basis of BPL population calculated @ 33% of total population as on 2001 census, keeping the principle 1 HHW per 1000 BPL population or the no. of wards which is higher.

After finalization of BPL population survey 2006, some of the ULBs have requested to sanction additional no. of HHWs either due to increased no. of BPL population in the ward or increased no. of ward.

The Table below will reflect ULB-wise no. of wards, existing no. of HHWs, Addl. No. of HHWs required on the basis of recent survey and the no. of addl. HHWs required by the ULBs :

No. of additional HHWs required by the above mentioned ULBs is 63 so far. It is to mention here that total 1266 no. of HHWs had been approved by DHFW in the project proposal. At present the total no. of HHWs are 1255. Hence, decision may be obtained towards sanction of addl. 63 no. of HHWs. This may need approval of DHFW and Finance Dept.

This is to mention here that ward-wise BPL population survey, 2006 have been taken into account while preparing above statement. As per instruction no. of HHW is calculated as 1 for 1500 BPL population in a single ward. There will be at least one HHW irrespective of no. of BPL population. It is also to mention here that Purulia under HHW Scheme also submitted prayer for additional HHWs vide his letter no PM/DFID/HHW/113 dt. 24.01.2009 at Flag - B. It may be seen from the statement that additional HHWs are not required by Joynagar Mazilpur and Taki Municipality as per statement submitted.
