

Sub. : Reporting on monitoring visit at Baranagar Municipality by officials of Health & Family Welfare Department and SUDA.

Placed herewith a report on monitoring visit at Baranagar Municipality on 27.10.2016.

The Monitoring team suggested the following :

1. Peri-domestic areas poses the major threat than that of domestic areas. Vector Control measures of peri-domestic areas is beyond the scope of house to house survey team members. Conservancy departments need to be involved. Presence of such peri-domestic area to be highlighted in the house to house survey activity report and the supervisor shall be held responsible such reporting.
2. Team-wise house to house survey report needs to be analysed for taking focus attention.
3. Spray workers to be sensitized regarding the exact dosage of the formulation of insecticide and the specific areas to be sprayed.
4. Councillors may be requested to intervene in case of areas where the survey team members could not get access.
5. Irrigation Department may be informed / involved to take action regarding water logging due to overflow of the Bagjola Canal.

On the basis of the above observation, the following actions may be taken :

1. The report may be sent to the Chairman, Bar anagar Municipality for taking necessary action and to request for sending an action taken report.
2. A training Programme for spray workers may be organized in consultation with Health & Family Welfare Department.
3. Department may be requested for taking up the issue with Irrigation Department regarding water logging due to overflow of the Bagjola Canal.

Both the ULBs have taken actions with regard to house to house visit to be held with effect from May 2017.

- Notice shall be issued by Bidhannagar MC and Dum Dum Municipality to the owner of the construction sites to take care off unmanaged water storage.
- Abandoned factory premises in Bidhannagar MC need attention for source reduction.
- Volunteers engaged by Bidhannagar MC are to be more careful w.r.t. examination of container followed by monitoring by the supervisor.
- Gambusia fish cultivation in large open drain / in well by the ULB.
