In 2008-09 110 nos. of loan cases were sponsored by the Municipality under USEP component of SJSRY, out of which 23 cases have so far been sanctioned by bank (s) and subsidy has been released by SUDA. Workshop was organised by SUDA in Dhuliyan Municipality for the members of TCG groups to enhance their capacity for formation of UWSP.

Ward based R.I centre need to open to cover the vast left out population. It has been observed that with the support of SUDA (H), WBSISC, N.T.S-Murshidabad and Dist. family welfare Dept. a good no of F.T.S were recently trained on skill development training of Immunization. These newly trained F.T.S can be effectively utilised to strengthen the R.I in ULBs. In this connection, a review meeting of R.I in ULBs will be organised on 5th Jan-2010 at 1 pm at District health and family welfare samity meeting hall (Attached C.M.O.H Bung low). This meeting will also discuss the preparing of the fourth coming IPPI Round in ULBs.

Sir,

You may be aware that Community Based Primary Health Care Services was launched in 63 non-KMA Urban Local Bodies with the approval of Dept. of Health and Family Welfare w.e.f February, 2006. The nodal agency for implementation of the scheme is Municipal Affairs Department and the State Urban Development Agency(SUDA) has been vested with the responsibility of supervision and monitoring.

As per Urban Health Strategy – 2008 developed by DHFW in consultation with Municipal Affairs Dept., Primary Health care, Public Health care and National Health programme are to be implemented in the ULBs. Dhuliyian Municipality is one of the 63 Non-KMA ULBs where Community Based Primary Health care is also being implemented. You may also be aware that job placement training of Honorary Health Workers- the grass root level health functionaries of the said scheme, was imparted by your office at Dhulian Municipality.

Honbl'e MIC, MA&UD, along with the Secretary, Dept. of Municipal Affairs visited Dhuliyian Municipality on 12.11.09 and expressed his concern about health of Bidi workers particularly with regard to primary health care including Ante Natal Care, Institutional delivery & Routine Immunization and public health care services as well.

You are requested to provide status based on data available with you in respect of primary and public health of the population of Dhuliyian Municipality particularly for Bidi workers as well as gaps identified, if any, and suggested solution thereof.

In this connection it is to mention here that under the health component of CMU, KUSP, there is some limited scope for strengthening of existing urban health care services. On receipt of your reply, the feasibility of rendering some assistance for strengthening & improving the existing health care services would be examined by CMU for taking possible corrective measures.

Your early response in this regard would be highly appreciated.



- ✓ 1) Director SUDA and Health expert of SUDA (i.e. Dr. Sibani Goswami) will visit the Dhulian municipality within next two weeks to particularly advise the municipality on schematic actions to be taken with regard to health of Biri workers in particular.
- 2) Project Director, KIJSP may be approached by Dr. Sibani Goswami to particularly find out whether new sub-centres and / or new schemes for the above could be evolved from out of innovative challenge fund. Alternatively, Dr. Goswami may also approach the Special Secretary (Debasis Mitra) for suitable funding in this regard.
- ✓ 3) Director, SUDA will also ensure early release of revolving funds in favour of the reported 190 TCGs that have been formed in Dhulian.
- ✓ 4) Director, SUDA will also ensure credit linkages and bank loan facilities towards self employment of the urban poor and will particularly explore whether a micro-market could be established in Dhulian.
- 5) If the Dhulian Municipality can send an integrated proposal for upgradation / construction of a burial ground, then such projects may be considered by Joint Secretary, Asok Kr. Patra in the department.
- 6) Some allotment could be considered for SWM land also if a comprehensive proposal comes.
- 7) A scheme for drainage may be formulated by the municipality with the help of MED in the long run.

MIC may visit Dhulian municipality within a month again to review the progress of works.
