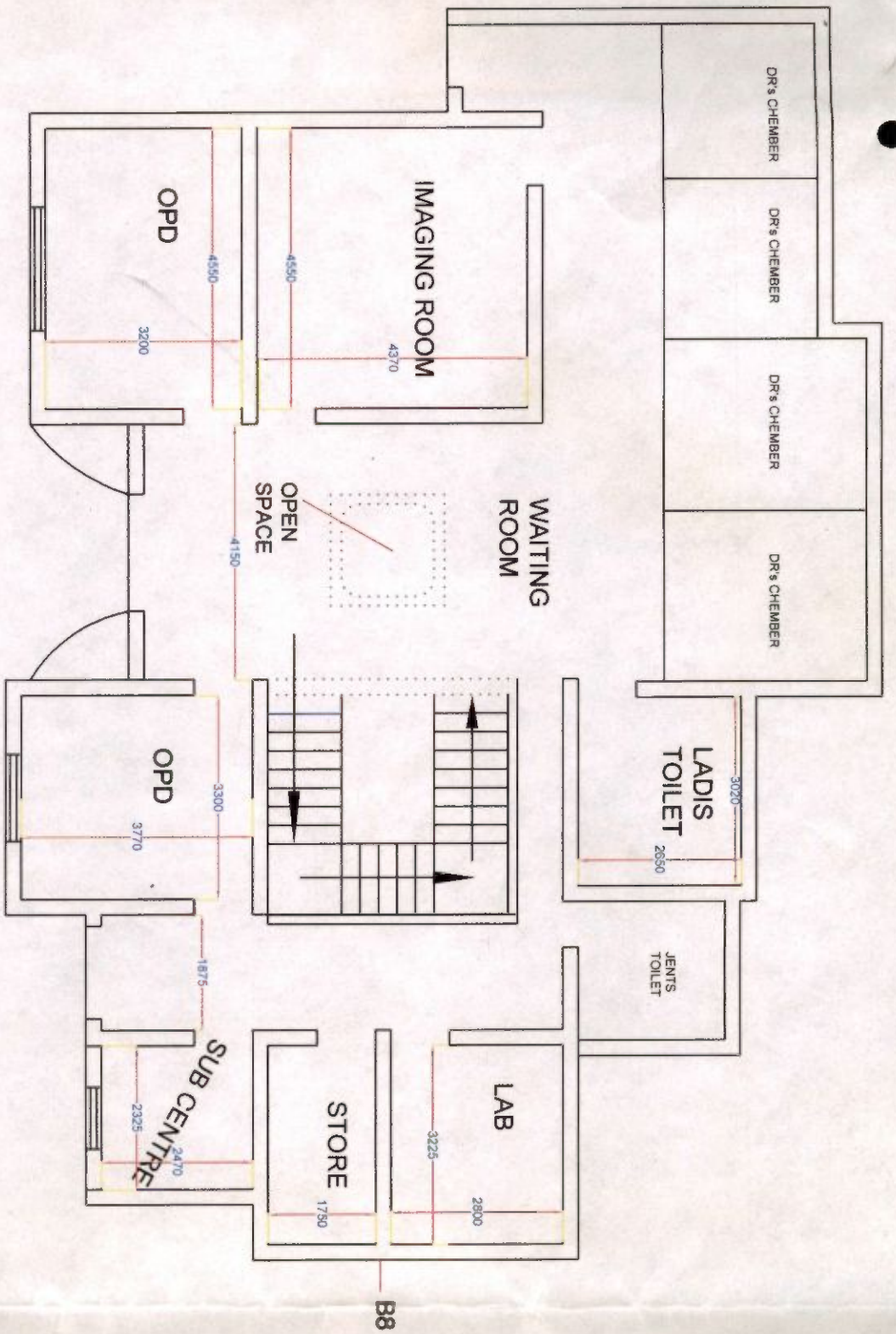
GROUND FLOOR PLAN
