## Treatment of Vivax Malaria

Diagnosis of vivax malaria may be made by the use of RDT (Bivalent) or microscope examination of the blood smear. On confirmation following treatment is to be given:

**Drug schedule for treatment of *P. vivax* malaria:**

1. Chloroquine: 25 mg/kg body weight divided over three days i.e.  
10 mg/kg on day 1  
10 mg/kg on day 2 and  
5 mg/kg on day 3.

2. Primaquine: 0.25 mg/kg body weight daily for 14 days.

Primaquine is contraindicated in infants; pregnant women and individuals with G<sub>6</sub>PD deficiency.

14 day regimen of Primaquine should be given under supervision.

## 1. Artemisinin based Combination Therapy (ACT-SP)

Artesunate (AS), available as 50 mg tablets are given for three days, and Sulfadoxine-Pyrimethamine (S-P) tablets, containing 500 mg Sulfadoxine and 25 mg pyrimethamine are given for one day, as shown in the dosage chart below.

All tablets for a day should be taken together, swallowed with water.

In addition, Primaquine (PQ Large) tablets should be given on the second day.

Dose schedule for Treatment of uncomplicated *P.falciparum* cases:

### 1. Artemisinin based Combination Therapy (ACT-SP)

Artesunate 4 mg/kg body weight daily for 3 days Plus

Sulfadoxine (25 mg/kg body weight) – Pyrimethamine (1.25 mg/kg body weight)  
on first day.

\* ACT is not to be given in 1st trimester of pregnancy.

o Primaquine 0.75 mg/kg body weight on day 2.

## Treatment of uncomplicated *P. falciparum* cases in pregnancy:

**1st Trimester** : Quinine salt 10mg/kg 3 times daily for 7 days.

Quinine may induce hypoglycemia; pregnant women should not start taking quinine on an empty stomach and should eat regularly, while on quinine treatment.

**2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> trimester**: Area-specific ACT as per dosage schedule given above.

i.e. ACT-AL in North Eastern States

ACT-SP in Other States

- Primaquine (PQ) prevents transmission of falciparum malaria to others by its ability to kill gametocytes. PQ tablets should be taken after a meal; not on an empty stomach. Children less than the age of one year and pregnant women should not be given Primaquine. As pregnant women having falciparum malaria require different medicines, they should be directed to go to the nearest PHC or hospital immediately, without delay.

## Treatment of mixed infections (*P. vivax* + *P. falciparum*) cases:

All mixed infections should be treated with full course of ACT and Primaquine 0.25 mg per kg body weight daily for 14 days.

**In North-Eastern States:** Treat with Age-specific ACT-AL for 3 days + Primaquine 0.25 mg per kg body weight daily for 14 days.

**In Other States:** SP-ACT 3 days + Primaquine 0.25 mg per kg body wt daily for 14 days.

### How to reconstitute Inj. Artesunate for I.V. use

The content of a vial of inj. artesunate (60 mg) needs to be dissolved in 1 ml of 5% (w/v) inj. sodium bicarbonate. If the available inj. sodi bicarb is 7.5% w/v, make it 5% in the following way.

Take 1 ml of the available sodi bicarb inj (7.5%) in a syringe. Draw 0.5 ml of water for injection into it to make the total content 1.5 ml. Shake gently and then discard 0.5 ml of the solution from the syringe. Now you are left with 1 ml of 5% inj. sodi bicarb in the syringe.

Push the 1 ml of 5% inj. sodi bicarb into the vial of inj. artesunate. Dissolve the whole content properly.

Take 5 ml of 0.9% inj. sodium chloride (i.e. inj. normal saline) or 5% inj. dextrose in a 5 ml or 10 ml syringe and push it into the vial of already dissolved artesunate. Shake gently to mix. Now you have a solution of inj. artesunate – 60 mg in 6 ml i.e. 10 mg per ml.

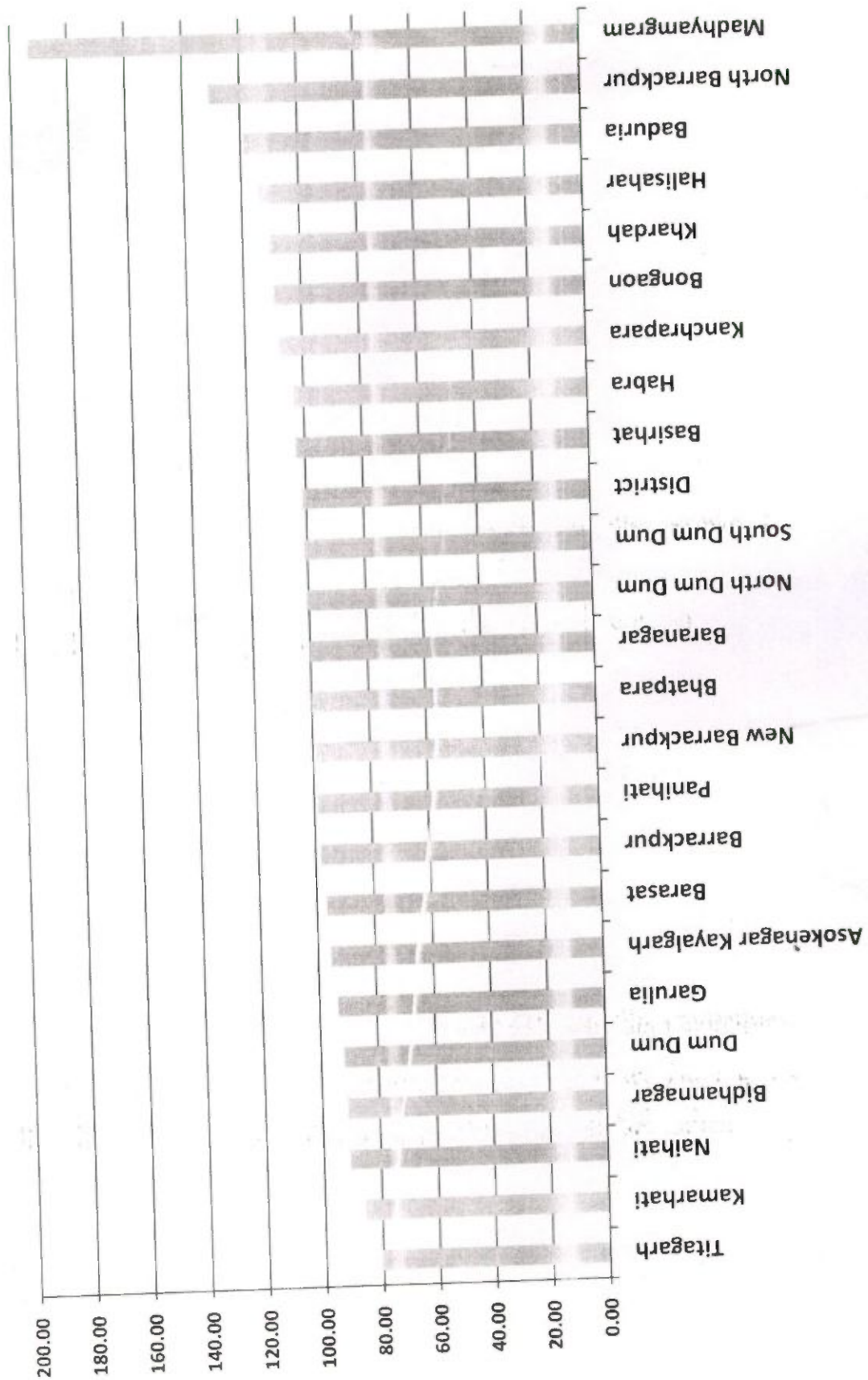
If body weight of the patient is 20 kg, one dose would be  $2.4 \times 20$  i.e. 48 mg, say 50 mg. So, 5 ml of the solution is to be given I.V. If the body weight is 60 kg, the dose would be  $2.4 \times 60$  i.e. 144 mg, say 140 mg. In this case, 3 vials have to be made ready and total 14 ml of reconstituted medicine has to be given (6 ml from 1<sup>st</sup> vial + 6 ml from 2<sup>nd</sup> vial + 2 ml from the 3<sup>rd</sup> vial) I.V.

### **Please note**

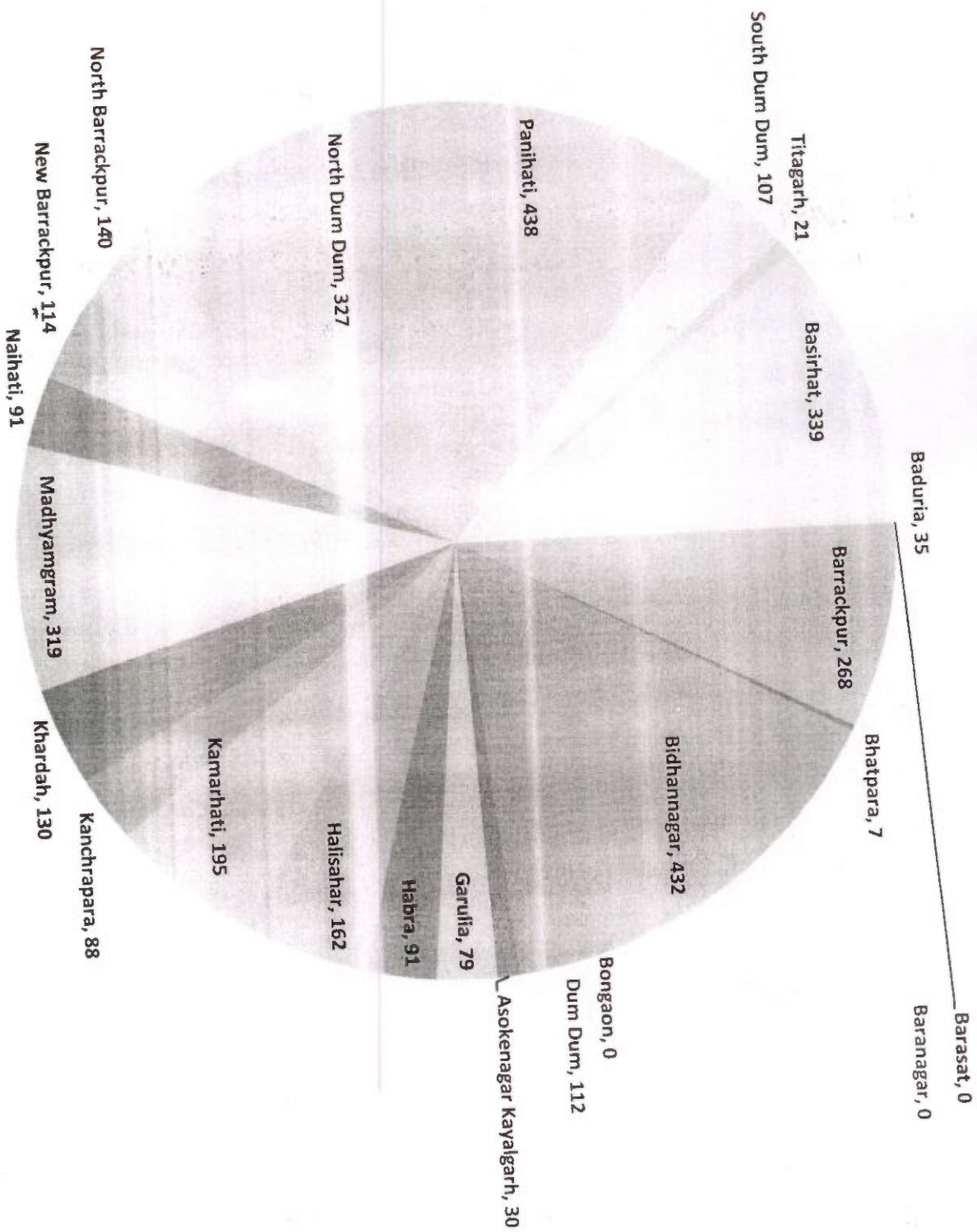
The powder for injection is difficult to dissolve. Ensure that it is completely dissolved before parenteral administration.

Use the drug immediately following reconstitution. Discard any left-over solution. If the solution is cloudy or a precipitate is present, discard it.

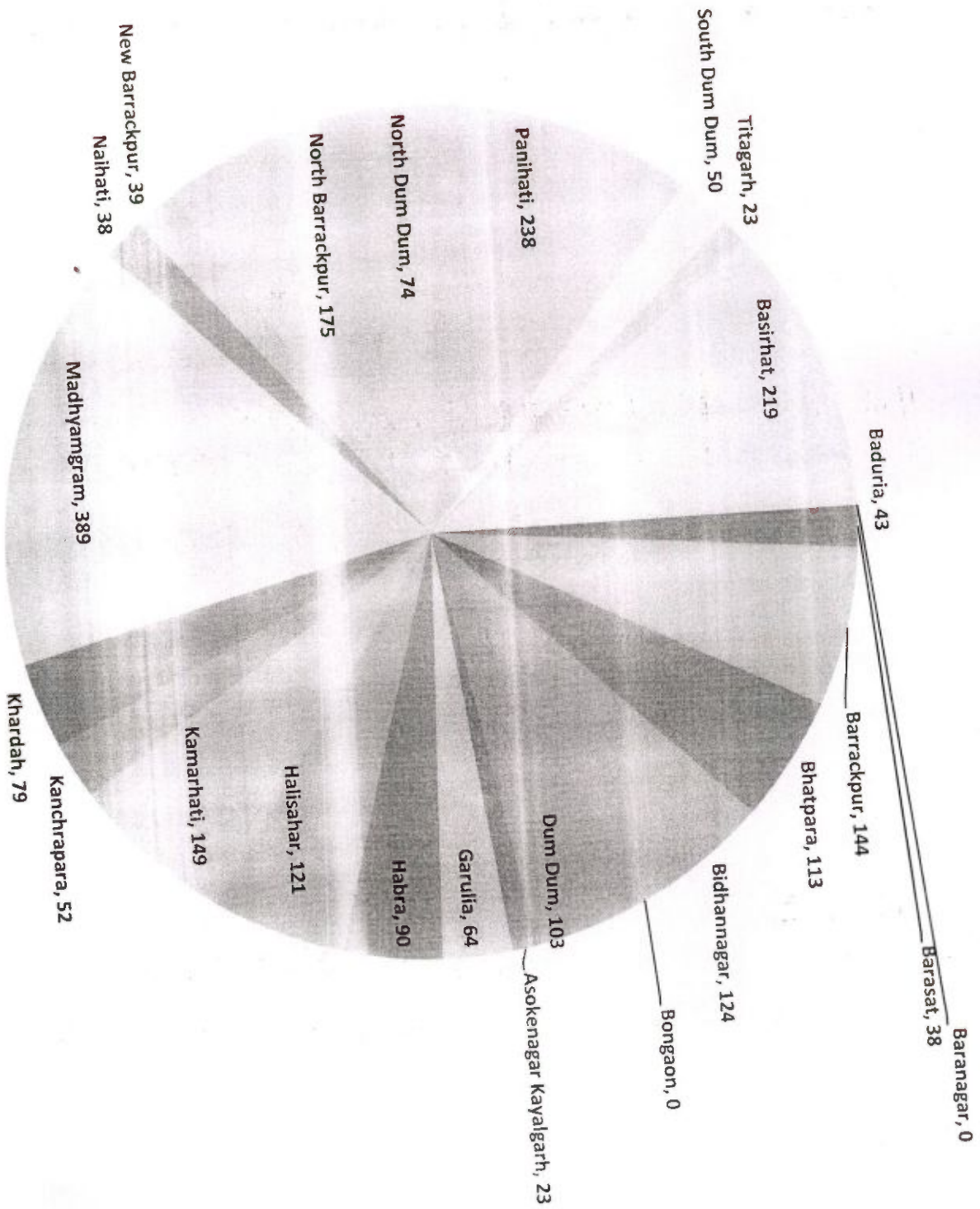
% of Household covered against recorded household



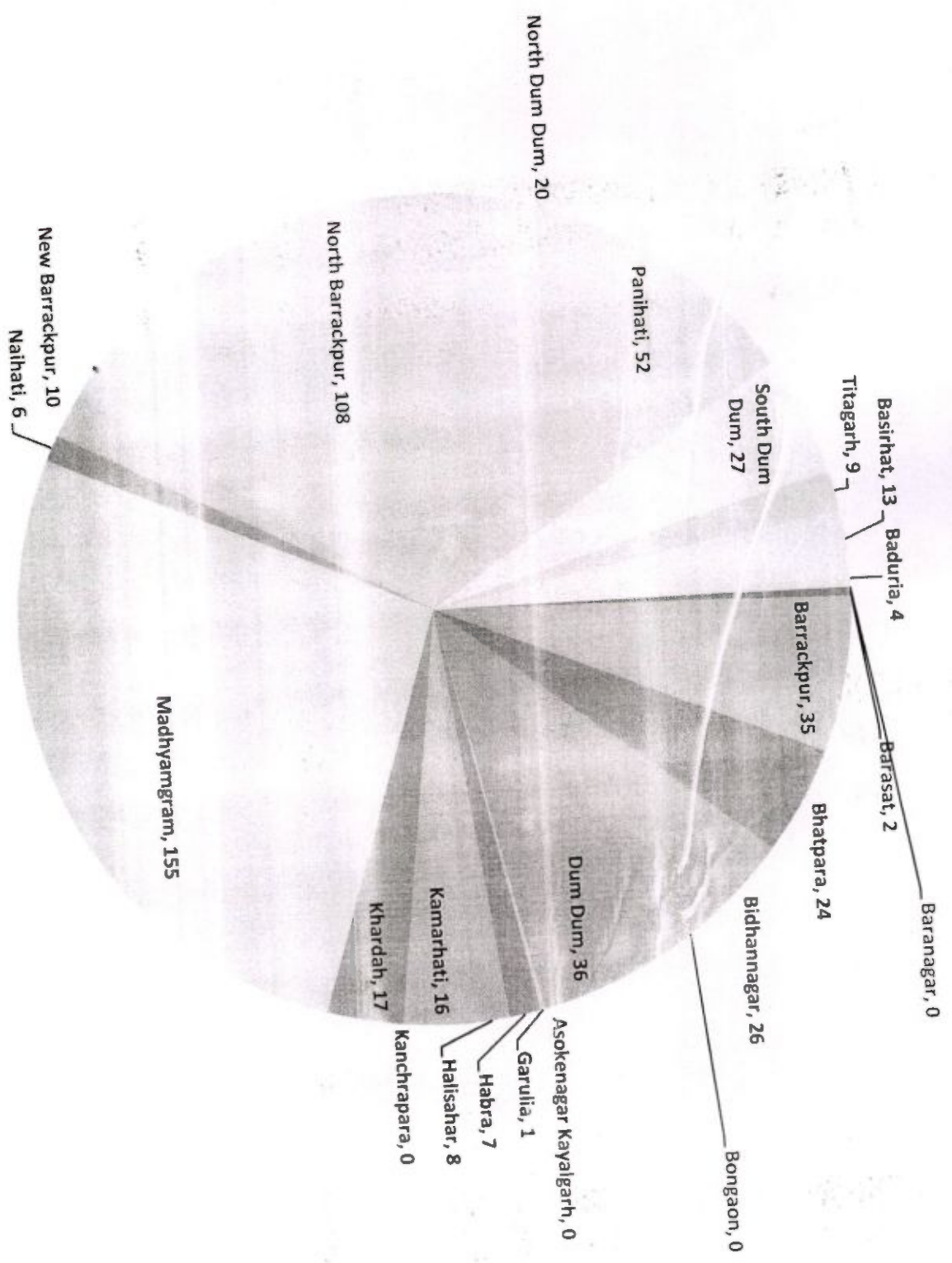
# No. of sites of pile of garbage (n=3525)
