Revised Work plan for Pulse Polio Immunization programme in June & July 08' Rounds at Maheshtala Municipality.

Maheshtala Municipality has been identified as a high risk zone for the spread of polio P1 type in the South 24- Parganas District & at present W. Bengal is one of the only two States in India with WPV circulation in 2008. According to WHO, if the transmission is not stopped before monsoon it could result in local out break & threaten the Polio Eradication programme of the entire country.

Though the Health workers (IPP-VIII & ICDS) & Social workers (Women) are sincerely & efficiently working as Supervisors & Vaccinators in co-operation with the officers & Staffs of the Health Section of the Municipality under the leadership of the Health Officer , yet a large number of children remaining unimmunised (with more than 1500 XR houses) during each phase of Pulse Polio Immunization programme

Based on the observation made at the field , interaction with the H.O, A.H.O, Chairman, Supervisors & Vaccinators of the municipality and the WHO & UNICEF officials, a new approach with modification of execution are proposed in the following plan.

Proposed System:-

The entire operation of the week May be conducted with Ice-packs only , in such case 2 sets of 1600 Nos. Ice- packs are required . But so far informations received from Dy. CMOH-III & SMO , NPSP that Ice- packs are not available separately at present, but District & State Health officialrs are trying their best to purchase a bulk Nos of Icc- packs from manufacturing unit of Maharashtra

Not only Ice- packs, at least 3 Nos. of ILR & DeepFreezer are also required at 3 DCCs like HAU – I , HAU- II & HAU – VI for Pulse Polio programme & Routine Immunization also.

But for incoming two Pulse Polio Rounds the programme will be operated by Ice- packs on booth day & by Ice only during H to H activity day (Monday to Saturday) .

The three locally available Ice Factories identified & discussed with them on 17.5.08 & they assumed for Ice –packing (@Rs. 5/- per ice-pack) for boothday & supplying ice @ Rs. 5/- per Kg. from Monday to Satarday as per our requirement.

***For Visibility of Booths-**

At least two Nos. Banners & 10 Nos. Posters are required. For Displaying Banners & Posters 5 to 6 days before boothday the responsibility May be given to any NGO like Amount Foundation Trust and/ or UNICEF . The list of prominent places for displaying Banners & Posters will be supplied from this end.

***Regarding Routine Immunization –**

the proposal of 42 out reach immunization sessions (in addition to fixed 46 sessions at IPP-VIII HAUs , Subcentres & Matrisadan) , has already been given to the CMOH & Dr. Satpathi (ADHS, Planning)

Dr. Satpati has already given assurance of sanctioning such proposal &also agreed to provide 3 ILR & 3Deep Freezer at HAU – I , II & VI for implementing such large no of Immunization sessions in this Municipality (42 SQ-KMs area) , maintaining appropriate Cold- chain system.

Though the F.T.Ss (42 Nos) are giving Routine Immunization at HAU & Sub center of IPP-VIII in presence of the P.T.M.Os . But P.T.M.Os are not always attending the Immunization sessions. For outreach immunization sessions & fixed immunization sessions these F.T.ss may be given proper Training at District/ State Level Hospital for authorising them for giving such Immunization (Injection) without Depending on P.T.M.Os.



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
