

The Routine Immunization activity in Kolkata has been restructured, with special emphasis on quality immunization activities. The microplan has been prepared with assistance from all agencies, cold chain has been reorganized, and training on immunization for Medical Officers and PHNs of different health institutions of Kolkata has been completed. KMC has now declared as nodal agency for Kolkata. Regular pogramme review has been initiated. The pogramme has been started from 19th November, 2008.



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
