Srl No: 1 | A.H.O : Though specific qualification in P.H. is lacking, yet the nature of experience documented point to experience in Public Health Services.

- Srl No 2/ Medical Supervisor : Fulfills the criteria of qualification and experience laid down in the guide line op cit.
- Srl No 3/Jr Training Officer (P.H.N) : No specific qualification in Public Health Nursing. G.N.M qualification possessed by the candidate might have some exposure on Public Health. Her age as stated is 60 +.
- Srl No.4/Statistical Assistant : No specific degree in statistics. However <sup>he is</sup> in possession of working experience as statistical assistant.
- Srl No 5/ Accounts Assistant : Fulfills the criteria by and large.

In view of the circumstances, spelled out at the P.U.D, the above candidature list may be considered for approval. If approved, initial appointment will be made by the Municipal Corporation for a period of 6(six) months.
