FINDINGS OF THE CONTROLLING AUTHORITY UNDER THE PAYMENT OF GRATUITY ACT, 1972 (ACT 39 OF 1972)

In the matter of an application dated 09.04.2009 (Form N) filed for direction under the Payment of Gratuity Act, 1972 and being numbered G-48/2010.

BETWEEN

The Controlling Authority under Payment of Wages Act, 1972 (hereinafter referred to as the said Act) received from the applicant of above named an application dt. 09/04/09 filed u/s 7 of the said Act for payment of gratuity due to him from the opposite parties of above named. The case of the application to put in brief, is that he joined the OP Co. on 01/03/2002 as Administrative Management Professional. He was terminated w.e.f. 30/09/07. He has rendered service in the establishment of OP 5 years 6 months and 29 days and last wages was drawn, Rs. 4850/- per month. His total claim of gratuity is Rs. 28,400/-.

Almost both the parties entered their appearance from the very beginning. The OP submitted a copy of Form 'M' under rule 8(i)(ii) of the Payment of Gratuity Rules 1973 on 13/01/2011. In spite of given several chances, the OP failed to submit their written statement. The applicant submitted written deposition on 25/11/11 alongwith exhibits as follows :-

- 1) Copy of appointment letter dt. 28/12/02 Exhibit - A
- 2) Copy of post-facto approval dt. 23/04/04 Exhibit - A1
- 3) Copy of working certificate dt. 03/09/07 Exhibit - A2
- 4) Copy of Certificate of Wages from April '05 to March '06 Exhibit - A3
and other exhibits A-3a, 3b, 3c, 3d, 3d(1), 3e and 3f.

The OP representative was handed over the copy of written deposition along Exhibits/Annexures as above on 28/11/11 and was requested to cross-examine the applicant but they did not cross-examine the applicant worker till 04/04/12. The OP witness submitted his evidence in chief on 27/08/12 but as the applicant was not allowed to cross-examine him by appearing himself on the dates fixed for same till 04/01/13, The date was fixed for submission of argument. Lastly, both applicant and OP submitted their argument on 05/02/13 and 17/02/13 respectively.

In the instant case there is no dispute between the parties in respect of applicant workers dt. of joining on 01/03/2002, termination service with effect from 08/10/07 and continuous service since 01/03/02 to 07/09/07 and last month wages Rs. 4850/-

The main contention OP is that the applicant worker was appointed purely temporary on contract basis in the post of Administrative Management Professional in the establishment of OP which has not been denied by the applicant worker. The OP further contended that above appointment was not made according to the provisions of Sec. 56 and 57 of West Bengal Municipal Act, 1993 and thus death cum retirement benefit contained in West Bengal Municipal Rule 2003 is not applicable to the applicant. Moreover, OP pointed out the "a relevant portion of the verdict of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India is thus" The source and mode of engagement / recruitment of work charged employees, their pay and conditions of employment are altogether different from the persons appointed in the Regular Establishment against sanctioned post after following the procedure prescribed under the relevant Act or Rules and their duties and responsibilities are also substantially different than those of Regular Employee" ((2009) 3 Supreme Court Case 661).

Here, the findings of the Controlling Authority is that the applicant worker was also not a regular employee in the establishment of OP but u/s. 2(e) of Payment of Gratuity Act 1972 though appointed as Administration Management Professional purely on contact basis and as his service is not governed by any other Act or rules providing for payment of gratuity, the applicant worker is considered an employee for entitled gratuity in respect of his continuous five years of service in the establishment of OP (u/s. 4(1) of the said Act).


After careful consideration of the facts of the case and examination of the views, evidence of the parties and documents on record the Controlling Authority finds that Shri Biswajit Roy, the applicant is entitled to gratuity under the payment of gratuity Act, 1972 on and from 01/03/02 to 07/09/07 (5 years 6 months 6 days) and amount of gratuity payable to the applicant is calculated under the said Act as follows: -

$$\text{Rs. 4850/-} \div 26 \times 15 \times 5 \text{ years 6 months} = \text{Rs. 15,389/-}$$

The amount of gratuity was payable to applicant worker at the time of his retirement Rs. 15,380/- but he was no gratuity. Therefore, the amount of gratuity Rs. 15,389/- is payable to the applicant alongwith entitled simple interest @10% per annum from 07/10/07 under the said Act. Till date of the gratuity is paid.

Therefore, the OP is hereby directed to pay Biswajit Roy, Ichhapur Ramchandra Path, Near 20 No. Rail Gate, P.O. Ichhapur Nawabganj, Dist. North 24 Parganas, the sum of Rs.15,389/- (Rupees fifteen thousand three hundred eighty nine) only within thirty days from the date of receipt of this direction in Form 'R' sent alongwith this findings. The OP is also requested to inform the Controlling Authority u/r 9(2) of the West Bengal Payment of Gratuity Rules 1973 within ten days from the OP of Payment as above.

The Mayors /Chairpersons of the Municipal Corporations /Municipalities shall issue orders of appointment on contract on consolidated pay in terms of Municipal Affairs Deptt.'s order in respect of the supportive staff already engaged for the Maternity Homes, and as Asstt. Health Officer and Staff Nurse under the municipalities on approval by IPP-VIII w.e.f. 01.07.2001 and shall take immediate steps for appointment of other supportive staff as sanctioned in the G.O. dated 20.11.2001 quoted above especially those who will be manning the Regional Diagnostic Centres, Maternity Homes on contract on consolidated pay p.m. sanctioned against each as well as take steps to fill up the vacancies in the posts of Asstt. Health Officer, full time Staff Nurse and other supportive staff in the units as and where necessary. While filling up such posts enclosed recruitment qualifications should be followed strictly and prior approval of the competent authority of IPP-VIII should be obtained.

This supersedes Memo Nos. 877/CMDA/FW(US) /IPP-VIII/E-20/98(Pt.) dated 09.06.2000 and 1023/CMDA/FW(US)/A—25/99 dated 13.07.2000 previously issued by the IPP-VIII, KMDA instructing engagement of the supportive staff in the Maternity Homes and under the municipalities as Asstt. Health Officer /Medical Officer and full time Staff Nurse on contract on daily wage basis.

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



Following to the notification of Dept. of Municipal Affairs bearing no. 610/MA/P/C-10/1G-5/2007 dt. 03.06.2008, a number of queries have been received from different ULBs regarding remuneration of Specialist Doctor attached to ESOPD under CUDP III, CSIP, IPP-VIII and IPP-VIII (Extn.). Necessary clarifications in this regard are given below :

- All the Specialist Doctors of ESOPD should get same rate of honorarium in all the projects like CUDP III, CSIP, IPP-VIII, IPP-VIII (Extn.) – as mentioned in GO of MAD dt. 3rd June, 2008.
- The ULBs who have engaged Specialist Doctors on clinic based fee, may maintain the same practice wherein the sanctioned consolidated pay may be divided by 8 visits in a month to arrive at the rate of fee per clinic, which will be Rs. 325/- per clinic for 8 clinics in a month.
- As the payment to Specialist Doctors is in nature of honorarium / salaries, the A/C head should be "Honorarium / Salaries" instead of "running cost of ESOPD", wherever applicable.






