

Sir./ Madam,

Two Drivers were engaged in accordance with the KMDA letter No. 64/CMDA/Health/CSIP/2A dated 27.5.94 (xerox enclosed) and their fixed honorarium was paid out of Ambulance Maint. cost and the fund was provided accordingly.

There are three Ambulances have been provided for two PP Centre at Garden Maternity Home & Champamoni Maternity Home, one Ambulance was provided for routine works like , carrying beneficiaries from the slum location to the centres where ligation is being undertaken and also to carry the emergent patients from beneficiaries house to the referral hospitals.

The fixed honorarium of each driver is Rs. 2500/- p.m. which is being paid out of Ambulance Maintenance funds being provided by the Govt. of West Bengal through KMDA till March 2008.

The services of two Ambulance Drivers are inescapable as there is acute shortage of Ambulance staff in the KMC.

All other expenses are being provided by the KMC.

In view of the above, it is requested that engagement of two Ambulance Drivers may kindly be considered alike previous occasion and their fixed honorarium @Rs. 3000.00 (as revised) per driver per month may kindly be included in the budget estimates namely 'Ambulance Maintenance cost'.

This is ~~your~~ for your information that very soon One Ambulance will be delivered to you as per ~~our~~ supply order no. 201/CMDA/Health/CSIP-2A dt. 22.11.93. Terms and conditions as laid down for the purpose by the competent authority are as follows which may kindly be adhered to.

- 1.(a) Salaries of Driver - Rs. 2000/- p.m. each for two drivers.
- (b) Cost of fuel - Rs. 2500/- p.m. / Vehicle. *2250/- p.m. enhanced w.e.f - 1.10.2005*
- (c) Maintenance of Vehicle - Rs. 6000/- p.m. / Vehicle.

The above expenditure is to be incurred from CSIP budget under head, ~~Centre operating cost~~ ~~General capital cost~~ sub-head 'Ambulance running cost' upto the end of project period after which it will be made from CMC budget. CMC will place indent under the above mentioned head and ~~will~~ debit the expenditure against ~~the~~ the same head.

2.(a) Ambulance is to be utilised for transportation ^{to} of emergency cases from the project area under CSIP Health Programme to any state Hospital/ any other authorised Hospital.

(b) The Ambulance is to be utilised for carrying the beneficiaries selected for Laparoscopic Sterilisation from the subcentre to the site where the operation will be done and also will carry back the patients after operations to their respective subcentres.

3. The Ambulance will be stationed at a suitable place where there is provision of Garage and the beneficiaries under CSIP phase a+b can avail of the facility of Ambulance at the time of need.

Kindly recall the discussion you had with Dr. D.C.Roy, Assistant Director CSIP(H)/CMDA on 19.3.96 in connection with the allocations of ODA fund (both capital & recurring) in respect of functioning of Maternity Homes under CSIP Health Programme.

The itemwise allotments of fund in respect of the Maternity Homes are appended for favour of your information :-

1. Maternity Homes' Renovation (Capital) - Rs.5.00 Lakhs + escalation as applicable as per rules in force (One time grant for Phase 1b)
2. Maternity Homes' Salaries (Recurring) - Rs.2.00 Lakhs per annum/Maternity Home. (Establishment cost for additional Staff)
3. Maternity Homes' Running Costs (Recurring) (contingency Expenditure) - Rs.0.50 lakhs Per annum per Maternity Home.
4. Maternity Homes' Ambulance Running Cost (Recurring) - Rs.0.84 lakhs per annum per Ambulance. (cf. Rates as communicated under this office letter no 199/CMDA/Health/CSIP-2A dt. 16.11.93)

Keeping in view of the above, you are requested to take measures in regard to renovation of the Maternity Home under Phase 1(b) and to engage necessary complement of additional staff on full time/part time/consultancy basis as will be considered by you, after opening of the renovated Maternity Homes (in both phases) and place your requisition of fund accordingly from the next financial year of 96-97. The renovation work in respect of phase 1(a) is stated to have been nearing completion and the utilisation certificate thereof may please be furnished on completion of the said renovated work.

An early action in respect of the above will be highly appreciated.
