

Sub : Payment of ex-gratia to all categories of personnel except Part-time Medical Officer working at HAUs, ESOPDs, Maternity Homes and Creches under CUDP-III, CSIP-1(a) & 1(b) and IPP-VIII Health Programmes.

During the last Puja in the year 1999 sanction was accorded by the competent authority for payment of ex-gratia to all categories of personnel except Part-time Medical Officer working at HAUs, ESOPDs, Maternity Homes and Creches established under CUDP-III, CSIP-1(a) & 1(b) and IPP-VIII Health Programmes. In this connection, a xerox copy of CMDA's relevant orders bearing No.321/11/CMDA/Sectt/FW-(USP)-59/95 dated 30.9.99 and Order No.442/CMDA/Sectt/G-16/94 dt.30.9.99 are placed below for kind perusal. During that time, an amount of Rs.1000/- was paid per head irrespective of monthly honorarium to all categories of personnel except Part-time Medical Officer working at HAUs, ESOPDs, Maternity Homes and Creches established under CUDP-III, CSIP-1(a) & 1(b) and IPP-VIII Health Programmes. This rate of ex-gratia so decided was at par with the rate of ex-gratia given to the voluntary workers employed under ICDS (Anganwa di workers) Project under Government of West Bengal.

This year also there is a pressing demand from all the local bodies implementing CUDP-III, CSIP-1(a) & 1(b) and IPP-VIII Health Programme for payment of ex-gratia to the above mentioned personnel. It has been learnt from the District Officer, ICDS located at Salt Lake that the rate of ex-gratia for Anganwadi workers is under consideration for enhancement from the last year's approved rate of Rs.1000/- per head but it is likely to take some more time for issuance of the formal order.

In view of all above and in consideration of the limited time available before the ensuing Puja it is proposed that the payment of ex-gratia to all categories of personnel except Part-time Medical Officer working at HAUs, ESOPDs, Maternity Homes and Creches under CUDP-III, CSIP-1(a) & 1(b) and IPP-8 Health Programmes may be calculated and sanctioned at the last year's approved rate of Rs.1000/- per head for making necessary payment to the concerned personnel well in advance

before the Puja. If enhancement order for exgratia in respect of Anganwadi workers for ICDS is received in the meantime a supplementary order may be issued later on for payment of remaining balance of enhanced exgratia. This practice was adopted earlier also.

The financial implication at the last year's sanctioned rate of Rs.1000/- per head in respect of CUDP-III, CSIP-1(a) & 1(b) and IPP-VIII are shown in Annexure-I, II & III respectively. No separate proposal from IPP-VIII is being placed as discussed with Dr. S.K. Bhattacharjee, Deputy Chief of Health, IPP-VIII, CMDA. A combine proposal has been prepared covering all the 3 (three) above mentioned Health Programmes. Adequate funds are available with the concerned Health Programme Units to meet this expenditure.

Submitted for favour of kind consideration to extend the benefits to the 3 Health Programmes mentioned above as was done earlier years.

Sir,

I am directed, by order of the Governor to say that the Governor has been pleased to sanction Ex-gratia payment to the Anganwadi Workers & Helpers under the ICDS Scheme in West Bengal @ Rs.1000/- (Rupees one thousand) only for each Anganwadi Worker and Rs.800/- (Rupees eight hundred) only for each Helper.

2. The Governor has also been pleased to sanction a sum of Rs. 6,57,77,200/- (Rupees six crore fifty seven lakhs seventy seven thousand two hundred) only to the Child Development Project Officers who are in charge of the ICDS Projects for payment of Ex-gratia to the Anganwadi Workers & Helpers of the ICDS Projects to the extent of amount mentioned against each in the enclosed statement.

3. Anganwadi Workers & Helpers who were in service on 31.3.99 and have rendered at least six months continuous service during the year 1998-99 will be entitled to get the benefit of Ex-gratia payment.

4. The Governor has also been pleased to allot a sum of Rs.6,57,77,200/- (Rupees six crore fifty seven lakhs seventy seven thousand two hundred) only as sanctioned in para-2 above to the Child Development Project Officers for payment of Ex-gratia to the Anganwadi Workers & Helpers under the ICDS Scheme.

5. The charges may be met from the provision under the head, "2235-Social Security & Welfare-02-Social Welfare-102-Child Welfare-Non-plan-001-Govt. of India's crash Programme of Nutrition for children-50-Other charges(2235-02-102-N.P.-001-V-50) in the State Budget 1999-2000.






