Sir,

As you are aware the Health & Family Welfare Department, Municipal Affairs Department & SUDA are working together to bring out an uniform urban health service delivery system for the whole of West Bengal in tune with the Urban Health Strategy, 2008.

In keeping with the commitment of providing minimum basic health services to all the urban population, the following has been decided

- 1. Extension of the Community Based Primary Health Care programme in 63 Non-KMA ULBs for a further period of 1 year w.e.f. 01.04.10
- Continuation of HHW scheme in 11 Non-KMA ULBs from the State Budget for a period of 1
 year w.e.f. 01.04.10

Provision of fund of Fs.10.00 Crores has been made for the year 2010-2011 on basis of the following:

- 1. The rate of salary for the staff of ULBs under the programmes has been calculated on the existing scale.
- 2. Funds for training of HHWs/FTS were released in previous years and as per status report submitted vide SUDA/Health/69(pt-I)/08/597 dated 01.02. 10. Most of the training is complete. The unspent fund lying with SUDA will take care of the gap in training.
- 3. As stated in the letter vide SUDA/Health/69(pt-I)/08/597 dated 01.02. 10 the IEC materials have been printed all Kits and Manuals have been bought. Fresh allocation is made only to the extent replenishment would be required. Detailed list of articles that is proposed to be bought may be supplied.
- 4. Allocation for furniture and equipments have been made in the previous years and the report from SUDA states that the same has been purchased for all the health centres, so fresh allocation is not made in this sector. Fresh allocation may be made if required. SUDA has to submit list of Furniture and equipment bought and intended to be bought under the scheme.

5. Allocation for Drugs will be released subject to submission of Drug list. SUDA may be requested to make the purchases of drugs from CMS approved vendors at CMS approved price.

Further SUDA may be requested to submit the following:

- 1. List of all the ULBs under these programmes and their set-up.
- 2. The infrastructure available in these set-up including existing Manpower.
- 3. List of medicines that are purchased and supplied under these schemes

It may be noted that once the urban health service delivery system is in place the sanction made 4. UC of amount already spent by SUDA towards these schemes will automatically cease and unspent fund will merge with the budgetary allocation to be made for the integrated scheme. The modalities of the same may be decided once the scheme is operationalized. Yours faithfully,




Dear Mr. Raman,

You are aware that a Pilot Project to expand the Honorary Health Workers (HHWs) Scheme in 11 Municipalities of West Bengal supported by DFID under Health Sector Development Initiative (HSDI) was sanctioned by the Ministry of Health & FW (MoHFW), Government of India (GoI) vide letter no.L.19012/46/02-APS dated December 2, 2003. The Project at a total cost of Rs 5.9 crore was for a period of one year. The first installment of grant-in-aid amounting to Rs 2 crore, out of sanctioned Project cost of Rs 5.9 crore was also released by GoI on December 31, 2003 for implementation of the Project.

However, considering the delay in starting the Project particularly in the context of Parliamentary Election in May 2004, the end date of this Pilot Project has been extended to June 2005 with no escalation in Project cost. Copies of the letter of DFID dated April 19, 2004 recommending to Department of Economic Affairs (DEA), Gol for extension and the office memorandum under No.12/1/2001-EEC.II dated June 21, 2004 of DEA, concurring such extension are enclosed for ready reference.

The implementation of this innovative Project with the involvement of different agencies / departments was started for all practical purposes only in the month of June 2005 after the Parliamentary Election was over in May 2004. But for variety of reasons, all the 11 municipalities could not start the Project work simultaneously as per schedule. Couple of municipalities have initiated the implementation only in January 2005. However, initial activities in all the municipalities have now been completed and the Project infrastructures at different levels are in place to carry forward the Project for its desired output. A status report of the Project as on April 1, 2005 is enclosed for your perusal. So far Rs 71.64 lac out of Rs 2.0 crore released by Gol could be spent by the State Urban Development Agency, which is

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However, considering the progress made so far in the Project, it is unlikely that the Project will be completed within June 2005. It is not also desirable that after putting in so much effort and fund, the Project should be dropped incomplete midway. Though the HHW scheme has been included in the United Kingdom / India Health System Development Initiative —Grant 2005, sanctioned by DFID only recently, it is expected to take considerable time to formalize the agreement to facilitate actual fund flow.

Under the above circumstances, it is proposed that the end date of the Pilot Project on HHW Scheme may be extended till March 31, 2006 within the sanctioned Project cost so that the activities stipulated in the Project proposal can be completed.

You are requested to kindly recommend the extension to DEA under intimation to DFID and our Department at an early date to end the uncertainty relating to this project.
