As services of HHWs & FTSs are limited to BPL families, entire population of BPL families could not be covered. Training of HHWs & FTSs will be required for such detection. The said training shall be imparted by the Health Department through their designated officers. Furthermore, early detection followed by treatment is essentially required in Leprosy cases, if identified. For implementation, coordination among ICDS workers of Social Welfare Department, HHW & FTS of ULBs and designated officer for Leprosy eradication at District Health office are required.
