Resolution of the meeting for the vector control measures in Salt lake Stadium

In response to letter no. 386/VK8K/ 17 dated 12.09.17 duly endorsed to Jt. DHS of health Services (PH & CD) , a meeting was held in the official chamber of Jt DHS (PH & CD) in Swasthya Bhawan on 18.09.17 to discuss the strategies for the vector control measures in and around Saltlake stadium and its adjacent areas. The meeting was chaired by Jt.DHS (PH & CD), in presence of DDHS (PH), DDHS (MAI), OSG & DDHS (Admin)ADHS (Epid), ADHS (Entomologist), CHO (Bidhanagar Municipality), MO (SUDA), State Entomologist, Entomologist (SUDA).

It was decided to visit the site and meet with the Govt of WB Sports Dept. and FIFA Officials to understand the vector control strategies at field level and their valuable inputs about various activities related to FIFA World Cup and the activities



- Other than the above mentioned activities it was discussed that FIFA LOC will be advised to carry on the indoor space spray activities inside the residential areas and rooms of the stadium utilized by the players or other official throughout the period of the event. They will also utilize their house keeping staffs to remove/ destroy the vector breeding sources.
- A team will visit the residential facilities for Team, coaches, Officials (Novotel Hotel, Senses Hotel, Hyatt Hotel, West IN Hotel, Stadel Hotel) to monitor the vector status on 20.09.17
- As discussed with the CHO, Bidhannagar MC they will use the insecticides (Adulticide & Larvicide) as approved by National Vector Borne Disease Control Programme (Govt) & WHO, however the detail of the same is as under:
 - A) For Killing mosquito larvae: Spraying of Larvicide on stagnant water collection.
 - a) Temephos 50% EC
 - b) Bacillus thuringiensis (BTI) var israelensis WP, strain – 164; serotype H-14
 - B) For killing adult mosquito:
 - 1) Thermal fogging – with Cyphenothrin 5 % EC
 - 2) Indoor space spray – with pyrethrum extract 2%

This will be intimated to the LOC, FIFA as it is a requirement from FIFA side.

- CMHO, KMC will be requested to ensure befitting vector control measures in the fringe area of VYBK and SAI complex (up to 500m from perimeter) falling within their jurisdiction.

As you must be aware, vector borne diseases are a rising challenge in India and with the world cup approaching, it becomes critical that we take measures to prevent these diseases & infections especially at the VYBK Stadium, Training Sites and the Team Hotel. Based on the matter addressed, please find the details of the requested dates for implementation of services and venue addresses in the following Annexures with this letter.
