The Chairman, Tufanganj has sought additional fund for extending the mandatory benefits of Employees Provident fund to the contractual Health Worker and Solid Waste Management worker which is placed below for your perusal.

In the above context please refer to the letter from the Assistant Commissioner, Employees' Provident Fund Organisation sent to some of the ULBs for extending the benefits of E.P.F and Pension to the employees of the Municipalities/ Municipal Corporation who are contingent/casual/temporary /piece rated /daily rated /contractual/employed by or through Contractors/Subcontractors and the employees are not getting benefits of regular P.F. in terms of E.P.F. &MP Act 1952 w.e.f. 08.01.2011 (Flag 'A') But let the contention be limited within the Health workers and workers engaged in SWM as those schemes are being funded through SUDA.

Regarding Health workers under Urban Primary Health Care Services and Community Based Primary Health Care Services, the Municipal Affairs department may be moved for clarification and sanction for coverage under EPF Act 1952. Moreover, both the schemes run with budgetary support from M.A. Department and H&FW department respectively. If the clarification is in affirmative, M.A. Department may also be requested to take up the matter with H&FW Department for additional funding and provision in M.A. Department Budget also.

The funding under Solid Waste Management is being provided through grant from 13th Finance Commission by M.A. Department. For the contractual workers engaged in Solid Waste Management M.A. department may also be moved for sanction and additional provision under 13th Finance Commission.
