Sub: Survey of Houseless Population in all Urban Local Bodies (ULB) in West Bengal

- A. The above subject may please be referred to. This office is in receipt of a letter from the Joint Secretary, MA Department, GOWB vide Memo No. 25/MA/O/C-1/1M-34/2011 dated 10/04/2014 whereby the Office of the Project Director, CMU has been requested to take necessary steps for conducting a survey to ascertain the number of houseless population across all urban local bodies in the State, including Nabadiganta Industrial Township Authority (NDITA). The survey, in all of 128 ULBs, shall be conducted on-site by the Municipal/Industrial Township Authorities themselves and needs to be completed within 15/06/2014. Once completed, this office will need to send a compiled report in this regard to the MA Department within 30/06/2014.
- B. Apropos paragraph A above and keeping in mind the ongoing General Election 2014 to the "Lok Sabha", the following steps/activities and allied pre-requisites for conducting the survey are being put up for kind consideration and concurrence/approval.





Sub: Urban Houseless Population Survey – Revised Report

Apropos, NSP 6 & 7 may please be seen. As per the initial collation, the urban houseless population survey reported a total figure of 6468 persons and the same had already been put up before the M.A.Department, GOWB.

However, while reviewing the data, figures from Baidyabati (503) and Baranagar (809) were found to be phenomenally high and the officials of the ULB were verbally requested to take a re-look/re-view at their report and if required revise them. This was decided in meeting with OSD & Dy. Secretary MA Dept and PM, CMU with the undersigned.

Accordingly, both the ULB had reviewed and submitted their revised report. Baidyabati had revised their initial report of 503 houseless persons to 73 and Baranagar had reduced their number to 229 against initial figure of 809.

The revised figure of total urban houseless population in the State now comes at 5458 as against 6468 earlier. Figures of other ULB remain unchanged.

Sub: Assembly Question No 555 raised by Sri Rameswar Dolui, MLA

This office in receipt of a letter from the Special Secretary, MA Dept (by Fax) CP 496 requesting for furnishing relevant information pertaining to the questions (CP 495) raised by Hon'ble MLA Sri Rameswar Dolui in the State Assembly.

His questions are:

1. As on 30/09/14 what is the total no. of homeless population in Kolkata Municipal Corporation (KMC)?
2. Of the total homeless population in KMC what is the total no. of women and children?
3. What plans/programs have been undertaken towards housing / food / education / health check up of these homeless population?

Responding to the above queries, it can be said that:

1. The total no. of homeless population in Kolkata Municipal Corporation is:
 - a. From Census data (CP 493): 69798
 - b. From Feb'2011 survey: 37468 (in the last survey on urban homeless population conducted in June 2014, KMC was left out of the scope of work)
2. The total no. of women and children among the homeless population of KMC are:
 - a. From Census data (CP 493): N.A.
 - b. From Feb'2011 survey: 10,629 women and 12,844 children (0-14 years)
3. Regarding provision of housing for the homeless, projects (shelters) are being taken up across various ULBs in West Bengal under the National Urban Livelihoods Mission program.

Further to above, a comparative statement showing the homeless population figures across ULB in West Bengal obtained from Census vis-à-vis CMU 2014 survey is presented below. (Census figures, as received from SUDA reflects data from 59 ULBs only)
