

Sub: Training and Certification through National Skill Development Corporation

Ref. Memo : D.O. No. K-14014/99/2014-UPA dt. 15/01/2015

Joint Secretary, MoHUPA has communicated the letter under reference to the Principal Secretary, Municipal Affairs Department, Government of West Bengal regarding Training and Certification through National Skill Development Corporation(NSDC).

Observations:

- MoHUPA has entered into a MoU with National Skill Development Corporation(NSDC). As per MoU NSDC has agreed to provide Skill training to a total 1 lakh Urban Poor before 31st March, 2015 through their empanelled training partners.
- The candidates will be identified jointly by the ULB and empanelled Skill Training Provider(STP) of NSDC.
- NSDC with their empanelled partners will be responsible for providing skill training, third party assessment and certification of candidates, providing placement and tracking of minimum 50% candidates trained under MoU.
- The number of candidates trained under this MoU shall be in addition to candidates trained by our State and would be considered as the state's achievement under EST&P component under NULM.
- The cost of training as fixed by NSDC will be directly paid to NSDC by the State as per agreed installments. The NSDC will further make payment to STPs and submit U/C to the SULM and the said cost would be included in the state NULM training expenditure.
- The copy of MoU is enclosed with the letter for reference.
- MoHUPA has submitted a 'State wise training commitment from NSDC Skill Training Providers'. It has seen from the list that nine empanelled STPs under NSDC can provide training to 6600 candidates in our state.

As per directives of GOI, National Skill Development Corporation (NSDC) may be engaged for imparting skill training to 6600 Urban Poor in the State by March, 2015 under EST&P component of NULM through engagement of its training partners in the state. A list of such training partners has been provided by GOI and target for each of them has also been specified therein (flagged-X in the file). For conduct of training, NSDC will be guided by terms and conditions laid down in the MOU signed jointly by MoHUPA and NSDC. The mode for delivery of training is broadly stated above. A copy of MOU is placed in the File (flagged-Y), which may kindly be seen.

GOI communication is however ambiguous on the 'payment milestone' to be followed for making payment to NSDC. It is suggested that payment may be made to NSDC in three phases on a 30:50:20 basis, which is the pattern of payment recommended by the State Committee for selection of STPs in the draft RFP submitted to M.A Deptt. for approval.

Sub: Bipartite Agreement with National Skill Development Corporation (NSDC) and Training Fund Allocation

- A) **National Skill Development Corporation(NSDC)** has sent signed copy of Agreement(two sets) to this office for signing of Director, SUDA & Mission Director, WBSULM from our part. Two sets of Agreement are put up in the file for the signature of Director, SUDA & Mission Director, WBSULM.
- B) **NSDC** has also submitted the final list of ULB wise Training courses allocation among their empanelled Training Partners. The number of candidates will be trained under different Sectors of NSDC is **6600** as the target was given by MoHUPA.
- C) As per agreement statement "WBSULM will transfer the amount of Rs. 15,000/- per candidate (as per NULM guideline) to NSDC for the purpose of the Project in following installments".
- i. 30% of the fund will be released on signing of the MoU (In accordance with the directions of MoHUPA).
 - ii. 50% of the fund will be released on completion and certification of training.
 - iii. 20% of fund will be released on Placement/ Enterprise Development and tracking of candidates for 6 months.

Thus, after signing of Agreement this office has to release 30% of the total training cost to NSDC and according they will start EST&P training under NULM in different pre-set ULBs through their selected Training Partners.

As per agreement the total Training Cost Break up(30:50:20 ratio) for 6600 candidates in 15 ULBs is calculated here under.

Total Training cost of 6600 candidates : Rs. 9,90,00,000.00
(@ Rs. 1500/- per candidate)

1) 30% of the total training cost : Rs. 2,97,00,000.00

2) 50% of the total training Cost : Rs. 4,95,00,000.00

3) 20% of the total training cost : Rs. 1,98,00,000.00

Hence, a sum of Rs. 2,97,00,000/- (two crore ninety seven thousand only) may be released to NSDC for 30% training cost.

Sub: Implementation of NSDC Training in 15 ULBs

NSDC has sent the signed copy of training target allotment for 6000 candidates in selected 15 ULBs on 22nd sept.2015 through e-mail. As stated, they will send remaining 600 target allotment on the basis of the performance of the training partners once the project is implemented.

They are seeking our cooperation in regard to creation of login IDs and password for the NULM portal for online MIS and also by sharing the selected ULB contact details, by which the training partners could coordinate with the ULBs for implementation of the training programme within this month.

Observations: .

A) This office has released 30% training fund for 6600 candidates to NSDC as per Agreement of training. As they requested the letter of e-transfer of fund had mailed earlier. No such confirmation has yet been received from NSDC till date.

If they imparted training for 6000 candidates initially would the excess amount released to them be adjusted with remaining training cost.

B) For creation of login IDs and password of the selected training provider we are to request MoHUPA to clear dummy data entered earlier into the website; nulm.gov.in. The concern file has already been moved from our side to intimate the matter to GoI.

Till such time the web site is ready for online data entry we may insist NSDC to direct their training partner to enter relevant training information in NSDC's monitoring system called Skill Development Management System(SDMS) as per agreement.

C) We may share the contact details of the Nodal Officer of NULM(Executive Officer/City Project Officer) of 15 selected NULM town.

D) To start the NSDC training programme within this month following action to be taken:

- i) NSDC to be requested to send the confirmation of our training fund receipt.
- ii) They are to be requested to provide the details i.e. Name, Address and contact person with contact number, of the selected training partners to this office.
- iii) They are also to be requested to instruct their training partners to provide following details at the time of introducing themselves at ULB level.
 - a) Self introduction letter.
 - b) Copy of Bipartite MoU with NSDC.
 - c) Training allotment letter of NSDC to Training Partner for imparting training in the ULB/s.
- iv) This office will provide the list of name and contact nos. of the Nodal Officers of 15 ULBs to NSDC for the assistance of their training partners.
- v) In the above lines we are to communicate with NSDC. A draft in this regard is put up for approval.
- vi) To start the NSDC training programme we are to inform the selected ULBs with the list of training courses finalized for them. A draft in this regard is put up for approval.

NSDC Training and Certification under EST&P component of NULM

As per the direction of MoHUPA National Skill Development Corporation(NSDC) had been directed to engage their empanelled Training Providers(TPs) for imparting training to 6600 candidates among the target group under NULM in 15 selected NULM towns. After training all candidates to be assessed and certified by Sector Skill Council under NSDC.

To impart NSDC training two interactive meetings were conducted with NSDC, SUDA, selected TPs of NSDC and 15 selected NULM towns on 08/07/2015 and 25/08/2015 for finalization of training courses and to inform the ULBs about its tit bits. After the interactive meeting, finally NSDC had sent the ULB wise selected National Skill Qualification Framework (NSQF) complaints training courses for 6000 candidates instead of 6600 with nominated Training Providers list.

This office had communicated to the selected 15 NULM town vide memo no. SUDA-38/2015/1308 dt.24/09/2015 with a request to start the NSDC training within 30th September, 2015. Side by side this office had created login ID and Passwords for their TPs and sent to NSDC for online MIS.

It has learnt from some NULM towns and TPs of NSDC that due to some technicalities most of the training courses are not yet started. It is proposed to conduct a review meeting on NSDC training with selected 15 NULM towns on 14th January, 2016 at 12 noon at SUDA Conference Hall.

Under above reference letter Sri Jaikant singh, Head-Partnership & State Alliance has proposed to extend the date of existing Agreement between WBSULM and NSDC, which to be expired on 31st March, 2016. Their proposed extended date is 31st March.2019. All other terms and conditions as stated in the original Agreement will be remain same.

NSDC has also submitted a draft copy of ' Letter Agreement' which to be signed by Sri Jayant Krishna, new C.E.O of NSDC in their part.

It is observed, in the 'Letter Agreement' it would be mentioned that " This Agreement shall become effective from the date of this agreement and remain in force till 31st March 2019. This Agreement may be varied at any time by mutual agreement of the Parties in writing. It shall be reviewed one month before the end of the term or at any time mutually agreed by the Parties for possible renewal."

Under Secretary, UPA-1 has informed vide above memo no. that to effectively implement & monitor of training the NSDC has sought 6% of the total project cost for their Project Monitoring Unit(PMU). The cost will be utilized for travel and administrative expenses of the PMU.

The Ministry has also requested to place our views/opinion on the proposal given by the NSDC after evaluation of performance and support already extended by NSDC in meeting the training target. The views/opinion may also be indicated whether state would be interested in bearing the expenses liked for by NSDC through DAY-NULM funds transferred to it.

Brief notes on NSDC training are as follows,

- An Agreement had been signed and executed on 29/07/2015 between WBSULM and NSDC.
- The Agreement has been expired on 31/03/2016.
- Extension of Agreement has been initiated by NSDC vide their memo no NSDC 9056/17-02-2016 dt. 17/02/2016.
- In reply, this office has issued a letter regarding extension of Agreement through 'Letter Agreement' vide memo no. SUDA-38/2015/583.
- After letter correspondence, e-mail and also telephonic communication no reply has yet received for extension of Agreement from their side.
- Virtually after a long delay in process the existing Agreement is seem to be invalid.
- A selected Training Provider(TP) of NSDC has reported that their bipartite agreement with NSDC not yet ready and for that reason they are not capable to start their allotted training courses in few ULBs.
- A number of TPs have unofficially reported that communication system of NSDC is not up to the mark and for that reason they are not able to start their allotted training programme in right time.

Recommendations

Before come to a decision on the above proposal to provide 6% of the total project cost to NSDC we may evaluate the performance of NSDC in all respect, i.e. performance/ quality of training being conducted by the TPs of NSDC, Commencement and completion status of training, MIS & ME system of NSDC etc. from the selected 15 NULM towns.
